DIVORCE DECREE

NOW on this day, comes on for hearing the complaint for absolute divorce filed by the Plaintiff, Steven Williams, appearing in person and by and through his attorney, Pine Drewyor; the Defendant, Desiree Williams, appearing not, having filed her Waiver of Service and Entry of Appearance herein; the parties announce settlement of all issues herein, and from the pleadings, testimony of Plaintiff, corroborating testimony of Ched Ormond, a witness called on Plaintiff's behalf, and other matters and proof properly before the Court, the Court being well and sufficiently advised in the premises, finds, orders, adjudges and decrees:

1. That the Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter of this action.
2. That the Plaintiff's grounds are sustained by the proof and he is entitled to an absolute decree of divorce of and from the Defendant.
3. That the Plaintiff and the Defendant were married on September 28, 2013, and lived together as husband and wife until they separated from bed and board on or about November 10, 2017.
4. That the parties have no children and none are expected.
5. Plaintiff shall maintain sole possession of the marital home and shall be solely responsible for any debts associated or encumbering the property and shall indemnify the Defendant against the same. Plaintiff shall pay Defendant her half of the equity of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) within ninety (90) days of this Decree.

6. That the parties shall each retain all other personal property that is currently in their possession and shall be solely responsible for any debt associated or encumbering any property they retain, and shall indemnify the other against the same.

7. Each party agrees to be responsible for the debts incurred by him or her since the date of separation. Both parties agree and affirm that neither party has opened any credit card, credit account or incurred any debt in the other's name that is not listed herein.

8. That the allegations contained in the Complaint of the Plaintiff filed herein are sustained by the proof.

9. That the Plaintiff, Steven Williams, is entitled to, and he is hereby granted, an absolute divorce from the Defendant, Desiree Williams.


10. The Defendant shall be restored to her previous name: Desiree Calouette.
