Motion

Plaintiff Tommie Jayne Wasserberg, proceeding pro se, moves for the appointment of counsel under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(1).

1. Plaintiff is indigent, with limited income (SSA benefits of \$1,200/month, \$300/month in EBT/UHC benefits, and no current business income).
2. The case's complexity (RICO, civil rights, class action) requires legal expertise.
3. Plaintiff's claims have merit, as evidenced by documented harassment and defamation.
4. Due to the impact of the extreme emotional and financial distress of the targeted

harassment exacerbated by fentanyl trafficking around residence on plaintiff's behavioral health, their provider, Jennifer Budd, NP, COPE Community Services is writing a letter of medical necessity for appointment of counsel that will be filed as an exhibit within 10 days.

Prayer for Relief

Plaintiff requests the appointment of pro bono counsel.
