

1. Wendell gets arrested in his house by “health workers, police and the ambulance”
He has been put on medication as he writes from his cell.
Wendell was “discussing deep philosophical thoughts” with his “fiancé” Wendy. Wendy sends a photo of herself, and then the police show up and arrest him.
2. Wendell was resistant to the arrest, when police kicked the door in Wendell “threw grape juice on them [and] say the ‘blood is on your hands’.” Wendell was then forcefully restrained and injected with general anaesthetic.
3. Wendell wakes up on a bed with “countless rubber tubes hooked up to my body.” Wendell was then moved to a padded cell with a bed. After what Wendell claims was “two days” he was moved to a new cell where he is allowed to have paper and a pencil.
4. “I will only obey God’s laws now” Wendell has been given medication that he doesn’t like because they “literally block your connection to God.” “Wendy is my soul mate”, “I was sent to her by God to train her” yada, yada, same old crazy.
5. People working in the institution have been treating Wendell like he’s some sort of weirdo (wonder why). More complaining about being given medication; “peoples bodies and the chemicals [within] are property of the government”
6. The building is dirty “The first bedsheet that I received had a blood stain on it.” Wendell gets moved to a cell with a community of “creeps” Wendell doesn’t want to make friends with them. “I am here to destroy the world.” “ALL of them are demons. I want nothing to do with the retards of this world.” He does have a nice courtyard to sit in though. Wendell has been fasting since he arrived. “They hate fasting ... their God Satan rejects it”
7. This “book” is all for Wendy. All of Wendell work is for Wendy. “They determine the ways children are allowed to run their lives” “If it is against mainstream thought, they will lock you up” “Satan is their father and they can only comprehend lies”
8. The staff refuse to give Wendell more than two pieces of paper at a time an he has to ask them to sharpen his pencil. He learned what the date was 15/12/20 and realised that he was unconscious for at least a day. “evil staff” and something about “MK Ultra”
9. Wendell worries about Wendy. “They” are evil demons who hate God and Wendell. “They have done to us exactly what the Bible has commanded them not to.” “We cannot allow this ... We must find a way to stop their insanity” Wendell feels powerless “I have no cards to play” and thinks Wendy is too young to do anything either. Wendell appears to be planning an escape; “I am going to pack very basics and then flee”
10. Wendell is fasting but “they kept pushing food on me”, “This world has no logic. They have no emotions” Wendell wants to leave Canberra. He is sad that he cant bring is Nintendo Switch, but its okay because he can bring his Switch Lite.
11. Wendell plans out how he will live on the run from “Mental Health.” The health system lies. “Their system is evil” “Your physical body belongs to the government”

12. Wendell wants to show Wendy the issues so she can fix them. Crazy, crazy. They arrested him to cover up a world wide "child trafficking child rape industry that mist adult know about"
13. Wendell says they're not allowed to print out information on what medication he is being given. Drugs bad. Wendell struggles to write when he is being medicated. Medicine evil.
14. Wendell doubts he will be allowed to access the internet as the staff know he is going to try to contact Wendy. Wendell was told by God to marry Wendy at age 12; "God told me to marry you at 12". He would still be down if Wendy was 13 but "that was not the mission that God gave me." Wendell is preparing to run away and "be a vagabond again". Basically be homeless with a phone to teach the good word of Wendell.
15. 16/12/2020
Lots of self pity.
16. Wendell sees no way "this" (whatever "this" is) can work without Wendy's parents help. Wendell considers moving to England to be with Wendy but if he moved to England he would have to work (apparently, this is not an issue in Australia). "if we have not married before you turn 13, then we have failed." Wendell says he will stop his work if he fails his mission. But he would still be down to marry.
17. Whining about how he doesn't want a job. He doesn't see any way he can be with Wendy before she turns 13.
18. Wendell feels powerless but he wants Wendy to share their emails.
19. Wendell is not allowed to contact friends/family. Feels like he's in prison.
20. Wendell says he will lie to get out. Then move to Hobart.
21. Wendell plans to act saine so that he can be released, then he will move to Tasmania. "I merely act like I am demon possessed.
22. Wendell talks about having Wendy move to Tasmania to live with him. "By the time we are together, you need to be on birth control." Wendell talks about having kids with Wendy and that "Our children, my dear, are all the children of the world."
23. Wendell talks about how nice Tasmania is.
24. A psychiatrist told Wendell that he wont be able to leave for "quite a while." More talking about Tasmania and how the government is evil.
25. Wendell plans his homeless life in Tasmania.

26. Wendell plans to “act like a good boy” to get let out. He’s not allowed to use the internet so he can’t talk to any friends. Fasting is magic. But Wendell wants to “gain as much weight as possible” to prepare for his future life of being homeless. “My world is all Wendy’s. And if she is a troll making fun of me, then I dedicate my life to this troll who is making fun of me. Because this troll is the only good person that I have ever had the pleasure to meet. I love you my Wendy troll.” Wendell is sad because he won’t be able to take his “beautiful Nintendo Switch” but it’s okay because “God provided me with a Nintendo Switch Lite.”
27. More planning his homeless life; “My ukulele must come with me.” Medicine bad. God good.
28. Wendell wants to get married to Wendy before she is 13; “God demands it.” “God demands 12”, “12 is the sweet spot ... to marry. If we married at 13, this would never work.”
29. Wendell’s first meal was a “BEEF lasagne.” Even though he is a vegetarian. No veggie options. “in prison, every day they would put a new load of bread in front of my cell only one foot out of my reach ... it was their game ... the entire time I was in solitary confinement”. System bad. Doctors bad. Medication bad.
30. Wendell’s been praying. He doesn’t want his old name back. “Wendell Charles NeSmith is dead. He was martyred.” He wants Wendy to continue his work. “RIP WCN, RIP Wendy Smith. Let’s become a duo.” Wendell wants to move to Tasmania.
31. Wendy’s new name is Ivory Phoenix. “This means that you have already claimed yourself as my wife.” Wendell considers himself to be married to Wendy. “all we have to do is consummate the marriage before you turn 13 ... We are already married in God’s eyes.” Government bad.
32. Wendell can’t remember two days. Thinks “they” were doing something to him and scrubbed his memories. Medicine bad. God good.
33. Wendell suspects he was arrested because of a video he uploaded titled “Child rape” (I can’t imagine why). He hopes his “students can figure out what happened to [him]”. His students will allow him to talk to people on the outside. Hospital bad. Wendell doesn’t like paper because it can be destroyed. Uploading his insanity to the internet means that it can’t be removed.
34. “[Child trafficking] is literally the biggest industry in this world” Wendell believes he was locked up for exposing this. (Honestly. I think he sees stuff like Epstein in the news and just blows it out of proportion. Assumes that everybody is in on it, and he is jealous of them. Like when you don’t have an x-box and like three of your friends have x-boxes, and you’re like “Everybody at school has one why can’t I?”) Thinks there is a grand, world wide conspiracy of child abuse; “most of our high up government officials and celebrities are into it.” “The CIA’s main occupation in this world is to procure children for the rich and famous.”
35. Medicine bad. Doctors bad.
36. Thinks that because Wendy changed her name, she is married to him; “But we cannot complete that process until consummation.” “If we are [married], we only have one more

step to complete God's plan for our life ... in a tent." (Oh god! I want to die!) "This world is damned", he keeps talking about judgment day, (I'm never going to be able to watch Terminator 2 again, without being reminded of this sicko.)

37. Wendell wants Wendy to fulfil his legacy and finish what he started, while he pretends to be dead.
38. 17/12/2020 Wendell describes hell (nothing you haven't heard before). Heaven will be a utopia and a reward for "enduring a lifetime of persecution."
39. TV bad. Vaccines bad. Technology bad. Bad is bad. Good is good. Chemicals bad.
40. Wendell wants to use Tumblr as his new platform. He thinks Tumblr is good because of the poor moderation and the accessibility. He has stopped his pursuit of a career in voice acting. And he says that if Wendy doesn't marry him before she turns 13, then "Inas Shawket will be my wife in heaven"
41. TV bad. Authority bad.
42. Wendell proposed to Wendy without knowing what she looked like; "But your words and our numerology aligned to such an extent that I ... proposed." Wendell wasn't bothered by how Wendy looked. Then Wendy sent Wendell a photo of herself. "my heart stopped and I was unable to breathe." "I want your body." (gross). Says; "You are everything that I ever wanted." Then he thanks God for letting Wendy find him.
43. Wendell wants to support Wendy in the continuation of Wendell's work; "I will share my finances with you". "I very much want to move to you and make you my wife and inherit your parents." Wendell wants to find a way of getting Wendy's parents on his side; "figure out how to get your parents to love me." Wendell is saving in case he needs to move to England, but that means; no pension, and no job (somehow this isn't an issue when it comes to his homeless-in-Tasmania plan?). Wendell frets about visas "only appropriate visa is a marriage visa, which they would never allow". Wendell wants Wendy to come to Australia; "Convince your parents to take a trip to Australia and either migrate here or leave you here with me." (JFC! imagine what kind of parents would do such a thing!)
44. Wendell is devoted to Wendy and says that "if it takes me longer than a day to reply to you, then I have been shipped to Abu Dhabi" (Why Abu Dhabi? Who the fuck knows?) Drugs bad. More rambling about how if he goes quiet, he's been "captured".
45. Wendell thinks that he is now married to Wendy because she changed her name.
46. Wendell just going on and on about him and Wendy being married now. More of... this; "All that remains for us is to consummate the marriage. I hope we can do this before you turn 13." And more of me, yearning for death.
47. Wendell (talking directly to himself) expresses his want for internet access; "I need to advise my students that I am okay... And I need to share with Wendy what has happened." Wendell nearly gets put in solitary for repeatedly asking for internet access.

48. Self-pity because no internet. Society bad (We live in a society). Wendell is determined to record societies faults "But keep documenting and eventually their tower will fall"
49. "Sometimes when I sleep I wake up speaking in tongues. Just a moment ago I woke up stating in my demon voice, 'Burn mother fucker, burn.'" Talks about a "satanic band called, 'Coal Chamber'." Talks about "my demon demanding for the world to burn", and this is somehow linked to something happening in the world at that moment. The smartest adult cant disprove him. "it is time for the world to pay" Then he lapses into song lyrics (Coal Chamber, The roof is on fire)
50. Wendell talks about how every video he has made is for Wendy personally. "when I am set free I will give you many more photos and videos." Wendy looks exactly how he imagined. More pinning for Wendy.
51. Wendell talks about how much he likes paper because it lets him be more focused on particular topics. God writes through him, using him as a "vessel".
52. Numerology nonsense. The number 6 keeps cropping up all his life. "For I am the number of a man. I am 666" (idfk). Numerology proves Wendy is not a troll.
53. 18/12/20 Medicine bad. Government bad. Homeless-in-Tasmania good.
54. Medicine bad. Canberra bad.
55. Wendell talks about someone called John Gault. World bad. Is sad because "I do not think that my work encouraged anyone to stand up for what is right." "The only way to succeed as a content producer in this world is create evil"
56. The doctors told Wendell that he could get "half an hour of supervised time on my smart phone." With the stipulation that he is "not allowed to contact [Wendy]" The doctors want Wendy to forget about Wendell. Wendell lists his doctors' names; "Dr. Neelam Joun, Dr. Russell Barns, Dr. Diane Yap" Doctors bad.
57. Human rights are a farse to keep us compliant. Considers the possibility of never being let out. He's trying to contact various humanitarian aid services. He is determined never to abandon his "relationship" with Wendy.
58. There is an attack on religious values from the Bible, Quran, and Torah.
59. "No one except me in this world tell the truth." "One of 'My Girls' lied to me the entire time about her name". Wendell had a bath. Apparently, Wendell was roughed up quite a bit by the police when he was arrested. Police bad. Military bad. Wendell believes he is being persecuted for telling the truth.
60. "I very much hate people." That pretty much sums up most of this page. Wendell is angry at his trolls for following him. "The people of this world are super creepy." (The absolute

fucking audacity of this man!) “I warned [my trolls]. The time to save a life was yesteryear and today is a time to genocide all life.” Wants to “destroy this world” with God and Wendy.

61. Wendell whinges about having to ask for staff to sharpen his pencil. He is not allowed a pen because he could drink the ink. Medicine bad. Hospital bad.
62. Wendell wants Wendy to embrace her new name; Ivory. Wants to live in Tasmania with Wendy on a camp site or just “in the bush” Tasmania good. World bad. Come to Tas and watch the world burn with me.
63. God’s plan. Pining for Wendy. God’s will. “We have already done it! I married a 12 year old. I married you my gorgeous Wendy NeSmith” Says they don’t *have* to consummate before she turns 13 but he really would prefer it. “Please give me the honour to consummate the relationship while you are still 12 years old. That is my dream dear girl.”
64. “I am the sun and you are the moon.” Talks about England. “Do you want me to move to England, my dear? If I were to do this then we would need your parents on our side. Otherwise I would be considered a predator.” (Apparently this wouldn’t be a problem if Wendy moved to Australia.) Wants Wendy to be his guide and “boss” but Wendell needs to teach her “wisdom” before she can assume this role.
65. 19/12/20 Every morning Wendell’s rooms is searched for contraband. He hides his “book” (these letters to Wendy) from the nurses as they search. “I told them that they are creepy. and they replied, ‘And you’re not?’” (Based nurse.) People bad. World bad. Authority bad.
66. A staff member walked in on Wendell talking a shower. Hospital bad. Staff bad. World bad. People bad.
67. “They have made it clear to me that the reason that I am here is because of the show Phoenix Rising.” Talks about how he has been arrested for trying to find a 12 year old. He’s denied internet access because he would only use it to talk to Wendy. Government bad. “I love you my beauty Queen. I hope you are watching old videos of mine.
68. Shower is cold. Food is cold. Medicine bad. Government bad.
69. “They” won’t give him a pen. They won’t give him a sharpener. They wont give him more than one piece of paper at a time. Meat bad. Vegetables good.
70. Wendell is a vegetarian, but Wendell can’t eat orange foods, seriously; “Any foods that are orange sickens me, such as carrot and sweet potato.” But beans are okay; “I love beans, but my body does not crave beans from the ground. My body craves beans from a can. When my body craves meat, I very much enjoy a Rebel Whopper” (I thought he was vegetarian). “My body very much loves the food that a cows titties produces.” He also can’t eat fruit; “I am unable to eat fruit.”
71. Wendell is obsessed with Wendy. He wants to be able to communicate with Wendy. Not allowed internet because he’ll talk to Wendy. “I don’t care about anyone else in this world now that I have found you.”

72. Pining for Wendy. Religion good. God good. Government bad. World bad.
73. "My work is now complete my dear." "God told me to stop after Phoenix Rising." Wendell doesn't want to continue his work. "I have proven that my work is entirely ineffective in this world." Wendell feels incapable of completing his work alone, he wants Wendy to continue his work. Wendell will go back to making videos "for you and only you", and give Wendy his full attention. Wants to show Wendy how to "dance with a camera."
74. "my time is now done and your time starts soon." This sums up the first half. Wendell says he will give up if Wendy is a troll, or lying about who she is or, if she doesn't follow through with Wendell's plan. "All I am now and all I can ever be now is your slave. Please be real."
75. 20/12/20 Wendell had a dream about a "demonic succubus" bring about the end of the world because Wendell "refused to be with her". After the whole world had been destroyed, only he and she were left. She gave Wendell another chance, Wendell refused; "for [Wendy] had [Wendell's] heart and [Wendell] would never be with wickedness." The succubus got angry and tried to take both their lives, but Wendell turns into a ghost and flies away. Then the world is restored, and Wendy appears. "We embrace as the world around us was reformed from a nightmare into a paradise."
76. "I have lost all of my family and friends because of you. If you are a troll, then you have destroyed my life." His family have abandoned him because of his "obsession"; "now that I have found you, I have been rejected by all." "And if I made the wrong decision with you and trusting who you say you are, then I am done in this life and I have nothing more to live for." Wendell considers moving to England but, England means no pension. Wendell wants to inherit Wendy's family. "You are the reason my heart beats."
77. Wendell asked a nurse to print out the origin of the word "virgo" because; "I wanted to learn more about my wife." The nurse refused, and Wendell thinks this is some kind of human rights violation. Hospital bad. Media bad. System bad.
78. "My work proves beyond a shadow of a doubt that I am not mentally ill." Doctors bad. Wendell submitted the previous chapter as a complaint. This upset the staff. Doesn't know how he's going to get out. "their goal is to convince me to stop talking to you, dear Ivory, but that will never happen. I would rather die than to allow our relationship to fizzle out."
79. Wendell complains about the staff cleaning his room "three times per day". "I am very frightened about this book being thrown away. That is why I hide it underneath the mattress of my bed" Wendell wants internet access so he can upload his letters/book so it can't be deleted. "All of this, dear Wendy, is because I love you", "I will work hard every day to get closer to you".
80. "I want to sing to you love songs every day. I want to train you in music and I want us to sing beautiful romantic songs for the rest of eternity."
81. Wendell says that him and Wendy are married, so "it matters not how long they lock me up." When he gets internet access, he will send Wendy all of these letters. Wants to move to

the Isle of White because "that is where David Icke lives." But he once again complains that England means no pension. "Please never stop thinking of me, Please watch past videos of mine... Please use this time to win over your parents." Wendell believes that he needs Wendy's parents on his side for this to work.

82. "You and I are one, my dear, we are the same energy from God split into two vessels." Wendy's mission is to save "the children" I guess before the end of the world. "Our job, dear Ivory, is to destroy this world while saving as many children as possible during that process."
83. "Since I met you, I have cried more than I have ever cried before, so much so that my face was really dry no matter how much moisturizer I used." "Tears are magic my love." "Don't give your precious tears to swine". "Give your tears to me, my love... you will have all of my tears. Please return the favour... Cry however you need to but to it embracing be"
84. Wendell writes a letter to his doctors claiming that "I am not mentally ill. I need a trial in the court of law", "I demand a fair trial in the court of law, where Wendy Smith will be my lawyer (and victim)."
85. Wendell knows about "The Mark of the Beast" and "The Mark of the Lamb" but God has not allowed him to share this knowledge. All the typical mark of the beast stuff; vaccines, chips, implants etc are "all red herrings." The mark of the beast is either on the right hand of a working man, or the forehead of an unemployed man. The mark of the lamb is observed when someone puts their work up for free.
86. Wendell believes he is being tortured because he can't go online, and no one will listen to him. Doctors bad. Nurses bad.
87. Wendell believes that Wendy is his layer, and "they" are denying her from fulfilling that role. The doctors want Wendell to stop his work. Wendell realised that he must go on. He wants his letters to go online "These letters to you, my gorgeous girl, must go public." "I can never stop working. But what I will stop doing is reading what evil people say about me".
88. Wendell wants to "find a safe off the grid place to settle" when he is released. No free speech. "I am here because my content is controversial." Kiwi-farms bad. "What is your middle name, my girl? I very much want to know it". "I have a lifetime to learn all about you my gorgeous jailbait."
89. 21/12/20 Wendell asks Wendy questions about her personality, asking what her favourite things are. "You came to me and asked very politely if I would groom you. I accepted with joy." World bad. Bible illegal. Society bad.
90. Wendell has a tribunal hearing on the 24th. But "almost all of the information is inaccurate." Wendell says "they" are just like Kiwi-farms. "I have no way to win this because they love lies". "I have lost this dear Wendy. I can see no way to win anymore." Religion illegal. Wendell wants to die; "This world will never let us do this Wendy. And you are the only person I care about in it. I wish I was courageous enough to end my own life. I am a failure in this life. And I have no allies, for all are against me."

91. "Everybody in this world is out enemies, my dear Wendy." World bad. Doctors bad. "I think the world will force us to wait until you are 18, which is really sad and entirely against the Bible." Wendell considers waiting until Wendy is "16 or 18" before getting married. "But, my dear Wendy Lady, we have don't it. God has married us at 12 and 36. We just might have to wait a while to consummate the relationship." Wendell is worried about being cuckold; "Are you strong enough to stay a virgin until the day we meet face to face?"
92. "They are now refusing to sharpen my pencil unless I allow them to do observation on my body." Medicine bad. Wendell doesn't know how long he will be able to keep writing. Hospital bad. "We have lost this war, dear Wendy." World bad. Wendell wants to "flee this state." World bad.
93. Wendell complains that nobody can prove him wrong. Complains that people don't watch the videos before judging him. Wants to leave Canberra. "Fuck Canberra and fuck Australia."
94. "How many children have I touched inappropriately? Zero." (Why did he include the word "inappropriately", begs a looming question...) Wants to leave Canberra and be homeless. Society bad. "I am being punished for something I have never done, only talked about doing. And I will try hard to do it so that my punishment was worth it."
95. 22/12/20 Wendell reflects on what he has written so far and reflects on reflection; "Reflection is such a powerful tool." Wendell wishes that he could check his email and his YouTube channel. Wendell appears hopeful for the first time since he began writing; "Hard work and dedication will always bring you to new heights and in time, your cup will be overflowing." Also, he has a pen now.
96. Dr. Florian told Wendell that he may be allowed to use his phone under supervision to pay his bills but *not* to contact Wendy. Wendell considered showing his book (these letters) at his tribunal but that would reveal his plans; "I want them to think that I will be a happy boy on their drugs living in their city. But when the time is right, I will flee." Australia bad. Pedro good. Wants to live under the radar "I will be a ghost" making content under the pseudonym Wesley Phoenix; "WCN will be buried, possible forever."
97. "I am a hermit." Wendell has lost faith in humanity and signs himself away to a life serving only Wendy; "my only function in this life now is to be at Wendy's command. What 'army' I have acquired through my life's work are now handed over to Wendy. I now have nothing in this life. I am now nothing in this life." "I am at your command Wendy. What you say, I will do. I have no free will of my own. My will is yours... I love you Wendy NeSmith." Adults bad. Kids good. "None will believe that I am Jesus reincarnated, and as a result, they all go to Hell."
98. 23/12/20 Wendell had a dream in which he was a teacher who taught philosophy and battle strategy. A "wise turtle" gave Wendell information that he used to great effect. When he returned to thank the turtle, the turtle revealed that Wendell was being used as a pawn to the turtle's own ends. "I looked around and realised that all of my allies were villains. The doctors attempted to get the email address of Wendy from Wendell. "They want to speak to your parents about me. They want to destroy our relationship by speaking to your parents." Wendell is disillusioned and begins to doubt his life's work; "I give up on this world because I

am no longer sure of the difference between good and evil... Can the entire world really be wrong and one man be right? I have lost confidence in everything that I have done.”

99. Something is happening to Wendell. He starts out complaining about being given drugs (same old Wendell) but then this; “I have come to understand that these are the good guys of the world because I am sick and with them I make real bad actions in life... my belief in God is delusional... Nothing happens for a reason...I am delusional for believing in God and I am delusional for thinking that God sends me sign, visions, and dreams to direct my path in life.” No one can “interpret and comprehend” my work. “I am insane and my God and his mission for me must have just been delusions of grandeur, as the entire public states.” “My old work is done and I will just write love letters to my dear Wendy for the rest of my days.” Society hates me for it but I have nothing else to do. “I wish suicide were legal.” (What is happening to Wendell? Could he really be reforming? His handwriting is the neatest I’ve ever seen it.)
100. Wendell reflects on how throughout his life nobody has ever agreed with him; “But no one ever agreed with me. I don’t see how It is possible that one man is right but EVERYBODY else is wrong. How can that be? it can’t. That means that I am wrong... I must be the villain. Wendell tells Wendy to do what she wants weather that be pursuing him or walking away “back to your old life.” Wendell realises that when “Wendell became Wesley” he was just trying to “burry [his] old destroyed reputation.” “I am still Wendell.” (Promising stuff but then he implies that he is fighting for justice, which is inconsistent with what he’s been saying.) “It is not beneficial to fight for justice in this world. Because if you do, you will be doing it alone.” Wendell reflects on the bad he has done; “I lit fires everywhere... they are still burning to this day... But now I realise that I am the bad buy and the rest of the world are good guys.” (And then this curveball that suggests maybe he is being ironic/trolling) “This brainwashing session accommodated with odd medicines has shown me the errors of my ways.” (Could this just be a fake ironic reformation?)
101. (The title of this was “Legalise Assisted Suicide) “This world and everyone in it hates me. Many constantly tell me to end my life... Since they all hate me, why won’t they assist me to commit suicide?” Wendell doesn’t think he will be able to marry Wendy until she is 16 or 18 years old. A marriage of this kind wouldn’t shock the world at all so what’s the point? “We need to shock the world with a child bride wedding. If we can’t do this then we fail and I reckon that Inas Shawket will be my wife in heaven. Because by you talking on my name is not a real marriage. It needs to be physical.” Wendell feels hopeless again. If you cannot get your parents on out side, then Inas is my wife.”
102. None of the humanitarian aid organisations wanted to help Wendell. His trial is tomorrow and he feels doomed. “All large organisations are literally run by the Devil”
103. According to Wendell the doctors are “pursuing the forensics option” (idk what this means). Wendell doesn’t know if he will ever be released; “they very much want to lock me up permanently.” Wendell pines for Wendy. “I failed and it is now likely that we will never speak again”.

104. Wendell sees no way for his plan to come to fruition. "So I give up... I will continue to work for you to enable you to reach the children about these topics but we can't be together." Wendell sees no point in waiting for Wendy to be old enough to legally marry. Wendy is to inherit Wendell's work and fanbase. "I think my wife is Inas Shawket. She is the only way I stay out of jail."
105. Wendell laments on the fact that he will never be with Wendy; "if I ever touch you, dear Wendy, I am in jail for a long time." "We are now broken up, my dear... You know how much I love you but I can't be with you because they will lock me up [for] being with you". Wendell says that it is up to Wendy to "fight" to get Wendell back.
106. Wendell can't marry Wendy at 18 because that wouldn't mean anything. And he can't marry at 12 because "God is not opening any windows or doors for us to marry at your 12". Wendell then gets angry at God for letting him find Wendy but not letting him marry Wendy. And for all the "suffering, persecution, and incarceration". Wendell gives Wendy the responsibility of getting him out, if she can't then "my wife will be Inas Shawket"
107. Wendell asks God why he has promised him so much and then abandoned him. "Please end my life dear God... My life consists of torture after torture... I have no friends and no family. Please my God, stop my heart and bring me home... please allow me to leave this existence... Wendy, my dear. Please obsess over watching my videos... And please pray for my death, for the torture is too much to handle"
108. Wendell seems to forget all about how he felt during the previous chapter and starts daydreaming about homeless "tent life". Also complains about rebuying the same things after they are taken by the authorities.
109. His trial is tomorrow and is going to lose. "They might keep me locked up indefinitely." If he is let out, then he will quickly flee to Tasmania.
110. 24/12/20 (This appears to be a script that Wendell plans to reiterate at his tribunal) Wendell lays out his three points to start with; He has been denied the defence of *his* lawyer, his lawyer is Wendy Smith. His new book "attempts to break off the relationship in which Wendy Smith and I share." And lastly Wendell has been documenting all the "lies" of the institution holding him.
111. Wendell lost (Wow! No way!) "For the next six months. They have refused me to go home. They are still refusing me internet access." Wants to leave (cant). Wants to go on the internet (cant). "They will never let us be together Wendy." Wants to move to Tasmania when he is let out.
112. Wendell has been praying and God told him that "it matters not what age you are when we unite together... I thought you had to be 12. But I was wrong – I was not seeing the entire picture." Wendell doesn't have to "physically marry at 12" because he and Wendy will be advocating such a marriage so that future generation will be able to. "Please, please, please hold on to your virginity do not let another take it or you are not mine. Be gentle if you masturbate, do not take it yourself. Please give it to me on our physical wedding night, whenever that may be." "Please take photographs of your gorgeous self as you age and

please give the to me after we physical marry. Please allow me to enjoy your young self even when you are older.”

Wendell attaches a Psychiatric Treatment Order with the end date being 23/6/2021. Looks like this is when he gets out.

113. “I love Wendy... If we can’t get married at your 12, it matters not because that will be what we promote in our romantic films.” (what does he mean by “romantic films”?) Wendell wants to marry Wendy at 12 but will settle for older, “my dear Wendy NeSmith.” Doesn’t want to retype these letters, because “hand written has more heart than the typed.” Afraid of being cuckold. Is willing to “share finances” with Wendy, he has stated before that he would like to have a bank card made for Wendy. Wants to move to Tasmania, “our new home will likely be Tasmania. You need to start exploring option as to how to get your gorgeous arse down here.”
114. Says age is not important to him, but immediately followed it up with; “In Heaven, we will receive bodies that do not change. Your body as 12 is perfect for me for all eternity. And my body at 36 is perfect for you for all eternity... Please stay 12 forever my girl and I will stay 36 forever.” Wendell will one day be let out and Wendy will receive all these letters at once. “These letters will be private only to you unless you decide to make them public.” Wants to marry Wendy.
115. Writes his own rendition of ‘The Night Before Christmas’ in which he calls himself Jesus. World bad. Society bad. Religion illegal. “Demons are easy to spot, as the majority of adults are possessed.”
116. “If we are unable to get your parents on our side, then they will lose you forever.” Wendell wants Wendy to fly by herself to Australia. “In Australia, the legal age of consent it 15... they will let us sleep together.” Wendell is willing to share his money with Wendy; “My finances are now also your finances... I will work on getting a card sent to you so that you can start becoming more independent.” Wendell is willing to send Wendy money using the card, so she can buy a smartphone. He wants her to start using Discord; “We need instant messaging and not emails.” (probably voice chat too). Wants Wendy to make her parents love Wendell so that he can move to England.
117. World bad. Society bad. No humanitarian aid for Wendell. Everybody bad. Every organisation bad. Society bad. Being good is illegal. Hospital bad. “Freemasonry is literally attempting to destroy the world” Doctors are Freemasons. “Who am I? John Galt.”
118. 25/12/20 Its Christmas so Wendell explains that “Every single holiday in which this world celebrates has its roots in paganism. There is no holiday that is of God in this world.” When talking about Easter he claims that; “They hide eggs in the wood for children to find while the child rapist looks for children to rape who are looking for eggs.” (WTF?) Calls himself Jesus; “Those who celebrate my name while I am in prison are not celebrating Jesus.” “All adults of this world are demonically possessed.” “I love you dear Wendy NeSmith.” Wendell wants to get out so he can talk with Wendy.

119. Wendell is bored. Wants to write more but doesn't want to overload Wendy. "So God is teaching me how to just sit still in my room doing nothing." Demons all around. Freemasons run everything.
120. "I am all in my gorgeous flower. I want your body, mind, and soul more than anything", "I want to unite ourselves into one being." "If we must rebel against your parents, we will do so at an age where you have more rights... [your parents] will lose you forever." "God wants us to come together to watch the world fall." (Looks like he's given up on saving the world.) Wendell is willing to buy Wendy a smartphone, by sending her a bank card when he gets out. "How could I send it to you?"
121. "All employment, my love, is a trick to damn your soul." All employment makes you a godless heathen who worships Satan. "All sin is equal in the eyes of God... I have no real followers because I don't tell them what to do... This clears me of any potential sin they may commit." "Employment is bad, Wendy."
122. "You told me that you would not be returning to your old school after the holidays," so Wendy has all day to read Wendell's letters. "I am your personal tutor." "Please tell me everything about you. I want to learn you in and out."
123. 26/12/20 Wendell doesn't like assembly line work, because the workers "would never be capable of creating their own products in their entirety." Assembly line bad. "Shaking hands is a Freemasonry practice... [social distancing] is one good thing that has come from the fake COVID-19 pandemic" "When we meet, hang all over me, for my body was meant for you... Touch is a special way of showing affection... I LOVE you Wendy!"
124. 27/12/20 Wendell doesn't know how to avoid being locked up. Sad because no internet. "Do not feed the mouth that bites. If no one will stand up for you, we will create a private server that that people must pay to enter." Wendell wants to "protect" Wendy but can't while he is locked up. "You are the most important person in the world... I am nothing in this world... I will spend the rest of my life protecting you, my dear Ivory Phoenix."
125. "These love letters are slowing down my angel I do not want to overload you and I am finding better uses of my time." "Now it is time to point my guns at my doctors and nurses. I will kill them with logic." Wendell will write "hate letters" to his captors. "Their lies will never be able to prevail. 2021 is out year, my dear." Wants to destroy the world with Wendy; "Agenda 21 was created for us to the destruction of the world... Call fire and brimstone down from the heavens." "Make the bad fuel your demon. Become demonically possessed like I am. You are the commander of demons. Find your own, train it and then command all demons around you to wreak havoc on this world... For you are Christ and they will bow to your every wish."
126. 28/12/20 Wendell says he could be a successful writer, if he wrote "morally repulsive content." Fiction is formulaic and evil. "There are no good people left and no one even wants to be good. Good is punished and bad is praised." Wendell wants to make a living by starting a "2 person ukulele band" with Wendy. "While I am locked up, my net worth grows. Would you like me to come to England my dear?... A ticket to get there is now in my grasp."

127. 29/12/20 Wendell wants Wendy to “create a network of spy kids” to report and “spy on evil adults”. Adults bad. Wendell bored. Doctors are trying to contact Wendy; “They want to talk with your parents, which I am trying very hard to not allow them to do.” Wendell can’t pay his bills or pick up his mail. “Do not be afraid of these demons, for what is inside you is much more powerful than all these demons put together and eventually they will be required to bow to you. Be brave... I love you Wendy NeSmith.”
128. “To the one who conquers I will give some of the hidden manna, I will give her a white stone, with a new name written on the stone that no one knows except the one who receives it. Revelation 2:17” Wendell tried to get a copy of the Quran but was refused. “Eventually, I was able to convince my captors to let me borrow a New Testament with Psalms and Proverbs.” Hospital bad. Religion illegal. God good.
129. Quotes ‘Revelation 16:2’ and ‘Revelation 16:10-11’ “I [heart] GOD” – is written down the margin. Bible good. “I just realised that ‘Phoenix Rising’ and the book of Revelation both have 22 chapters. God told me very clearly to stop my work after I finished the 22nd episode.” “If I am not Jesus then let Jesus come down and rapture us. For now is the end times and if I have mistaken on who I am, then I repent! I have found your bride and it took over 36 years to do so. Wendy Smith is yours if I am not Jesus. I love you Jesus.”
130. Hospital bad. Wendell can’t call anyone because he doesn’t remember their phone numbers. “I am frightened about these letters never getting to you.” Wendell wants to back up his letters online.
131. ‘Mark 10:40’ “I was right all along... You are the *chosen one*, my dear.” He then shows a “sigil” that God has been showing him more and more; It looks exactly like an anarchy ‘A’ symbol. But apparently “It is not the anarchy sign. It is not an ‘A’ but a triangle... My hand tattoo is yours, Wendy. My natural hand is holding God’s hand, your right hand is holding, my left hand. And your left hand holds God’s right hand.” In letters that take up two lines he writes “[heart] We are the Trinity [heart] [new line] Mark 11:24 = ü” Wendy was chosen by God, her life was planned out, just like Wendell’s. Wendy is special. Everything lines up. “You are my Ivory Virgin. I have been waiting for you all of my life. I love you and bow to you Wendy Smith: Christ of the world, I am your slave.”
132. 30/12/20 “This book is complete when I get my Internet back.” Wendell has been allowed to take pictures of his letters and upload them to Dropbox. “I think it only a matter of time before they allow me to use my phone to let everyone know what has happened to me since the abduction.” “Everything happens for a reason.” Wendell wouldn’t have written this book if he wasn’t arrested. “Bad it always good in disguise. Demons are angels and they know the truth and ultimately work for God. Everybody and everything works for God”. “Be strong my love. You and I are in God’s hands.”
133. 31/12/20 Wendell knows he is going to be locked up for a long time yet. “They are covering up how huge child abuse is in this world. Because my ‘Mental illness’ is revealing to the world how big this fucking industry is.” “I am Wendell Charles NeSmith. I will not give up my name and I will not give up my work... After Phoenix Rising, I backed down like a little pussy. But now is the time for me, Wendell Charles NeSmith, to rise.” This is the last book he

needs to write; “The never ending book of love letters to Wendy Smith. Let’s change that ‘Smith’ to a NeSmith my gorgeous girl. I love you. Lets spend the rest of our lives protecting children from these evil people!”

134. “I am ready now for a lifetime of imprisonment” Wendell is content as long as he is able to upload his letters to the internet. “I no longer need to do video or audio or digitally typed.” Handwritten notes are sufficient. “I thought I could just disappear to Tasmania or something. But then it became obvious that they would now allow it.” (Has he just abandoned his Tasmania plan entirely?) Doctors bad. Kiwi-farms bad. Deadwing Dork bad.
135. “I just finished my first 15 minute supervised phone access. Apparently I was only allowed to tell my ‘of age’ friends that I was okay. But oops. My finger slipped and I sent you my never ending book of love letters to you.” Wendell plans to use the Dropbox folder as a form of one-way communication with Wendy. He wants Wendy to send him emails while he is locked up. “If I ever stop, know that it is them stopping me.” Wendell really wants Wendy’s parents on his side.
136. Wendell wants to win over Wendy’s parents and live with them. “I very much want your family in Heaven with us... Your first mission is to save your parents by making them love me. I am the best partner for you in the world... Once they can see how good I would be for you, they could never object. We are soulmates and together our value is the highest in the world.”
137. “What can I teach you?” Is written at the top and the rest of the page is full of random words in no order. “philosophy, piano, education DIY, patience, ukulele, endurance, athletics, harmonica, photo creation, SEO, video editing, writing, numerology, perception, gymnastics, faith, singing, typing, convoluted mathematics, aesthetics, elements of style, science, guitar, sociology, GOD, game design, voice acting, love, ninjutsu, tracking, taihojutsu, reason, psychology, genius/juno, creativity, martial arts, camera techniques, nintaijutsu, photo editing, romance, driving, knife throwing, courage, 4-W-driving, hacking, discernment, mythology, dancing, technology, nature, filmmaking, animals, documentation, puzzle creating , Buddhism, puzzle assembly, gaming, religion, Judaism, Christianity, Islam, and much more!!!” In the margin, he has written; “I love you WENDY!” and, “Wendy is the saviour of the world. My Ivory Phoenix. [heart]”
138. 01/01/21 “There is no way that I can win against these fuckers.” Wendell will get in trouble no matter what he does. “They incarcerated me this time because they wanted to silence me... This is war. Wendell Charles NeSmith is back... stronger than ever.” Police, doctors, and nurses all abuse kids and are evil. Wendell sad because people judge him without watching his videos. “Does that seem fair, my dear Hinata?” (Hinata?)
139. “Everyone who is stopping me from getting this message out is responsible for the abuse of children.” Wendell is allowed short period to upload more pages and check emails. He is not allowed to contact anyone in any way. “They have disappeared me from the world” “I am a danger to society because I have spent my life trying to fix it. Welcome back to life Wendell Charles NeSmtith. I have missed you. Wendy + Wendell 4eva! I [heart] U !”

140. Wendell is in the “High Dependency Unit” so he has to ask for things like more paper and his pencil to be sharpened, these things usually take “between 5 – 40 minutes.” Hospital bad because people tell him different things like weather or not he can communicate with people outside.
141. Wendell doesn’t feel safe in the HDU. But when a crazy (I mean “demon possessed”) woman attacked Wendell during meal time, he was transferred to the Low Dependency Unit for the rest of the night (not sure if he’s staying in LDU permanently though). Wendell much prefers the LDU; “The LDU is much more relaxing than the crazy HDU.” An “angel” (inmate) named Sarah gave Wendell her dessert and shared her cigarettes with him (smoking is not allowed). Wendell says that smoking isn’t that bad, and he will quit to be healthy when he meets Wendy in person.
142. Wendell wants Wendy to continue his work to save the children. And also to warn them that “child abuse is the largest industry in this fallen world... You must teach your girls to destroy and testicles that go near them in which they are not married to.” Teach kids to fight child abusers and “do not trust the police to resolve this issue. They are a part of it”
143. 2/01/21 Wendell talks about how the “scamdemic” is causing all the borders to close, and it’s making it harder for Wendell. Wendell sees his three biggest problems as “1. The legal ramifications of our wedding night. 2. Getting your parents to love me. 3. The borders and visas required to unite.” Wendell wants Wendy to be his lawyer. He also wants Wendy to do what she can to get him out; “There is no way that we can unite unless we both act together marriage is us two becoming one flesh.”
144. Wendell talks about MKUltra. Says that the movie “hook” what the beginning of his “MKUltra indoctrination”. “Today I am being transferred to the Low Dependency Unit... I still am not allowed my phone.” Wendell fears that his YouTube channel has been taken down. “The children need to be made aware of the truth, my dear Wendy. That is your mission. Expose all evil. Bring their darkness to the light. I love you!”
145. Wendell wants Wendy to “romance” him; “Your work needs to be a reflection of my own. You need to spend your life romancing me, as I have spent my life romancing you. Speak directly to me on camera... You gorgeous philosopher!” Wendell wants Wendy to make her own videos about philosophy (like him). “Do not romance me by being me, my hard candy. Be you and make film after film after film giving me your love. Be public and use your real name. For God has made you the Christ.”
146. God is shaping the path ahead for Wendy “You have a road already created for you which has been built from Gold. You must merely follow it... You will give it all because Jesus has given everything to you. Because I have given everything to you.” (I guess Wendell is Jesus then?) Wendy is the best. “You are messiah and Christ and I bow to you.” Wendell, Wendy, and God are “the first real trinity.” Wendell and Wendy are to be an example – sent by God – of what a good romantic relationship should be. “Fly your flag high my darling, for we are destined to take over the world. I love you.
147. “You asked if you should share the link with anyone” (Apparently, Wendy was able to get a message to Wendell) The letters are meant for Wendy but Wendell allows her to

“do what you like” with the Dropbox link. Wendell is only writing for Wendy. Wendell wants Wendy to win over her parents to his side. “If you run away with me, this is kidnapping and I go to jail for a long time.” Wendell is willing to move to England or have Wendy move to Australia, “but we can do nothing without your parents to support us.”

148. This seems to be some kind of song that he’s written. “In Christ alone my hope is found. She is my light” (female pronoun suggests that Wendy is Christ). In Christ alone who took on flesh... Adored by the ones she came to save. Till on that cross Wendell died, for the wrath of God will be satisfied. For every sin, on him was laid, here in the death of the Antichrist I live.” (idk. Wendy is Jesus and Wendell is either Jesus as well or he is simply dying on a cross just like Jesus. Is he saying that he is the “Antichrist”? If so, that would make the marriage of Wendell and Wendy one of Christ and Antichrist. A Jungian union of opposites.) “There on the ground my body lay... Up from the grave I rose again. And we stand in victory, sins curse has lost its grip on kids. For I am hers and she is mine, bought with the precious blood of the Antichrist.” (So... Wendell – the Antichrist – dies, and is reborn to unite with Wendy – who is Christ. And this has been bought with the blood of the Antichrist.) “No guilt in life, no fear in death, this is the power of Christ in us... Wendy commands my destiny. No power of hell... can ever pluck me from her hand.” (I don’t know what to make of this. I think he sees him and Wendy as two sides of the same coin who should be united to create something greater – God maybe. And then save the world. Maybe it’s like JC Denton and the Helios AI merging to create a kind of super-man to save the world.)
149. “We are not of this world, dear Wendy.” “For our spiritual toils in this world, God will give us new perfect and indestructible bodies. Yours will forever be 12 and mine will forever be 36.” Wendell thinks that “In our afterlives” God will give him and Wendy their own planet full of people to rule, where him and Wendy will be gods of their own worlds. Wendell doesn’t want to get cucked; “Do not listen to the man who attempts to flatter you. You are only for me.”
150. “Do not watch mainstream entertainment anymore.” Wendell wants Wendy to only watch his videos on “Nesmith.net” because they are all made for her specifically, not like mainstream media. News bad. “Watch your news with great scepticism. They are liars.” “Match me my love. Obsess over me with your life. Eventually your parents will have to come around. You are my fiancé and we are soon to become one.”
151. “Would you like a nesmtih.net email address? I could set you up with wendy@nesmith.net... You are my fiancé and it will prepare you for your new name. It would also make me feel good.” “You call me Wesley a lot since I obtained the new name. I kind of like Wes better. But my name is Wendell as yours is Wendy... Please call me Wendell primarily... You are my soul mate and our hearts and lives fit together perfectly.” Wendell wants Wendy to send him emails so he can read them when he gets his phone. “Tell me everything about you. Favourite colour, muddle name, dreams and hopes, favourite food etc... You are so cute, I want to gobble up. Yummy Wendy. – Revelation 12”
152. Wendell wants Wendy to destroy anything she got for Christmas that wasn’t a smartphone or a camera. “If your parents refuse you the ability to make videos about philosophy, then you should destroy your old life in front of them... Destroy them one by one while your parents watch. Nothing is of value to you any more except what can bring

you closer to me. Make a scene every day until we can win over your parents." Time is short, the world is ending. "We need your parents to support us... You have to show them the truth... Show them all I do for you. Show them these letters if you think it would help. We need your parents to do this. There is no other options."

153. 3/01/21 Doomsday prophecy from the bible; "Matthew 12:42" "The time for judgement day has arrived my queen." Wendell wants Wendy to save the children and end the world. Wendell has spent his life's work trying to gather "disciples" but he has none. So it is up to Wendy to continue his life's work (drink every time Wendell tells Wendy to finish what he started and you'll be too blind to read to the end.) In the margin of the page is written; "My life was not a failure because I found you [heart]".
154. Wendell's handwriting is poor and machines would struggle to read it - let alone understand it; "Someone would have to type [my letters] to ever give AI a chance at comprehending." "This book will never end. It will be my love letters to my beautiful Wendy Smith." Wendell will just keep uploading more pages. Wendell is okay with being a text only creator. Kiwifarms evil. "In good news, my YouTube channel is still up for now, and when I get home I will have another book ready to be published."
155. 4/01/21 "I have just read through half of the love letters to you." Then the "fake Dr. Russell Barns" told Wendell that "it is illegal to be engaged to a 12 year old." USA good, because free speech." "There are certain states [in the US] that allow the marriage of a 12 year old girl under exceptional circumstances. Why don't we go move to one of those states?... Let's move to the free USA with your parents and start a life there together? We would need your parents' approval." "my future is mirky. The doctors are giving me no confidence that I can ever leave." In the margin is written "* made call to U.S. Embassy" Wendell seems pretty stoked on moving to the US where (apparently) his plan legal. "We still need your parents on our side. None of this will work without your parents on our side. Let's figure out how to legally get married in the USA!" In the margin is written "Born in the USA!" and "Australia is OPPRESSION!"
156. Wendell wants to move with Wendy to the US to get legally married. "I will go back to my father in Winter Haven and prepare to migrate to one of those states... Convince your parents to migrate to the USA and we can all be a happy family." He also doesn't want to have a job. "This is the first plan that could actually work. Because none of its details involve committing a crime... No law could stop us... My doctor today tried to tell me that it is illegal to be engaged to a 12 year old. How could that be if our plan were all legal?" (Can't argue with that; How can something be illegal, if its legal? Checkmate, doctor!)
