This cause was called and the parties appeared. The State appeared by her District Attorney as named above.

**Counsel / Waiver of Counsel (select one)**

Defendant appeared with counsel.

Defendant appeared without counsel and knowingly, intelligently, and voluntarily waived the right to representation by counsel in writing in open court.

Defendant was tried in absentia.

Both parties announced ready for trial. Defendant waived the right of trial by jury and entered the plea indicated above. It appeared to the Court that Defendant was mentally competent to stand trial, made the plea freely and voluntarily, and was aware of the consequences of the plea. The Court received the plea and entered it of record. After hearing the evidence submitted, if any, the Court **ADJUDGES** Defendant **GUILTY** of the offense indicated above. The Court **FINDS** that the Presentence Investigation, if so ordered, was done according to the applicable provisions of Subchapter F, Chapter 42A, Tex. Code Crim. Proc.

Having been convicted of the offense designated above, the Court **ORDERS** Defendant punished in accordance with the Court's findings as to the proper punishment as indicated above, and after having conducted an inquiry into Defendant's ability to pay, as directed by Article 42.15, Code Crim. Proc., the Court **ORDERS** Defendant to pay the fine, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution as indicated above and further detailed below.

**Punishment Options (select one)**

**Confinement in State Jail or Institutional Division.** The Court **ORDERS** the authorized agent of the State of Texas or the County Sheriff to take and deliver Defendant to the Director of the Correctional Institutions Division, TDCJ, for placement in confinement in accordance with this judgment. The Court **ORDERS** Defendant remanded to the custody of the County Sheriff until the Sheriff can obey the directions in this paragraph. Upon release from confinement, the Court **ORDERS** Defendant to proceed without unnecessary delay to the District Clerk's office, or any other office designated by the Court or the Court's designee, to pay or to make arrangements to pay any fines, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution due.

**County Jail—Confinement / Confinement in Lieu of Payment.** The Court **ORDERS** Defendant committed to the custody of the County Sheriff immediately or on the date the sentence commences. Defendant shall be confined in the county jail for the period

indicated above. Upon release from confinement, the Court **ORDERS** Defendant to proceed without unnecessary delay to the District Clerk's office, or any other office designated by the Court or the Court's designee, to pay or to make arrangements to pay any fines, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution due.

**County Jail—State Jail Felony Conviction.** Pursuant to §12.44(a), Tex. Penal Code, the Court **FINDS** that the ends of justice are best served by imposing confinement permissible as punishment for a Class A misdemeanor instead of a state jail felony. Accordingly, Defendant will serve punishment in the county jail as indicated above. The Court **ORDERS** Defendant committed to the custody of the County Sheriff immediately or on the date the sentence commences. Upon release from confinement, the Court **ORDERS** Defendant to proceed without unnecessary delay to the District Clerk's office, or any other office designated by the Court or the Court's designee, to pay or to make arrangements to pay any fines, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution due.

**Fine Only Payment.** The punishment assessed against Defendant is for a **FINE ONLY**. The Court **ORDERS** Defendant to proceed immediately to the District Clerk's office, or any other office designated by the Court or the Court's designee, to pay or to make arrangements to pay the fine, court costs, reimbursement fees, and restitution ordered by the Court in this cause.

All supporting documentation, if any, concerning Defendant's credit for time served is incorporated herein by this reference.

Furthermore, the following special findings or orders apply:

The Court ORDERS that the sentence in Count Two of the Indictment is assessed at 20 years confinement in TDCJ, Correctional Institutions Division, and shall be served **CONSECUTIVELY** to, and shall only commence to be served following completion of, the sentence assessed in Count One of the Indictment.

The Court ORDERS that the sentence in Count Three of the Indictment is assessed at 20 years confinement in TDCJ, Correctional Institutions Division, and shall be served **CONSECUTIVELY** to, and shall only commence to be served following completion of, the sentence assessed in Count Two of the Indictment.

The Court ORDERS that the sentence in Counts Four, Five, Six, Seven, Eight of the Indictment is assessed at 20 years confinement in TDCJ, Correctional Institutions Division, and shall be served **CONCURRENTLY**, and shall only commence to be served following completion of, the sentence assessed in Count Three of the Indictment.

The Court ORDERS that the sentence in Count Nine of the Indictment is assessed at 10 years confinement in TDCJ, Correctional Institutions Division, probated for 10 years, 800 hours community service, \$10,000 fine, and shall be served **CONSECUTIVELY** to, and shall only commence to be served following completion of, the sentence assessed in Count Eight of the Indictment.

12. Submit to blood and/or urine and/or breath testing at any time and from time to time as directed by the Adult Probation Officer at his or her discretion during the term of probation. The Probationer shall pay for all costs of such testing. The Probationer consents to the State's use of a Certificate of Analysis described by *Code of Criminal Procedure* art. 38.41 in any proceeding to adjudicate, revoke, extend, or modify community supervision. The Probationer waives and shall waive any objection to the admissibility of a Certificate of Analysis which substantially conforms to *Code of Criminal Procedure* art. 38.41, Sec. 3.
13. Participate in any and all community based educational programs and testing, including but not limited to any psychosexual assessment or evaluation and any educational and treatment programs(s) recommended through such assessment or evaluation as directed by the Community Supervision and Corrections Department.
14. Work faithfully and satisfactorily participate in a community service project by completing 800 hours of community service, at a rate of no less than 16 hours per calendar month, by performing said community service in accordance with *Texas Code of Criminal Procedure*, Article 42.12 §16. Said community service is to be performed in accordance with general administrative and reporting guidelines set forth by the Erath County Supervision and Corrections Department.
15. Consent to search of your person, residence, business and any vehicle or container under your control by a supervision officer or peace officer acting at the direction of a supervision officer without prior notice or search warrant to determine your compliance with the conditions of supervision and the laws of this State. Any contraband found to be in your possession will be subject to seizure.
16. Complete a substance abuse screening/assessment as directed by your community supervision officer and provide written proof of compliance to the supervision officer within 10 days of completion.
17. Abide by all Sex Offender terms as listed in the Sex Offender Admonishments Addendum included with the papers of this cause.
18. Attend all courses, classes, lectures, and programs required by the licensed sex offender counselor as directed by the Community Supervision and Corrections Department of Erath County, Texas for the purpose of rehabilitation of offenders placed on supervision for sexually related offenses. Attendance and participation in said courses, classes, lectures, programs or other educational activity is mandatory unless discharged, released or exempted by the C.S.C.D. Director with approval of the Court. Tardiness, absenteeism or early departure from any courses, classes, lectures, and programs without expressed written permission of the C.S.C.D. is prohibited. Maintaining an acceptable standard of behavior and attitude toward the program, its course material, as well as personnel involved in said activity, is mandatory. The probationer shall be responsible for and pay all costs of said program.
19. Be prohibited from accepting any employment or participate in any volunteer activity requiring unsupervised contact with anyone under 17 years of age.
20. Be prohibited from having any contact with minors under the age of 17 years old unless supervised by another adult over the age of 18 and who has been approved in writing by his registered sexual offender counselor and Community Supervision and Corrections Department officer. The person must be aware of the defendant's offense and willing to take responsibility for the defendant's actions.
21. Be required to obtain written permission from his registered sexual offender counselor and permission from his supervising officer prior to securing any employment or volunteering his services. The Defendant is prohibited from employment or volunteering his services to any agency in which the defendant may have access or contact with minor children (i.e. schools, day-care centers, churches, etc.)

22. Be prohibited from visiting places where minors (persons under 17) normally congregate (i.e. schools, playgrounds, recreational parks, etc.) without written permission from his registered sexual offender counselor and his supervising officer.
23. Be prohibited from initiating, maintaining, or establishing contact with any minor child or attempting to do so, or residing in the same residence with minor children without written permission from his registered sexual offender counselor and his supervising officer.
24. Be prohibited from residing within 1500 feet of a day-care center, public and/or private school or any educational program where minors under the age of seventeen (17) may frequent. The defendant will obtain written permission from his registered sexual offender counselor and his supervising officer prior to his relocation.
25. Be required to pay all costs of counseling for the victim of this offense.
26. Submit to a blood sample or other specimen to the Texas Department of Public Safety under Subchapter G, Chapter 411, Government Code, for the purpose of creating a DNA record of the defendant.
27. Register with the proper official of your county or city of residence as a Sex Offender.
28. Shall not use the internet, or have access to a device which is capable of accessing the internet.

Submit a copy of your income tax return filed with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) or Proof of Extension to the Community Supervision and Corrections Department (CSCD) of the 266<sup>th</sup> Judicial District by April 15<sup>th</sup> of each year during the term of supervision and bring your IRS Income Tax Refund check to the CSCD immediately upon receipt and endorse the check to the CSCD to be applied to delinquent probation fees, restitution, fines, and/or other monetary terms and conditions of probation payable through the CSCD by Defendant.
30. Defendant shall not use or own any device, which allows internet access unless specifically authorized in writing by his/her sex offender counselor and his/her supervision officer. This includes, but is not limited to, satellite dishes, PDA's, electronic game systems, web-television and cellular/digital telephones.

34. The Defendant shall not possess any pornography, obscene material or device or any other material that depicts or describes sexually explicit acts, including oral, anal, or vaginal intercourse or sexual acts of the breasts, genitals or anus of another person.

35. The Defendant shall not go to sexually oriented establishments (topless bars, adult book stores, X-rated theaters) or places where pornography or sexually explicit materials are openly displayed at the establishment.





The files contained CyberTipline reports # 87769353, 87991913, 88151471, 88972106, 89330877, 90110478, 90503314, 90527266, 90557061, 90672592, 90672610, 90767084, 90767183, 90857658, 90864321, 90965728, 90965764, 91080620, 91148233, 91216845, 91216852, 91423427, 91505578, 91646789, 91783713, 91823210, 91824038, 91857948, 91946171, 92033588, 92202466, 92202470, 92291606, 92375488, 92386272, 92462260, 92501670, 92501744, 92501913, 92598502, 92687503, 92791313, 93043597, 93186653, 93438118, 93438171, 93545496, 94982279, 95169749, 95243964, 91216816, 91325392, 91423430, 91857914, 91946170, 92752515, 92756473, and 92762899. These cybertips show images of prepubescent females a male engage in sexual acts, or in various poses nude. The tips show Discord as the reporting party. It also shows that the user profile screen name being reported as Felix.#923, Brad, Felix AKA Brad, Brad 764, or come variation of Felix. The IP address that is reported as the one used to upload the flagged image is 67.21.188.121. This IP address returns to Northland Cable television and issued to a Stephenville address. This information is all included in the CyberTipline reports.

A subpoena was then sent to Northland cable on 7/6/2021 requesting any and all subscriber information related to the IP address that was associated with the child pornography that originated in Stephenville, Texas. The return from Northland cable showed the subscriber name as Heather Schneider, Address: 949 S Lillian St, Apt 112, Stephenville, TX 76401. An accurint search through Lexis Nexis for Heather Schneider revealed she has an email address Bradley.Cadenhead@gmail.com associated with her. An additional cybertip # 92919008 was received by Jenna Ethridge on 6/13/2021 reporting someone named Bradley Ortiz has been distributing child pornography on a Discord server, and the user names Felix AKA Brad were used in the distribution.

Auburn Place apartment management verified that Schneider still resides in apartment number 112 with her son Bradley Cadenhead.

A search warrant was issued for 949 S Lillian Apt 112 and signed by Judge Blake Thompson. A search of the apartment provided a Black HP Pavilion laptop, and an Motorola Cell phone both belonging to Bradley Cadenhead.

Heather Schneider was interviewed at the Stephenville Police Department and she stated that Bradley is the only person with access to his laptop. Schneider denied knowing the log in information for laptop and advised that no one else knew it. Schneider stated that her boyfriend Michael Davis does not know the log in information for her wifi router. Schneider stated that she does not know who has been sending child pornography from her residence but advised her boyfriend did not move in until April 2021. The Cybertips indicate the child pornography was being sent as early as March of 2021.

On 8/28/2021 Bradley Cadenhead was processed as a juvenile at the Stephenville Police Department. While speaking with Bradley's father Jeff Cadenhead he advised me he was upset his son was sending these images and would be angry if he did it again. Photographs of Cadenhead were taken and placed in the O drive under this case number.

On 8/27/2021 a detention hearing was held for Cadenhead and he was sent to Granbury Youth Services for detention. A search warrant for the black Pavilion laptop was obtained on 8/27/2021 and it will be forensically examined.

After further reviewing the name Bradley Cadenhead through SPD police records, it was determined to be Heather Schneider's juvenile son.

Later in the day of 8/24/2021, I drove by unit 112 at Auburn Place Apartments located at 949 S. Lillian to check for any unsecured WiFi connections. I did not observe any unsecured connections near unit 112. While there, I took photographs of the front door of unit 112. I later drove back by the apartment to take more in depth photographs once Sergeant Lanier advised a search warrant would be completed. Those photographs were downloaded to the (O): Drive under this case number.

On 8/25/2021, Sergeant Lanier advised a search warrant was obtained for 949 S. Lillian unit 112 and asked if I would be available to assist. At approximately 1458 hours, I arrived at the above listed address with Sergeant Lanier and Detective Morrison. During the time the search warrant was being conducted, I stood outside the unit with Heather Schneider and her daughter. During said time I asked Heather if her son or her live in boyfriend (Michael Lee Davis TX DL# 06096745) ever went by any nicknames.

I received the results from the forensic examination on March 14, 2022 and forwarded them to Lt. Lanier. Do to the nature of the evidence on the digital report and laptop that was submitted it is the policy of the Austin DPS Crime Lab that the items should be picked up in person.

On March 24, 2022 I drove down to Austin DPS Crime Lab and personally received the items from crime lab tech Yvette Ruiz. The items received were the HP Pavilion laptop with charger and a thumb drive containing the digital report. I then transported the items back to the Stephenville Police Department and secured them into the property room.

### **Supplemental Narrative 06/23/2022 08:45:40 JEREMY LANIER**

On 3/24/2022 the forensic examination of Cadenheads laptop were returned from the DPS lab. The forensic analysis was conducted by Kathleen Hickey with the Texas Department of Public Safety. Upon reviewing the results of the examination multiple images of child pornography were located depicting young prepubescent females engaged in sex acts or displaying their unclothed genitals. Over twenty unique images were located on the the laptop of young prepubescent unclothed and engaging in sexual activity were located on the laptop. Many images are also duplicated many times on the laptop. In addition to the images located on the laptop two videos were also recovered that depict adolescent females engaged in sexual intercourse. One video file name \$R1F8KTM.mp4 has screen captures of social media conversation between user Felix and other members and contains a video of a minor female having intercourse with an adult male with the caption, "no one cares." Additional notable images can be found in the forensic analysis of the laptop depicting self harming in the form of cutting the words, "Brad is a pedo" and "764."

Multiple audio recordings of people discussing or mentioning grooming were also located in the forensic examination. One audio recording titled \$R13K8SR.mp4 mentions "Brad" multiple times. In addition to the child pornography recovered login credentials and user names consistent with the cybertips were also located on the laptop including users names brad764, Felix, Brad76444@rape.lol.

A thumbdrive containing the forensic analysis of the laptop has been placed in evidence and this case will be forwarded to the Erath County Attorneys office.

Joey told Mr Sanders he over heard Bradley say he wants to bring a gun to school and shoot the school and go home and kill kids. Joey gave a statement to Mr Sanders.

The next person Brian spoke to was Shana Dalley. Shana told Mr Sanders she didn't hear Bradley say anything about bringing a gun and shooting anybody. Shana told Mr Sanders Bradley was trying to tell her how to build a bomb the other day. Shana told Mr Sanders, Madison was also there when Bradley talked about making a bomb. Shana told Mr Sanders she just walked away. Shana was asked when did this occur. Mr Sanders was told a while back.

Mr Sanders next spoke to Madison Solis. Mr Sanders knows Madison and told me she is a trusted student. Madison told Mr Sanders that none of the threats occurred. Madison told him Bradley did not say anything about shooting up the school or making a bomb. James Phelps was called into the office and he spoke to Mr Sanders. James told Mr Sanders Bradley did not say anything about guns or shooting up the school. Mr Sanders called Bradley's mother and

I asked Shana about any other witnesses to the bomb remarks. Shana told me Madison heard it. Madison was not available but she has already told Mr Sanders that Bradley did not tell Shana how to make a bomb. Mr Sanders gave me copies of some of the statements. Mr Sanders also gave a statement. My axon video was logged onto the property page and downloaded into Evidence.com.

Henderson SISD is not going to take any action against Bradley and does not have evidence that the threat occurred. The case will be unfounded.

New evidence has come forward and I have opened the case back up.

On 09-18-2018 at approximately: 8:00pm, I, Was told by Assistant Principal Sanders that another child wanted to report threats made by Bradley Cadenhead. The child name is Ethan Barns. Ethan came to the Assistant Principals office and I recorded the interview. Ethan told me he wanted to let us know that Bradley Cadenhead had threatened to shoot up the school because Bradley hates it. Ethan told me this occurred on the first day of school. Ethan told me Bradley made another threat to shoot up the school towards the end of the first week. Then again around September the tenth Ethan told me Bradley said he wanted to carve pentagrams into the table and kill everyone. Ethan told me Bradley often says the same thing a lot as they have lockers near each other. Ethan told me he is tired of hearing Bradley make threats and wanted Mr Sanders and me to know about it. Ethan gave a written statement.

Taking into consideration the threat made last week by Bradley and the content of that threat matching Ethan's complaint does start to corroborate Joey Avalos statement too. Joey statement reads Bradley was heard saying in the hallway when break was over he wanted to shoot up the school and when he gets home he wants to kill kids. I called Joey back in and spoke to him about Bradley. Joey told me he did hear him say that and his friends are lieing for him. Joey stands by his statement.

Around 12:00pm I was approached by Mrs Vandenburg, Bradley's teacher. Mrs Vandenburg told me she wanted Bradley out of her class. He was being disruptive and some of the children complained about his threats of violence against the school. Mrs Vandenburg had overheard Bradley fixation on violent behavior's. She had heard him talk about getting guns and putting silencer on them, making bombs, and watching violent killing videos on you tube. Mrs Vandenburg told me she was afraid he was building his courage up to do such things. Mrs Vandenburg was upset and was very concerned for her class room safety and she told me her class room aid Mrs Ketchum felt the same way.

Today Bradley lashed out at Mrs Vandenburg when she told him to stop talking about gang killing and bloods and crips. Mrs Vandenburg told him she didn't want to hear it. Bradley

yelled back at Mrs Vandenburg he didn't want to hear what she had to say either. Mrs Vandenburg sent him to the office but Bradley detoured and went to lunch. Mrs Vandenburg gave a written statement.

With all the statements and subject matter being the same I believe Bradley is making threats to students. Bradley's demeanor since I have started working at Henderson Junior High is sullen and angry young man. He comes to school with a attitude of I hate this place and I have heard him say so as he enters the school and is walking down the hall.

I met with the Erath County Attorney Lisa Pence and we discussed the statements and threats by Bradley. What makes the past complaints come to light is the fact that teachers are now coming forward about Bradley's behavior and threats. Mrs Vandenburg feels threatened as does her aid Mrs Ketchum.

Bradley was taken into custody by myself and Officer Totts. Bradley is being charged with Terroristic Threat. I called Bradley's mother and asked her to meet us at Judge Bass' office. I told Mrs Bettis the school councilor what was occurring and we had called the parents. I also contacted Assistant Principal Sanders and advised him of the situation. The school wishes to seek charges in this case.

I transported Bradley to Judge Bass' Office in the Erath County Court House Annex. Judge Bass Magistrated Bradley. Bradley parents refused to let me question Bradley. I explained the complaint to them and read the statements against Bradley. I asked Bradley's parents to take Bradley to the PD. Bradley was then fingerprinted and pictured as required. The only way we are aware of what happened is because this kid is posting it on social media. He posted a picture of his disciplinary form that was given to him by the school. Since then, he has continued to post. Below is the most disturbing of all. Im not sure if his social media is being monitored, so I thought I'd forward this information along to you. I am not sure where he is posting this (Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat. Ect.) Signed respectfully Leslie Cantu.

Attached to the e-mail is a picture of a young black male pointing a large caliber handgun at the camera. The picture reads-Guess What, at the bottom is written ,I still don't care. Taking into consideration the reason Bradley is in DAEP , this post is concerning and shows his attitude towards the offense he has committed, the post was made on 09-19-2018.

I called Leslie and spoke to her about the post. Leslie told me her son is afraid Bradley might actually do something. I asked Leslie if it was ok for me to talk to Caleb tomorrow. Leslie told me yes. Around 8:44am I asked Caleb to come to Mr Sanders office. I asked Caleb to also bring his phone. When Caleb arrived I asked him what happened. Caleb told me Bradley Cadenhead was posting things to Instagram. I asked Caleb if they were on his phone. Caleb told me yes. I told Caleb I will call his mother and see if she will give me permission to look at Caleb's phone. I spoke to Leslie again, Leslie works at Gilbert Elementary as a Bilingual Teacher. Leslie told me it was ok for me to look at Caleb's phone. Caleb showed me his phone. On it is five pictures all with the Instagram name of staying\_low\_key\_for\_awhile. The pictures were all added on or after 09-19-2018. The day after Bradley was taken into custody.

Caleb told me this is Bradley's Instagram name. Caleb is on Bradley's list of people he posts

things to. He also knows it is Bradley because of the discipline paperwork on the Instagram site. The five pictures are as follows: a picture of the young man pointing the handgun, one is of Bradley's discipline papers which he would be the only one with a copy besides the school. This ties the Instagram page to Bradley.

The other post read, The people at the probation office said Im dangerous, the next one reads, #burdscourtcase. The next post reads, Post all your posts on #burdscourtcase. The last one is a still picture of a video of a person opening a knife with a handgun in the background. This post of the knife was made in May of 2018 but is under the name of staying\_low\_key\_for\_awhile.

Caleb told me Bradley used to go by the name of Yaitezburd on Instagram then he changed it to staying low for awhile sometime this past year. Caleb told me his new Instagram is #burdscourtcase. I asked Caleb how it made him feel. Caleb told me he was concerned for his safety and others. He is afraid Bradley might hurt him or others at the school. Caleb gave me a written statement.

The pictures were downloaded to the O: drive under the case number. JPO and the County Attorneys office were contacted about this report. A print out of Leslie's e-mail is with this report.

At the bottom it reads Dab on them suicidal haters. The next meme reads When you tell your parents you vape. Cartoon on it reads Oh, that's right honey, we don't have a son.

The next meme is a picture of a young man with down written above it. At the bottom of the page it reads Well mem dank memes dankmemees howto doggo 420 lit fresh phresh phatoff disabled humor comedy funny.

The last and most disturbing one is a cartoon character pointing to a AR style rifle. Written on the top of the page is When you're getting sick and tired of everyone making fun of your fidget spinners. The screen shots have been down loaded to the o drive under the case number. 

**X. NARRATIVE (Optional)**

The Defendant Bradley Cadenhead is a 17-year-old male who is before this Honorable Court charged with Possession or Promotion of Child Pornography with nine counts all 2nd Degree Felonies. On June 15, 2021, Officer Lanier at Stephenville PD> received a Cybertip from Jenna Ethridge an officer with the Dallas PD Child Exploitation Unit . The Cybertip indicated the sending individual had an IP address registered to Northland Cable and user names of Felix. #923, Brad, Felix AKA Brad with a local IP address. Officer Lanier subpoenaed the records from Northland cable and the IP address was verified as belonging to a local subscriber Heather Schneider , residing at 949 South Lillian Apt 112 Stephenville, Texas. On August 25th 2021 a search warrant was signed and officers from the Stephenville Police Department went to the Lillian address a laptop was recovered and two cell phones belonging to Bradley Cadenhead. Officers interviewed Heather Schneider and it was determined she and her boyfriend who lived at the residence did not have knowledge of the child porn and neither had a password for the computer. On August 28, 2021 Bradley was processed as a juvenile, a detention hearing was held and Bradley was sent to Granbury Youth Services. A search warrant was obtained for the laptop and a forensic examination was conducted. The laptop was sent to the DPS laboratory in Austin on September 22, 2021 The results were received March 24, 2022. The results were approximately 20 images of child pornography, depicting young prepubescent females engaged in sex acts. There were two videos indicating depicting adolescent females engaged in sexual intercourse. There was a social media conversation with user Felix and other members accompanying a video of a adolescent female having sex with a adult male. There were other videos depicting self-harm There were audio files discussing grooming with the user name Brad mentioned many times. Logon credentials were consistent with the logon information provided by Cybertips.

## Juvenile Court and Probation

Bradley was charged with Terroristic Threat on or about September 13, 2018, in Juvenile Court in Erath County. Bradley was charged with making threats of bringing a gun to school and shooting the school. He also made comments about going home and killing kids. He was also heard making comments about making a bomb. Bradley was placed on Juvenile probation. In June of 2019 he violated his probation and was sentenced to 10 days in Grayson County Juvenile Detention Facility.

I met with Bradley April 4th, and April 18th 2023 we discussed the instant offense. He describes a normal childhood. He started watching adult pornography at age 8 online which was not unusual for a boy that age. He describes this as a normal curiosity with adult sexual relations. At age 10 he became fascinated with violent torture pictures and videos, as well as gore most had no sexual content. He stated he watched them for the shock value. He watched them from age 10 through age 16. He became acquainted with an individual through the online game Minecraft where he continued to develop his fascination with gore and torture pics and videos to start a group called 764. He claims they had hundreds of torture videos on his server and between two hundred and four hundred followers. Most child sexual pictures and videos came into his server through other users of the server. Bradley does admit to uploading child porn to the server on occasion. Bradley was the moderator and was in charge of the group and the server's content. Bradley does not appear to have been overly interested in the child pornography aspect of the server, but noted that he did view and download pictures and videos to be placed on the server. I believe he did this primarily to continue to attract and keep followers on the server. Bradley did admit to the group's use of the server to do sextortion of individuals admitting this was quite common among the members. They would do this for money and sometime just for power over the individuals. I reviewed the 404b material with Bradley, he recalls some of the files but does not remember them all. He does recall influencing some individuals in the group to actually carve his initials and other references to him into their bodies as a form of homage to Bradley. His influence over some members of the group appeared to be extreme. Bradley said this was actually a self-described Cult. Many people on the server idolized him as the cult's leader.

After reviewing pictures and materials related to this offense in the states 404(B) and 37.07 filing and discussions with the District Attorney's it was determined due to the graphic nature of the images in the file, that they should not be included in the presentence report. The District Attorney will present the text and images to the Honorable Court on the day of sentencing.

Based on the nature of these offenses and concern over his obsession with violent and shocking material this officer does not believe he is a good candidate for supervision. The court should sentence the defendant to something in the range of punishment that it determines appropriate for this type of offense in each of the indicted counts. The determination to stack counts in sentencing is purely discretionary with the court but should be given consideration.

On 6/15/2021, 6/30/2021, 7/7/2021, 7/9/2021, 8/16/2021, and 8/23/2021 I received a Cybertips from Jenna Ethridge of the Dallas Police Department's Child Exploitation Unit advising me of a new CyberTipline Report that had ties back to the Stephenville area. The files contained CyberTipline reports # 87769353, 87991913, 88151471, 88972106, 89330877, 90110478, 90503314, 90527266, 90557061, 90672592, 90672610, 90767084, 90767183, 90857658, 90864321, 90965728, 90965764, 91080620, 91148233, 91216845, 91216852, 91423427, 91505578, 91646789, 91783713, 91823210, 91824038, 91857948, 91946171, 92033588, 92202466, 92202470, 92291606, 92375488, 92386272, 92462260, 92501670, 92501744, 92501913, 92598502, 92687503, 92791313, 93043597, 93186653, 93438118, 93438171, 93545496, 94982279, 95169749, 95243964, 91216816, 91325392, 91423430, 91857914, 91946170, 92752515, 92756473, and 92762899. These cybertips show images of prepubescent females a male engage in sexual acts, or in various poses nude. The tips show Discord as the reporting party. It also shows that the user profile screen name being reported as Felix. #923, Brad, Felix AKA Brad, Brad 764, or some variation of Felix. The IP address that is reported as the one used to upload the flagged image is 67.21.188.121. This IP address returns to Northland Cable television and issued to a Stephenville address. This information is all included in the CyberTipline reports.

A subpoena was then sent to Northland cable on 7/6/2021 requesting any and all subscriber information related to the IP address that was associated with the child pornography that originated in Stephenville, Texas. The return from Northland cable showed the subscriber name as Heather Schneider, Address: 949 S Lillian St, Apt 112, Stephenville, TX 76401. An accurate search through Lexis Nexis for Heather Schneider revealed she has an email address Bradley.Cadenhead@gmail.com associated with her. An additional cybertip # 92919008 was received by Jenna Ethridge on 6/13/2021 reporting someone named Bradley Ortiz has been distributing child pornography on a Discord server, and the user names Felix AKA Brad were used in the distribution.

Auburn Place apartment management verified that Schneider still resides in apartment number 112 with her son Bradley Cadenhead.

A search warrant was issued for 949 S Lillian Apt 112 and signed by Judge Blake Thompson. A search of the apartment provided a Black HP Pavilion laptop, and an Motorola Cell phone both belonging to Bradley Cadenhead.

Heather Schneider was interviewed at the Stephenville Police Department and she stated that Bradley is the only person with access to his laptop. Schneider denied knowing the log in information for laptop and advised that no one else knew it. Schneider stated that her boyfriend Michael Davis does not know the log in information for her wifi router. Schneider stated that she does not know who has been sending child pornography from her residence but advised her boyfriend did not move in until April 2021. The Cybertips indicate the child pornography was being sent as early as March of 2021.

On 8/28/2021 Bradley Cadenhead was processed as a juvenile at the Stephenville Police Department. While speaking with Bradley's father Jeff Cadenhead he advised me he was upset his son was sending these images and would be angry if he did it again. Photographs of Cadenhead were taken and placed in the O drive under this case number.

On 8/27/2021 a detention hearing was held for Cadenhead and he was sent to Granbury Youth Services for detention. A search warrant for the black Pavilion laptop was obtained on 8/27/2021 and it will be forensically examined.

On Tuesday 8/24/2021, Sergeant Lanier reached out to see if I could assist him in looking up a name and email address' through Lexis Nexis Accurint. I met with Sergeant Lanier in my office at CID a short time later.

Sergeant Lanier advised he was looking for a name of Bradley or Felix to be associated with the name Heather Schneider. After running the name Heather Schneider through Accurint, an email address of Bradley.Cadenhead@gmail.com was attached to her name. After further reviewing the name Bradley Cadenhead through SPD police records, it was determined to be Heather Schneider's juvenile son.

Later in the day of 8/24/2021, I drove by unit 112 at Auburn Place Apartments located at 949 S. Lillian to check for any unsecured WiFi connections. I did not observe any unsecured connections near unit 112. While there, I took photographs of the front door of unit 112. I later drove back by the apartment to take more in depth photographs once Sergeant Lanier advised a search warrant would be completed. Those photographs were downloaded to the (O): Drive under this case number.

On 8/25/2021, Sergeant Lanier advised a search warrant was obtained for 949 S. Lillian unit 112 and asked if I would be available to assist. At approximately 1458 hours, I arrived at the above listed address with Sergeant Lanier and Detective Morrison. During the time the search warrant was being conducted, I stood outside the unit with Heather Schneider and her daughter. During said time I asked Heather if her son or her live in boyfriend (Michael Lee Davis TX DL# 06096745) ever went by any nicknames.

Heather stated Brad for her son or Mike for her boyfriend but never called them anything else. I asked if the name Felix meant anything to her where she stated no. I asked if she observed any unusual behavior from Bradley or Michael where she again stated no. I also asked Heather if she knew if Michael had ever been in trouble where she stated not the she knew of. I later had dispatch run a full criminal history on Michael and it was determined he is currently serving 10 years probation for a 3rd Degree Felony out of Brown County.

After Sergeant Lanier and Detective Morrison concluded the search warrant, we all cleared the scene and arrived back at SPD. At this time there was no further action taken by myself on this date and time pertaining to this case.

On August 25, 2021, I was asked to help collect evidence and take photos during a search warrant at Auburn Place Apts. 949 S. Lillian #112 Stephenville, Texas. After I arrived and took photos of the apartment Sergeant Jeremy Lanier and Detective Taylor Morrison started searching the rooms for any electronic devices. Below is a list of items collected and their location:

**Suspects bedroom:**

Black Motorola cell phone located on bed  
HP Pavilion laptop located on bed

**Mother's bedroom:**

Unknown make/model cell phone located in dresser  
LG Cricket cellphone with blue & purple case located in dresser

**Living room:**

Black Lenovo laptop with charger located on table next to couch  
Hitron modem w/charger located on floor next to couch

I then cleared the scene, transported, and secured the items into the Stephenville Police Department Property room. Sgt. Lanier took possession of the Lenovo laptop and charger and released it back to the mother Heather Schneider.

On September 22, 2021 I mailed the HP Pavilion laptop and charger to the Austin DPS Crime Lab for forensic examination. Certified mail# 7020 1810 0000 3298 5091

I received the results from the forensic examination on March 14, 2022 and forwarded them to Lt. Lanier. Do to the nature of the evidence on the digital report and laptop that was submitted it is the policy of the Austin DPS Crime Lab that the items should be picked up in person.

On March 24, 2022 I drove down to Austin DPS Crime Lab and personally received the items from crime lab tech Yvette Ruiz. The items received were the HP Pavilion laptop with charger and a thumb drive containing the digital report. I then transported the items back to the Stephenville Police Department and secured them into the property room.

**Supplemental Narrative 06/23/2022 08:45:40 JEREMY LANIER**

On 3/24/2022 the forensic examination of Cadenheads laptop were returned from the DPS lab. The forensic analysis was conducted by Kathleen Hickey with the Texas Department of Public Safety. Upon reviewing the results of the examination multiple images of child pornography were located depicting young prepubescent females engaged in sex acts or displaying their unclothed genitals. Over twenty unique images were located on the the laptop of young prepubescent unclothed and engaging in sexual activity were located on the laptop. Many images are also duplicated many times on the laptop. In addition to the images located on the laptop two videos were also recovered that depict adolescent females engaged in sexual intercourse. One video file name \$R1F8KTM.mp4 has screen captures of social media conversation between user Felix and other members and contains a video of a minor female having intercourse with an adult male with the caption, "no one cares." Additional notable images can be found in the forensic analysis of the laptop depicting self harming in the form of cutting the words, "Brad is a pedo" and "764."

Multiple audio recordings of people discussing or mentioning grooming were also located in the forensic examination. One audio recording titled \$R13K8SR.mp4 mentions "Brad" multiple times. In addition to the child pornography recovered login credentials and user names consistent with the cybertips were also located on the laptop including users names brad764, Felix, Brad76444@rape.lol.

A thumbdrive containing the forensic analysis of the laptop has been placed in evidence and this case will be forwarded to the Erath County Attorneys office.

Child Porn Tutorial By WokkelSokkel on TeleGram.

This method uses Twitter to trade the files.

The files come in a form of mega.nz links, an online cloud storage platform.

The tag #megalinks and #s2r is used to trade child porn (CP) on Twitter.

Here is a video by SomeOrdinaryGamer explaining it:

#s2r stands for send to receive.

#### 1. Intro

In this tutorial I will show you how to get child pornography in a few simple steps.

This is made for educational purposes only and I do not encourage any entity to replicate these steps.

Do this at your own risk.

#### 2. Get a VPN

A VPN is used to keep your IP address and other details that could trace back to you, safe.

The VPN is used as a man in the middle, some good VPN's are NordVPN, Surfshark, or really any other VPN will do.

What this does is it keeps your IP address safe so any feds can't lead it back to you, and get you arrested.

A Virtual Private Network (VPN) is optional, but I highly recommend it to keep yourself safe.

#### 3. Create an alternate Twitter account

Register a Twitter account under a different EMAIL ADDRESS. DO NOT USE YOUR PHONE NUMBER.

Don't use your real name or anything that could trace back to you.

Sign up for a Twitter account:

#### 4. Make a tweet with the following template

Once you've made your new Twitter account, make a tweet that looks like this:

"#megalinks #s2r Trading now, got loads of stuff. DM me!"

These 2 hashtags are extremely important. If you don't include them it won't work.

What I like to do is also add my Discord tag or Telegram to the tweet. This makes it way faster.

Example:

"#megalinks #s2r Trading mega links now! Add me on Discord: (Your tag) or Telegram: (Your username)"

#### 5. Receiving the CP

You should get a few messages in about a few hours. Be patient, or spam your Telegram/Discord under other tweets including the hashtags #megalinks and #s2r to get more people.

After about a few minutes or hours you should get your first messages or friend requests on Discord.

Ask them something along the lines of "Hey, wanna trade?"

People trade the mega.nz links with each other.

Ask them if they want to send the link first, and that you'll send it after they send you the mega.nz link.

Now you don't have any mega links or cp, so you take their mega link and store it somewhere. Upon opening the link in a browser there should be a folder with cp.

If you do have cp already, you can just trade it with them.

So, a brief recap:

You use Twitter to make a tweet that you wanna "Trade", do not state you wanna trade cp, this will get your account banned.

People contact you.

You ask them to send their mega link first.

You steal their mega link.

After you have 1 mega link, you can trade with other people for more.

This method got me about 200GB of cp (Around 25000 files) in a few days.

Brian told me he was notified by a teacher Vandenburg about the threat on 09-12-2018 at 1:00pm. Brian told me it was unfounded and he believed it did not occur after speaking to all the witnesses. Brian told me all involved have went home at this time. Brian wanted me to know in case I wanted to do any follow up investigation. I asked Brian what happened.

Brian told me he pulled Bradley into his office immediately and searched his backpack. No weapons were found. Bradley was placed in ISS for the remainder of the day as he investigated the threat.

Brian first spoke to Joey Avalos. Joey told him he was standing in the hall at first period near Mrs Rainey room(09-12-2018). Also present were James Phelps, Shana Dalley, Madison Solis, and Bradley Cadenhead. Joey told Mr Sanders he over heard Bradley say he wants to bring a gun to school and shoot the school and go home and kill kids. Joey gave a statement to Mr Sanders.

The next person Brian spoke to was Shana Dalley. Shana told Mr Sanders she didn't hear Bradley say anything about bringing a gun and shooting anybody. Shana told Mr Sanders Bradley was trying to tell her how to build a bomb the other day. Shana told Mr Sanders, Madison was also there when Bradley talked about making a bomb. Shana told Mr Sanders she just walked away. Shana was asked when did this occur. Mr Sanders was told a while back.

Mr Sanders next spoke to Madison Solis. Mr Sanders knows Madison and told me she is a trusted student. Madison told Mr Sanders that none of the threats occurred. Madison told him Bradley did not say anything about shooting up the school or making a bomb. James Phelps was called into the office and he spoke to Mr Sanders. James told Mr Sanders Bradley did not say anything about guns or shooting up the school. Mr Sanders called Bradley's mother and

spoke to Bradley as she listened in. Bradley's mother, Heather Cadenhead, did not believe Bradley made any threats. She also told Mr Sanders they do not have any weapons in the home and Bradley is watched enough that they would know if he was trying to make a bomb but he is not that type. Bradley denied all the allegations against him. No action will be taken against Bradley.

On 09-14-2018 I called Joey Avalos into the office around 11:45am and started looking into the case. Joey told me the same story as he did Mr Sanders. I recorded all interviews on body cam. I next spoke to James Phelps. James also told me Bradley did not say anything that day about shooting up the school. I next spoke to Shana. Shana also told me Bradley did not say anything about shooting up the school. Shana then told me on different day Bradley was trying to tell her how to build a bomb. Shana told me she just walked away. I asked Shana if he threaten to use a bomb. Shana told me no. I asked Shana when was this. Shana told me maybe on Monday. I asked Shana if this was so important why didn't you tell somebody then. Shana told me she didn't realize it was important until asked about the gun. I asked Shana about any other witnesses to the bomb remarks. Shana told me Madison heard it. Madison was not available but she has already told Mr Sanders that Bradley did not tell Shana how to make a bomb. Mr Sanders gave me copies of some of the statements. Mr Sanders also gave a statement. My axon video was logged onto the property page and downloaded into Evidence.com.

Henderson SISD is not going to take any action against Bradley and does not have evidence that the threat occurred. The case will be unfounded.

New evidence has come forward and I have opened the case back up.

On 09-18-2018 at approximately: 8:00pm, I, Was told by Assistant Principal Sanders that another child wanted to report threats made by Bradley Cadenhead. The child name is Ethan Barns. Ethan came to the Assistant Principals office and I recorded the interview. Ethan told me he wanted to let us know that Bradley Cadenhead had threatened to shoot up the school because Bradley hates it. Ethan told me this occurred on the first day of school. Ethan told me Bradley made another threat to shoot up the school towards the end of the first week. Then again around September the tenth Ethan told me Bradley said he wanted to carve pentagrams into the table and kill everyone. Ethan told me Bradley often says the same thing a lot as they have lockers near each other. Ethan told me he is tired of hearing Bradley make threats and wanted Mr Sanders and me to know about it. Ethan gave a written statement.

Taking into consideration the threat made last week by Bradley and the content of that threat matching Ethan's complaint does start to corroborate Joey Avalos statement too. Joey statement reads Bradley was heard saying in the hallway when break was over he wanted to shoot up the school and when he gets home he wants to kill kids. I called Joey back in and spoke to him about Bradley. Joey told me he did hear him say that and his friends are lying for him. Joey stands by his statement.

Around 12:00pm I was approached by Mrs Vandenburg, Bradley's teacher. Mrs Vandenburg told me she wanted Bradley out of her class. He was being disruptive and some of the children complained about his threats of violence against the school. Mrs Vandenburg had overheard Bradley fixation on violent behavior's. She had heard him talk about getting guns and putting silencer on them, making bombs, and watching violent killing videos on you tube. Mrs Vandenburg told me she was afraid he was building his courage up to do such things. Mrs Vandenburg was upset and was very concerned for her class room safety and she told me her class room aid Mrs Ketchum felt the same way.

Today Bradley lashed out at Mrs Vandenburg when she told him to stop talking about gang killing and bloods and crips. Mrs Vandenburg told him she didn't want to hear it. Bradley

yelled back at Mrs Vandenburg he didn't want to hear what she had to say either. Mrs Vandenburg sent him to the office but Bradley detoured and went to lunch. Mrs Vandenburg gave a written statement.

With all the statements and subject matter being the same I believe Bradley is making threats to students. Bradley's demeanor since I have started working at Henderson Junior High is sullen and angry young man. He comes to school with a attitude of I hate this place and I have heard him say so as he enters the school and is walking down the hall.

I met with the Erath County Attorney Lisa Pence and we discussed the statements and threats by Bradley. What makes the past complaints come to light is the fact that teachers are now coming forward about Bradley's behavior and threats. Mrs Vandenburg feels threatened as does her aid Mrs Ketchum.

Bradley was taken into custody by myself and Officer Totts. Bradley is being charged with Terroristic Threat. I called Bradley's mother and asked her to meet us at Judge Bass' office. I told Mrs Bettis the school councilor what was occurring and we had called the parents. I also contacted Assistant Principal Sanders and advised him of the situation. The school wishes to seek charges in this case.

I transported Bradley to Judge Bass' Office in the Erath County Court House Annex. Judge Bass Magstrated Bradley. Bradley parents refused to let me question Bradley. I explained the complaint to them and read the statements against Bradley. I asked Bradley's parents to take Bradley to the PD. Bradley was then fingerprinted and pictured as required. Juvenile Probation was called and they asked that Bradley be released to his parents and wanted them to come to thier office. Bradley was released to his parents and they proceeded to the JPO office.



Violations listed below (# 30, 4, 8, 10, 25 on probation orders):

May 31, 2019 telecounseling had to be stopped because he refused to participate or cooperate with the telecounselors. He had been in telecounseling for 7 months and had not participated most of the time while in the program.

June 8, 2019 both Bradley's parents reported he had left home without permission and went to James Phelps house, who is involved with ECJP, and was refusing to return home

June 13, 2019 JPO and CJPO did a unannounced house visit and his mom informed us he was at another juveniles home, James Phelps, that is on conditions of release with ECJP. His mom said that Bradley refused to return home for several days

June 13, 2019 JPO and CJPO did a home visit at Phelps house and found Bradley there. JPO instructed him he had to return home and couldn't be around Phelps. Both juveniles began yelling and cussing at both JPOs. JPO's were also informed they had caused damage to the home during the early morning hours to a window and door.

June 13 or 14, 2019 He took approximately 10 prescription Tylenol 650mg pills and consumed half a bottle of cough syrup. He initially said this was to commit suicide and after his initial ICU to stabilize his health, he was transported to Red River Hospital in Wichita Falls. He told that hospital he took the meds to get high. I understand he also tested positive in the hospital for marijuana.

June 19, 2019 He assaulted his mother at an MHMR meeting which she called SPD but the refused to file an assault charges or notify our dept, they just told mom to restrain him. His mom did report this to me.

June 27, 2019 He refused to answer all questions for the Noble Pact which is used for case planning. During this meeting he kept cussing at JPO and JPO had to ask him to leave this appointment for a while due to his behavior.

It was also reported by his dad that he had been running around the streets with Phelps during June 8 to June 15 without being supervised by an adult.

I have him scheduled to meet for substance abuse counseling tomorrow and he will have to meet the provider weekly so I will let you know if there are any issues with him participating.

**Present Referral(s):**

Bradley Cadenhead was referred to the Erath County Juvenile Probation Department by the Stephenville Police Department on August 27, 2021, for Possession of Child Pornography (F3). Bradley was residing at the time of referral with his mother, Heather Schneider, and his older sister Courtney. A detention hearing was held on this date and Bradley was detained at Rite of Passage Lake Granbury Youth Services due to the parent/guardian lacking sufficient parent skills to provide adequate supervision of the child.

Lt., Jeremy Lanier, the investigator for this case, reports that on June 15, 2021, June 30, 2021, August 16, 2021, and August 23, 2021, he received a cyber tip from Jenna Ethridge of the Dallas Police Department's Child Exploitation Unit informing Detective Lanier of informed Cyber Tipline report that tied back to the Stephenville area. The files contained Cyber Tipline reports #87769353, 87991913, 88151471, 88972106, 89330877, 90110478, 90503314, 90527266, 90557061, 90672592, 90672610, 90767084, 90767183, 90857658, 90864321, 90965728, 90965764, 91080620, 91148233, 91216845, 91216852, 91423427, 91505578, 91646789, 91783713, 91823210, 91824038, 91857948, 91946171, 92033588, 9220246, 92202470, 92291606, 92375488, 92386272, 92462260, 92501670, 92501744, 92501913, 92598502, 92687503, 92791313, 93043597, 93186653, 93438118, 93438171, 93545496, 94982279.

95169749, 95243964, 91216816, 91325392, 91423430, 91857914, 91946170, 92752515, 92756473, and 92762899. Lanier reports that the cyber tips show images of prepubescent females and males engaging in sexual acts or various poses nude. The tips show Discord as the reporting party. It also showed that the user profile screen name was reported as Felix.#923, Brad, Felix AKA Brad, Brad 764, or various combinations of Felix. The IP address that was used to upload the images and flagged was 97.21.188.121. The IP address was returned to Northland Cable television and with a Stephenville address.

Stephenville Police Department sent a subpoena on July 6, 2021, to Northland Cable requesting all subscribers' information related to the IP address that was associated with the child pornography that originated in Stephenville, Texas. Northland Cable returned the information and showed that the subscriber was named Heather Schneider (address: 949 S. Lillian St, APT#112 Stephenville, Texas 76401). An account search through Lexis Nexis for Heather Schneider revealed that she had the email Bradley.Cadenhead@gmail.com associated with her. An additional cyber tip #92919008 was sent to Lt. Lanier from Jenna Ethridge on June 13, 2021, reporting that Bradley Ortiz and Felix AKA Brad had been distributing child pornography on the Discord server. Stephenville Police department verified that Heather Schneider was still residing in apartment number 112 with her son Bradley Cadenhead.

Lt. Lanier completed an Affidavit for Evidentiary search warrant that was signed on August 25, 2021, by Honorable Judge Blake Thompson with the Erath County Court at Law. The warrant was executed on this day and multiple electronics were recovered from the home including a laptop computer and a cellphone from Bradley's room. The laptop was seized and the lock screen showed the username of the computer was Brad764.

A search warrant was obtained on August 27, 2021, to forensically examine the black Pavilion laptop that was obtained from the first warrant. On August 30, 2021, Bradley was released from Rite of Passage Lake Granbury Youth Services on Conditions of Release with an ankle monitor and was placed to live with his father, Jefferey Cadenhead (835 W. Vanderbilt St. Stephenville, Texas 76401).

On June 23, 2022, Stephenville Police Department released to the Erath County Juvenile Probation department a supplement to Bradley's Current pending offense report. In the supplement, Property/Crime SC Tech, Jeanine Parmentier, reports that on September 22, 2021, she mailed the HP pavilion laptop and charger to the Austin DPS Crime Lab for forensic examination. On March 14, 2022, Property/Crime SC Tech, Parmentier received the results from the examination of the seized items in this case and they were sent to Lt. Lanier. Due to the nature of the evidence on the digital report and laptop that was submitted to the Austin DPS crime lab for the forensic examination, Property/Crime SC Tech, Parmentier needed to pick up these items in person. On March 24, 2022, Property/Crime SC Tech, Parmentier drove to Austin DPS Crime Lab and personally received the items from Crime Lab Tech, Yvette Ruiz. The items received were the HP Pavilion laptop with a charger and a thumb drive containing the digital report. On March 24, 2022, Lt. Lanier received and reviewed the forensic examination of Bradley's laptop that Property/Crime SC Tech Parmentier forward from the DPS lab. Lt. Lanier reports that the forensic analysis was conducted by Kathleen Hickey with the Texas Department of Public Safety. Upon reviewing the results of the examination multiple images of child pornography were located depicting young prepubescent females engaged in sex acts or displaying their unclothed genitals. Over twenty unique images were located on the laptop of young prepubescent unclothed and engaging in sexual activity were located on the laptop. Many images were duplicated multiple times on the laptop. In addition, Lt. Lanier, reports that the images located on the laptop were two videos that were recovered, that

depict adolescent females engaging in sexual intercourse. One video file named \$R1F8KTM.mp4 has screen captures of social media conversations, between user Felix and other members, and contains a video of a minor female having intercourse with an adult male with the caption "no one cares." In the report Lt. Lanier notes that images can be found in the forensic analysis of the laptop depicting self-harming in the form of cutting the words, "Brad is a pedo" and "764."

Lt. Lanier reports on the supplement that multiple audio recordings of people discussing or mentioning grooming were located in forensic examination. One audio recording titled \$R13K8SR.mp4 mentions "Brad" multiple times. In addition to the child pornography that was recovered Lt. Lanier recovered login credentials and user names consistent with the cyber tips he received, which were located in the laptop including user names brad764, Felix, [Brad764447rape.lol](#).

#### **The States Petition**

The States Petition for Discretionary Transfer to Criminal Court was filed on March 08, 2022. The Petition includes sixty-two alleged Counts of Felony offenses. The offenses included in the petition are the second-degree offense of Promotion of Child Pornography and the third-degree felony offenses of Possession of Child Pornography that were committed when Bradley was fifteen years of age between March 17, 2021, through June 22, 2021.

#### **Family History:**

Heather Schneider and Jefferey Cadenhead were married in December 2000. Before this marriage, Mrs. Schneider had a daughter, who currently resides with her today named, Courtney Alexander (27 years old). Mr. Cadenhead had two children from his previous marriage; a daughter named Amanda Cadenhead who currently resides in El Paso, Texas (26 years old), and a son named David Cadenhead (25 years old) who currently lives in Arlington, Texas. On August 21, 2005, Bradley Chance Cadenhead was born in Stephenville, Texas.

The family resided in Stephenville, Texas and Ms. Schneider reported that Amanda and David lived with their biological mother after Bradley was a year and a half old. She and Mr. Cadenhead described that their family was involved in their church, Washington Baptist Church. Mr. Cadenhead was in charge of the music, the recording, and the website. Ms. Schneider and her daughter Courtney sang in church services. Both parents report that Bradley played soccer as a young child, but he did not care for it after the age of seven.

Around 2011 both parents reported that Bradley did not like attending church due to the Pastor's grandson's picking at him. Mr. Cadenhead mentioned that Ms. Schneider left the church around that same time and she started attending Harvey Church. Ms. Schneider said Mr. Cadenhead refused to change religion and that he would continue to take Bradley to church with him. Ms. Schneider said this caused issues in their marriage and they started marriage counseling around the last year they lived together.

Ms. Schneider moved out of the family home sometime in June 2016. Bradley's paternal grandmother stepped in to help Mr. Cadenhead raise Bradley when he was at work. Mr. Cadenhead reports that Bradley was mad at his mother when he found out she moved out of the home. Mr. Cadenhead mentioned that during the beginning of the separation he and Bradley got along well and that they would spend time together and attend church functions. Ms. Schneider obtained standard visitation rights with Bradley during the separation process.

During this time, Ms. Schneider relays that she was drinking a lot and partying. She mentioned

that when Bradley would come over she would be at the pool, drinking, and hanging out with friends.

Around January 2017, Mr. Cadenhead reports that Bradley started "acting out." The more time he spent with his mother the worse his behavior became. He mentioned that Bradley even idolized Ms. Schneider's boyfriend at one point. Mr. Cadenhead described Ms. Schneider's boyfriend as a bad influence who was in and out of prison his whole life. In March 2017, Mr. Cadenhead and Ms. Schneider's divorce was finalized.

Ms. Schneider and Mr. Cadenhead both recounted that Bradley was still manageable around the fall of 2017 when he started 7<sup>th</sup> grade. They mentioned that he wanted to play football, but broke his arm at the beginning of the season. Mrs. Schneider reported that she noticed a "big change" after that point.

Both parents mentioned that Bradley started hanging out with another teenager at the end of 2017. Ms. Schneider reports that she was at first happy that Bradley made a new friend because he did not have any and he was bullied a lot in school. However, she mentioned that over time she realized that it was a toxic friendship. The other teenager had behavioral issues and they started to feed off of each other's behavior. Bradley started leaving the home whenever he wanted and acting out.

In the summer of 2018, Ms. Schneider reports that Bradley became very ill and was throwing up all night. She took him to the emergency room and that's when he admitted to taking pills and cough syrup. Bradley was in ICU for three days. Once he was released from the hospital, he was transported by the Sheriff's office to Red River. Both parents recalled that they were not aware at that time that Bradley was trying to get high. They both reported they thought he was just trying to harm himself.

On September 18, 2018, Bradley obtained his first offense for Terroristic threat cause Fear of Imminent SBI (MB). Bradley was placed on Conditions of release on September 18, 2018. During this time both parents became aware that Bradley was drinking alcohol and smoking marijuana. Bradley was placed on Court Order Probation on June 06, 2019. While on Court Order Probation Bradley had compliance issues and was detained in Grayson County on August 22, 2019. Bradley was then moved from detention to a placement program with Rockdale Academy on August 28, 2019. Bradley was in Rockdale Academy for a six-month program and completed placement on February 13, 2020. Bradley resided with his father after his release from placement with. On June 3, 2020, Bradley completed Court Order Probation.

After his release from juvenile probation, Bradley went to live with his mother around August 2020. Ms. Schneider reports that Bradley started ninth grade and he seemed happy. She mentioned that he would get up and get dressed. However, he started getting sick, often throwing up and his anxiety worsened. Both parents reported that he only attended school the first week of 9<sup>th</sup> grade and that he started not wanting to go anymore. In January 2021, Ms. Schneider said she received a phone call that she needed to unenroll Bradley because he had too many truancy days and she would receive a truancy charge. Ms. Schneider mentioned that Bradley had become secluded and was in his room all the time. She mentioned that she did not know what was going on with Bradley and was in shock when he was detained in August 2021 for his current pending offense.

Bradley reported that he has lived in Stephenville all his life and that the longest family home setting he lived in was before his parent's separation. He stated he lived with his mother Heather, father Jeffery, and half-sister, Courtney. He reported that he does not remember much of his childhood, but remembers playing soccer for one year, but was not interested in it. He said his family attended church and that he liked it. He enjoyed church camp and said that the challenges

against everyone were fun. He described that during the camps they would go swimming and just hang out with church friends.

Bradley stated that when his mother moved out of the home, his sister, Courtney, was not residing with the family because she had moved out after high school graduation. Bradley reported that he felt different, and it was not the same after his mom moved out. Bradley described that when "My mom moved out it affected me. I stopped caring about everything."

**Housing:**

Bradley has lived on and off with both parents since their divorce in 2017. As of March 5, 2022, Bradley is currently residing with his mother Heather at 1203 N. Dale St. Stephenville, Texas. His older half-sister, Courtney, and mom's boyfriend currently live in the home. The home has three bedrooms, two restrooms, a living room, a kitchen, a sunroom, and an enclosed backyard.

**Family Criminal History: N/A**

**Intra-Family Relationships:**

Ms. Schneider describes her relationship with Bradley: *"Bradley is a momma's boy. I knew he would be my last child. Bradley and I share a son and mother bond. He was such a hugger but is not as much anymore. When Bradley was born I stayed home with him just to soak him up. I started working around the time he started second grade. He was such a good child; he liked school until he started getting bullied around 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Before and when Bradley was born our family took a lot of vacations and we attended church events. When Bradley became older it was harder for us to take vacations. I think that when I moved out of the home and my behavior during the first year or so of leaving contributed to Bradley's behavior and, at times, I feel responsible. When Bradley went to placement I would go visit him often. He came out a different child. He would smile and hug me. He cared about the way he looked, and he would talk to me. I do not know what changed, but he started feeling sick again in 9<sup>th</sup> grade, and then he just secluded himself. I think he feels like he was left out, is an outsider, and is awkward. When he was arrested in August 2021, I was disgusted, devastated, and scared. Since then, he shut down his communication with me. We still hang out, watch movies, and eat together, but I feel the distance between us. Bradley has a good heart and he wants to take care of me. I want Bradley to turn his life around, obtain his GED, and be a productive member of society. He needs to obtain a job, continue to take his medication, and deal with his mental health. He is well behaved at home and does the chores that I ask him to complete."*

Bradley's relationship with his sister, Courtney, is described by Ms. Schneider: *"He gets along with his sister. Before, his first offense in 2018, she would help out with him a lot. She kind of took a parent role for Bradley. He listens to her more than his dad and me. When Bradley was on probation, Courtney started to distance herself from him because his behavior became overwhelming. When he was in placement, she went with me to see him and after he was released they worked on their bond again. When Bradley obtained his current offense, she was disgusted and angry with him. They had a confrontation that led to me stepping in to stop it. She is devastated about the situation but is currently in counseling and this has helped her with Bradley's situation."*

Bradley's described his relationship with his sister, Courtney: *"We have gone through a lot together. She was like my partner in crime. I can talk to her about things that I cannot talk to with*

*my mom. She does a lot of stuff for me, we watch movies together, and I know she is worried about my current situation."*

*Bradley describes relation with his father, Mr. Cadenhead: "We talk, but are not close. Before my mother moved out of the home my relationship with my dad was good. After my mom moved out our relationship fell apart because we were feeding off each other's negativity."*

*Mr. Cadenhead's relationship with Bradley: "Bradley and I got along well even after his mother moved out of the home. We attended Church events, played football outside, and even went to play laser tag together. Bradley has always had a different style of humor and has been a bit mischievous since he was younger. I noticed a big change in Bradley when he started going to his mother's home during visitations. He started idolizing his mom's boyfriend, and his behavior changed. He was inappropriate at times, Bradley started acting out in church and at home. It started to progress until he ended up on probation and was placed at Rockdale Academy. When he moved back to his moms in August 2020, he just became secluded. I would try and take him to school, but he would refuse to. I was shocked to learn about his offense, but I allowed him to come live with me after the detention hearing. I requested he follow certain rules when he came to live with me. Bradley seems to enjoy pushing others' buttons by picking at them; he has done this with me. While he lived in my home, he did not follow certain rules. We had issues and I no longer wanted him in my home. I am concerned for the safety of Bradley if he is transferred to be charged as an adult. I think he will flip out and will try to commit suicide and he could be successful if he does not have 24<sup>7</sup> supervision. I do not wish my son to be sent to prison, but perhaps a facility that can help him deal with certain issues and provide him a routine."*

*Bradley Describes his relationship with his mother Ms. Schneider: "I feel distant from my mom right now. She is just going through female stuff and she is struggling with finding a new job. I liked her boyfriend Mike at first, but I feel like he is using her."*

*Bradley describes his relationship with his sister, Amanda: "My sister and I have been talking more. She is getting married in July 2022, and our relationship is going good right now."*

**Financial Information:**

Mr. Cadenhead has been employed at Touchstone Ranch Recovery since June 2014 and makes around \$41,000 per year.

Ms. Schneider just started employment with Good Tree, on June 26, 2022, and makes \$14 per hour.

**Health and Mental History:**

Ms. Schneider advised that Bradley has high triglyceride due to his medication (Seroquel) and has gained weight.

Both parents report that he has always had stomach issues and that they have taken him to the doctor, but there has been no explanation. He takes a lot of tums to deal with it.

Seroquel 250mg (only as needed)

Bradley is about five ft and 11 ½ inches tall and weighs around 195 pounds, he has red hair and blue eyes. He claims he has one birthmark on his chest that is the size of a dime. Bradley has been hospitalized four times since the summer of 2018.

Bradley reported that in December of 2016 he started self-cutting. He mentioned that he did this because other kids at school were doing it and they showed their cuts and scratches to him. Bradley reported that from there he got the idea of inflicting pain and decided to do this to himself. Bradley has self-inflicted scars on his left arm from self-cutting.

Ms. Schneider described that the first hospitalization happened because Bradley had been extremely sick and was throwing up all night. She reported that she took him to the emergency room and he was in the ICU for three days. On his release date, the Stephenville Police Department transported him to Red River due to him admitting to his mother that he took pills and cough syrup. Bradley told his parents that he was just trying to get high and that he was not trying to commit suicide. He reported that was incorrect and that he was just attempting to get his girlfriend's attention. He relays that it was not the first time he had taken medication and drank cough syrup to get high. Dad reported that Bradley was in Red River for about six days.

Ms. Schneider reported that the second hospitalization was around August 2019. Bradley threatened to kill his father and was then transported to Red River for about seven days. His parents reported that when he was released from Red River, he was immediately transported to Grayson County Department of Juvenile Services after a detention hearing was held.

Bradley was hospitalized on January 26, 2022, at Perimeter Behavioral Hospital in Dallas due to a meltdown hearing voices "to kill them all". Bradley was released on February 1, 2022.

On February 3, 2022, Mr. Cadenhead took Bradley to the ER due to self-harming in the living room. Bradley advised that he blacked out and does not recall what happened during that time. Bradley was hospitalized at Hickory Trail Hospital on February 4, 2022, and released on February 11, 2022. Mr. Cadenhead provided the documentation for this hospitalization and Bradley was diagnosed with Bipolar, depression, and unspecified anxiety disorder.

Prior to this current pending offense, Bradley did receive therapy in placement at Rockdale Academy from August 22, 2019, to February 28, 2020. Bradley continued to take his medication after his release from placement and he and his mother reported that he stopped taking his medication a week into 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

Since October 12, 2021, Bradley has been seeing a psychiatrist in Brownwood. He is currently taking the medication that his psychiatrist has prescribed for him. He mentioned that he does not feel like the medication is helping and he feels blank and unhappy.

Bradley reports that after placement in Rockdale Academy, he did not continue counseling. Around March 2022, his mother had him start counseling services with Accell health. Bradley reports that he likes his counselor, but does not feel like he is able to be honest with her.

Bradley reported that he has had anxiety issues for a while now and this causes him issues with attending school.

Ms. Schneider disclosed her concerns for Bradley. She reported that Bradley told her boyfriend, that if he is sent to adult prison or if he has to register as a sex offender he will commit suicide. She reported that he mentioned to her boyfriend Mike that he would complete this action by overdosing with medication. Since then she has locked up all the medication in her home and he has no current access to it.

**Physical, Sexual, Neglect, or Emotional Abuse:**

Both parents reported that Bradley went through a lot of bullying in school and, in some ways, in the church. They both reported that they went to the school to talk to the administration about the bullying and nothing was done. They talked to the Pastor (the grandfather of the kids that picked on Bradley) and they talked to the kids doing the bullying about their behavior. However, Ms. Schneider felt like it was not addressed and Mr. Cadenhead described that after speaking with the Pastor's grandson's boys that the picking on Bradley stopped. Mr. Cadenhead does not describe the church incidents as bullying.

Both parents reported that due to Bradley's current offense they are concerned that maybe he suffered some type of abuse, but have never asked Bradley about it.

Bradley did not make any reports for physical, sexual, neglectful, or emotional abuse.

**Substance Abuse History:**

Ms. Schneider described that Bradley started drinking alcohol, taking pills, and smoking marijuana around 2018. Mr. Cadenhead became aware of the drug use when Bradley was on Conditions of Release in July 2019 and tested positive for marijuana.

Bradley said that he first drank alcohol at the age of eleven or twelve with an older friend. He said that after that he drank randomly and stopped while he was in placement in August 2019. He said he started drinking again in May of 2021, and that the last time was on his sixteenth birthday. Bradley said that he would drink alcohol to feel happy.

Bradley reported that he first used marijuana around the age of eleven. He said that he did it about another two times at that age. However, he reports that at age twelve through thirteen he started smoking marijuana anytime he could. He stated that sometimes he would get marijuana for free and other times he would use his money from mowing lawns to pay for the marijuana.

Bradley reports that other drugs he used to get high were oxycontin which was prescribed. He also reported that he would sell these pills at school to make extra money. Bradley stated that he would take pills with cough syrup to obtain a high. Bradley reports that he last used cough syrup or pills a week after his release from placement and did not enjoy it. He reports that was the last time he tried that.

Bradley was drug-screened on July 30, 2022, and there were no positive results.

**Education:**

Mr. Cadenhead reports that Bradley struggled with math growing up and in fifth grade, he had a hard time with reading. Bradley was placed in remedial classes in 7<sup>th</sup> grade and was placed in the behavioral room at some point in Junior High here in Stephenville. However, both parents are uncertain of the grade level at which this happened. Bradley repeated the eighth grade twice due to him not wanting to go to school and not passing his grade level. In the fall of 2020, Bradley started ninth grade in Stephenville High School and attend about a week of school. Ms. Reports that he missed too many days of school that fall semester and that it was recommended she

unenrolled him around January 2021 to prevent truancy charges.

Ms. Schneider mentioned that she would like Bradley to obtain his GED and wants to obtain information from the Texas Workforce.

Bradley reported that he is uncertain if he wants to obtain his GED, due to the uncertain outcome of his current pending offense.

**Hobbies and Interests:**

Both parents reported that Bradley enjoys drawing and playing video games.

Bradley stated that he enjoys drawing, playing video games, and is uncertain where or what he would like to do when he gets older.

**Religion:**

Bradley is uncertain about his religion or faith.

**Employment:**

Bradley is not employed at this time, nor has he been in the past. Bradley seems interested in seeking employment.

**Psychological Evaluations:**

Bradley completed a psychological evaluation on October 24, 2018, with Altman Psychological Services, PLLC. Dr. Daniel Altman.

**Child's attitude:**

Bradley was previously under the supervision of Juvenile Probation Officer Jennifer Thurman during his first referral to Erath County Juvenile Probation and current referral. However, JPO Thurman is no longer employed with Erath County Juvenile Probation, and Bradley has been under this Officer's supervision since December 14, 2021. This Officer has seen Bradley in his home and at the probation office at least once a week since obtaining supervision under conditions of release. Bradley was placed on an ankle monitor on August 30, 2021, and has not had any issues or violations. He has been cooperative during our meetings and seemed to understand during the social history that this report was being completed to provide to the court for Transfer hearing to Criminal Court. He seemed to understand that he could be transferred to adult proceedings due to the nature of the alleged offense and the States Petition filed with sixty counts. Bradley mentioned, "I knew what I was doing was bad, but I did not know how serious it was." During the social history report. He also mentioned, "I looked up the possible sentence I could face for these allegations prior to being arrested." Bradley did try to express remorse for the victims. However, this Officer did not allow Bradley to give any more information about his offense. He was advised to speak with his attorney and to answer questions without details of his case. When asked who is to blame for the alleged counts Bradley stated "Someone introduced me to it and I continued to do it. I am to blame."

**Disposition Recommendations:**

Bradley Chance Cadenhead, who is sixteen years of age when the state filed its original petition for discretionary transfer to criminal court on March 08, 2022, was born on August 21, 2005, and was fifteen when he committed sixty-two alleged felony counts. No adjudication hearing has been conducted concerning these offenses and according to the state, because of the seriousness of the offense and the background of the child, the welfare of the community requires that the Juvenile Court waive jurisdiction and that Bradley should be transferred to Erath County District Court for criminal proceedings concerning the alleged offenses on said Petition that was filed on March 08, 2022. The sophistication and maturity of the child have been addressed in the diagnostic evaluation by Dr. David M. Sabine.

If the court finds there is probable cause for "each" second-degree offense of Promotion of Child Pornography and the third-degree felony offense of "each" Possession of Child Pornography, then it is recommended that Bradley Chance Cadenhead be transferred to the Erath County District Court for criminal proceedings.
