
Dear Judge Garnett:

The current schedule in the above-referenced matter for pretrial motions (not related to the constitutionality of the death penalty¹) is as follows: defense motions due September 26, 2025; government's response due October 31, 2025; and defense's reply due November 14, 2025. The defense respectfully requests the following modest adjustment to these deadlines: defense motions due October 10, 2025; the government's response due November 14, 2025; and the defense's reply due November 21, 2025. The government does not object to this request.

Importantly, this request is made with the shared understanding that the December 5, 2025, pretrial conference remains firmly in place. The parties agree that maintaining that date is a priority, and we do not seek any adjournment of the conference notwithstanding the proposed adjustments to the motion schedule.
