NARRATIVE		The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant on the 01 day of November, 2018, at approximately 0030 p.m. at 35 Alicante Road DEBARY within Volusia County, violated the law and did the following:											
<p>1 unlawfully kill another human being by premeditated design, to wit:</p> <p>2</p> <p>3 On 11/02/18 at approximately 1552 hours, deputies responded to 35 Alicante Road, Debary, in reference to a burglary to a residence.</p> <p>4</p> <p>5 While deputies were en-route to the residence the reporting party, Gregory Ramos (A juvenile resident), advised the 9-1-1 operator that his mother's</p> <p>6 vehicle (A 2007 Tan Toyota Van bearing Florida license plate "196WLP" was parked in the driveway, unlocked and running. Ramos advised the</p> <p>7 residence was completely ransacked and his mother, Gail Cleavenger, was missing. Deputies conducted a safety sweep of the residence, and</p> <p>8 observed the pedestrian door on the south side of the house to have been forced open (inwardly broken door frame), by unknown means. Inside the</p> <p>9 residence, the deputies observed drawers and cabinets open, with their contents strewn about the floor. Just inside the front door, deputies observed</p> <p>10 a blood droplet on the tile floor, where the entryway leads into the kitchen/dining room.</p> <p>11</p> <p>12 Detectives Tucker and Martin responded to the residence and observed the vehicle still to be running, and almost out of gas. Deputies contacted</p> <p>13 Gail's employer, Rhodes and Brito Architects Inc., who confirmed Gail was an active employee, and she was a no call no show for work today. They</p> <p>14 further advised they attempted to contact Gail on her cell phone at approximately 1030 hours (approximately two and half hours after her start time),</p> <p>15 however, her phone went straight to voicemail. Deputies and Detectives made contact with all of Gail's immediately family, who advised the last</p>

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16 person to see or speak to Gail was her son, Gregory, at approximately 0630 hours. Gregory advised this was the last time he had seen or spoken to
 17 Gail (his mother). Gregory advised he arrived at 35 Alicante Road (his home) at approximately 1545 hours, after being dropped off by the school bus.
 18 Upon his arrival, he observed the aforementioned and called 9-1-1. Gregory advised Gail's normal routine was to drop him off at school between
 19 0630-0645 hours, and then drive to the DeBary SunRail Station, located at 630 S. Charles R. Beall Blvd., DeBary to catch the 0700 hours train to go
 20 to work in Orlando. Gregory advised upon arriving in Orlando, Gail would then ride her bicycle to her workplace (Rhodes and Brito Architects Inc.,
 21 located at 605 E. Robinson Street Suite #750). Inside the aforementioned running Toyota Van was Gail's bicycle.
 22
 23 When speaking with Gregory, Detectives observed fresh superficial scratches on his face on the bridge of his nose and underneath both eyes. When
 24 asked, Gregory advised he was injured during a fight a school with his friend "Dylan".
 25
 26 After the conversation Gregory was speaking to his father, Daniel Cleavenger, who asked him about the injuries to his face, at which point Detectives
 27 overheard Gregory state that he had fallen down the stairs at school. After hearing a different explanation, detectives asked Gregory again how he
 28 was injured, to which he stated, "I got into a fight with my friend Joel, but everything is fine now, we made up."
 29
 30 Detectives asked Gregory what he did after being dropped off at school by Gail. Gregory advised he attended school from approximately 0700 hours
 31 until 1445 hours, which is the end of school. Gregory advised he attended every class for the day. Following school, Gregory rode the school bus
 32 home, at which time he discovered the burglary had occurred, and his mother was missing.
 33
 34 Detectives then contacted the Volusia County School Board and learned Gregory checked himself out of school at approximately 1300 hours, and he
 35 did not ride any Volusia County School Board buses on 11/02/18.
 36
 37 Due to the increasing discrepancies, detectives asked Gregory about what he did on 11/01/18 leading into 11/02/18. Initially Gregory stated on
 38 11/01/18 he came home from school, had dinner with his mother, Gail, did homework, and went to bed. Gregory advised he did argue with Gail over
 39 a "D" grade in one of his classes, to which he was grounded for prior to going to bed.
 40
 41 Gregory later advised after being disciplined by Gail he went into his room and pretended to be asleep. At approximately 0030 hours on 11/02/18,
 42 Gregory snuck into Gail's room and took his cell phone (A Boost Gray LG Smart phone in a red silicone case). Gregory advised he had to sneak into
 43 Gail's room to retrieve the cell phone due to a previous disciplinary issue, wherein his phone was to be kept in his parents' room at night. Gregory
 44 advised after taking his phone back he called several friends to come and pick him up. Gregory advised upon their arrival at approximately 0130
 45 hours, Gregory decided to steal Gail's vehicle (The Toyota Van), to take he and his friends to get alcohol. Gregory advised he and his friends traveled
 46 to an unknown 7-11 and then to a church in DeBary with a fire pit behind it. Gregory advised throughout the night he and his friends traveled via the
 47 van between his residence (35 Alicante Drive) and the church with the fire pit. Sometime after 0500 hours, Gregory and his friends travel back to 35
 48 Alicante Drive. Gregory's friends leave and he goes inside. Gregory then got ready for school and laid down to nap before Gail woke up. At
 49 approximately 0600 hours Gail wakes up and goes into Gregory's room and wakes him up. Gail then drove Gregory to University High School and
 50 dropped him off at approximately 0640 hours.
 51
 52 Gregory advised he attended school until approximately 1300 hours, when he met up with his friends (Dylan, and unknown other friends), and left
 53 school. Gregory advised Dylan drove him to 35 Alicante Drive to "Get money", and then went back to the church with the fire pit. Gregory advised
 54 when he went home his residence was observed intact and normal. Gregory and his friends hung out at the church until approximately 1530 hours,
 55 until he was driven to Naranja Road and Highbanks Road, and dropped off. Gregory then walked south down Naranja Road to Alicante Road and
 56 south on Alicante Road to his residence. Upon arriving at the residence is when he observed Gail's Toyota van parked in the driveway(running) and
 57 the home to be ransacked.
 58
 59 On 11/02/2018, at approximately 2200 hours, Detectives Cox and Wheeler responded to 811 Fairbairn Court, Deltona, in reference to making contact
 60 with Dylan Ceglarek. Dylan was identified as a potential best friend of Gregory's during an earlier interview with Gregory's family members. Dylan
 61 was also later mentioned in Gregory's interview. Upon arrival to the residence, detectives made contact with Dylan's guardians, his grandparents
 62 Joseph and Marion Capizzi. Detectives spoke with Joseph and Marion briefly and asked if they could speak with Dylan. Joseph and Marion agreed
 63 and sat with detectives as they spoke with Dylan. Dylan was asked if he knew why detectives were there to speak with him in which he denied.
 64 Detectives advised Gregory's mother was missing and they needed to speak with anyone who may have information about the family. Dylan
 65 acknowledged. Detectives spoke with Dylan about his relationship with Gregory in which he attempted to minimize by saying Gregory was his math
 66 tutor. Dylan stated the last time he saw Gregory was today (11/02/2018) during lunch at school (University High School). Dylan stated Gregory sat

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67 by himself which was not unusual. Dylan stated he left school at approximately 1345 hours with a friend, Brian, who drove him home before work.
 68 Dylan advised he gets to leave early because of his work schedule. Dylan denied seeing Gregory after the lunch hour. Dylan claimed he went to
 69 work in Sanford between 1530 and 1700 hours when he was picked up by his grandmother. Detectives believed Dylan was being untruthful with his
 70 answers and confronted him with inconsistencies. Dylan finally confirmed he left school with Gregory and Brian. After changing his story multiple
 71 times, Dylan eventually admitted he and Brian picked Gregory up on the way to school around 0615 hours this morning (11/02/2018) and on the way
 72 to school Gregory told them he killed his mother. Dylan advised Gregory needed assistance after school at the residence to stage a "robbery", so he
 73 Dylan and Brian left school with Gregory to Gregory's residence of 35 Alicante Road, DeBary. Upon arrival, Dylan claimed the house was a mess.
 74 Dylan advised Gregory provided him and Brian several items to store at their residences, so it would appear they were stolen during the "robbery."
 75 Dylan advised some of the property Gregory gave him was in his closet and later showed it to detectives. Dylan provided the location of additional
 76 property from Gregory's residence in a dumpster near a Winn Dixie in Deltona. Dylan also stated he was given a rifle by Gregory but he did not want
 77 to take it back to his house, so he hid it in the woods near a church on Highbanks Road in DeBary. Dylan advised there was additional property
 78 hidden in the woods near the church and he was willing to show it to detectives. Detectives asked Dylan if Gregory's mother was buried near the
 79 church in which he denied having knowledge but later admitted she was buried near a fire pit behind the church. The initial information provided by
 80 Dylan was sworn to. After it was determined he may have criminal involvement in this case, he was read and waived his Miranda Rights. This was
 81 audio recorded. A consent to search was signed by Joseph and Marion for detectives to recover the property from inside Dylan's closet which was
 82 given to him by Gregory. Dylan then guided Detectives Cox and Wheeler to the 267 E Highbanks Road (River City Presbyterian). Upon arrival,
 83 Dylan walked detectives toward the woods and through a path to a fire pit area. Dylan advised detectives the fire pit area is where Gregory buried
 84 his mother. Dylan then showed detectives a rifle hidden in the woods as well as multiple electronics which he advised he helped Gregory hide after
 85 they left school. Dylan advised Gregory told him he did not use any weapons when he killed his mother, so he did not think the firearm was involved.
 86 While near the fire pit, Dylan advised around 1500 hours when they were hiding the property in the woods, he remembered seeing drag marks
 87 coming from the parking lot area down to the pit. During the investigation, Dylan apologized for initially lying to detectives but he did not want anyone
 88 to get into trouble and that is why he assisted Gregory in hiding the property from his residence.
 89
 90 Detective Johnson responded to the rear parking lot of Crunch Fitness located at 1200 Deltona Blvd., after investigating detectives received
 91 information evidence possibly was in the dumpsters. Detective Johnson and Detective Sgt. Cobb was able to locate the possible evidence in the
 92 dumpster behind door #53. Detective Johnson observed a white printer, silver radio, and black DVD player in the dumpster, which matched the
 93 property detectives were advising missing from the 35 Alicante Road. VCSO Crime Scene Unit Detectives responded and recovered the property
 94 from the dumpster (See CSU Supplement).
 95
 96 Detective Johnson then received instructions from Detective Sgt. Cobb to respond to 240 W. Embassy Drive, in Deltona to interview Brian Porras
 97 (defendant). Detectives Johnson and Wheeler were able to make consensual contact with Brian who agreed to speak with detectives. During the
 98 interview, detectives advised Brian they were investigating a burglary at Gregory's residence. Brian acknowledged he knew Gregory and Dylan.
 99 Detective Johnson told Brian that he was not in trouble and to be honest. Brian initially denied knowing about a burglary at Gregory's and denied
 100 giving Gregory a ride to and from school on 11-2-2018. Brian then started telling bits and pieces of truths, that he gave Dylan and Gregory a ride to
 101 school on 11-2-2018. Brian then tells detectives that he also gave Gregory a ride home after school, but didn't go into Gregory's house. Detective
 102 Johnson then informed Brian this was a homicide investigation and Brian asked detectives to tell him what they know and he will tell the truth. Brian
 103 was read his Warning of Constitutional Rights from a VCSO issued Miranda Card and instructed he could have his parents there for the interview.
 104 Brian understood his rights and agreed to speak with detectives without his parents present. Brian confirmed he gave Dylan and Gregory a ride to
 105 and from school on 11-2-2018 and they left before 6th period. Brian, Dylan, and Gregory then drove to Gregory's residence. Brian said before they
 106 were at the residence, Gregory was acting very weird and shaken. Gregory, Dylan, and Brian go inside the residence, where Brian advised it looked
 107 like a hurricane blew through. Brian then stated Gregory requested them to help him (Gregory) get rid of some property. At this point, Brian stated
 108 Gregory disclosed he (Gregory) killed his mother. Brian said he didn't believe Gregory and agreed to help him store and discard of property. Brian
 109 also advised they dumped property in the dumpster behind Crunch Fitness and discarded a gun case, laptops, and a box of property at River City
 110 Church located at 267 E. Highbanks Rd., DeBary near the campfire area. Brian said Gregory also discarded the clothing he was wearing, because he
 111 was wet from submerging the box in a nearby pond. Detective Johnson learned from investigating detectives that the campfire area was the area
 112 where Gregory buried his mother after murdering her at the residence. It should be noted, Brian's interview was digitally recorded by Detective
 113 Wheeler, and copied to a CD/DVD (See DVD/CD for full interview).
 114
 115 After locating the property in the dumpster, detectives confronted Gregory with the discrepancies in his stories, and Ceglarek's statements. Post
 116 Miranda; Gregory began to confess to killing his mother (Gall). Gregory advised earlier in the evening (at approximately 2047 hours), they had an
 117 argument over his school grades. The argument turned physical when Gregory said his mother hit him in the face. After the altercation, Gregory

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118 went back to his bedroom. At approximately midnight, Gregory re-engaged his mother and went into her bedroom and the two began to argue again.
 119 As the argument was taking place, Gregory began to strangle Gail with his hands and forced her from the bed onto an area of the floor / wall.
 120 Gregory advised he believed it took him nearly (30) thirty minutes, and after initially strangling her, he got up to get a wheelbarrow to put her in. Upon
 121 returning to the bedroom, Gail was still alive and moving on the floor, so Gregory "Jumped" on top of her and stangled her until he was sure she was
 122 dead. Gregory stated he did it because he believed his mother would eventually kill him some time in the future and justified killing her as some form
 123 of self-defense. Gregory advised he then bound Gail's feet together in order to load her into the wheelbarrow and haul her out to her van. Gregory
 124 stated he then dragged Gail by her feet from the wheelbarrow into the back cargo area of the van. With Gail's dead body now in the van, Gregory
 125 advised he began to make the home look like someone had committed a burglary. Gregory took some items and placed them in the van. Gregory
 126 then drove the van to Daytona where he discarded the wheelbarrow but kept Gail's body. Gregory said he drove her body to the River City
 127 Presbyterian Church (267 E Highbanks Road, Debary) where he buried her body and threw some of the items he took from the house in the woods.
 128 Gregory then went home and got ready to go to school. At some point, Gregory gets picked up from his home sometime between 0600 to 0630
 129 hours by Dylan and Brian in Brian's vehicle. The trio then went to their high school until about 1310 hours. The trio then left school and went to
 130 Gregory's house. Once they were there, Gregory said Brian and Dylan helped him complete the staging of the alleged burglary to the residence.
 131 Gregory stated they opened all the cabinets and drawers, and shattered cups and dishes on the kitchen floor. Gregory stated Brian and Dylan also
 132 kicked in the door on the south side of the house to support the claim the house was forcibly entered by someone else. Gregory also said that both
 133 Brian and Dylan took additional items from within the home knowing that Gail was dead. Gregory said after the trio left the house, they went to the
 134 burial site of Gail's body and Brian and Dylan hid some of the items taken from the house in the woods.
 135
 136 During the interview with Gregory, other detectives were guided by Ceglarek to where much of the reportedly stolen items were disposed of, at which
 137 time, the items were recovered. These detectives also collected Gregory's computer which was still in Ceglarek's possession. Ceglarek then
 138 directed the detectives to the area behind the River City Presbyterian Church where Gail's body had been buried by Gregory beneath a ring of stones
 139 which was used as a fire pit in a wooded area behind the church behind the parking lot.

137 detectives then conducted a cursory search of the area and began to find the remnants of human remains.


