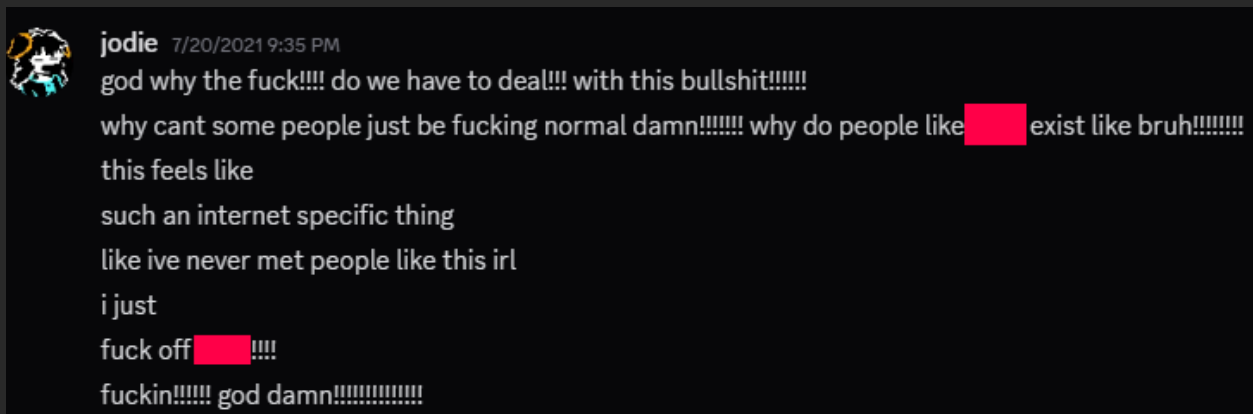

*Jodie asks her discord of Goons why people like me exist. Apparently I'm supposed to feel like a half assed apology will make it fine.*

Hey Jodie. You've just "apologized" for the people you hurt within your toxic friend group. Not only do we not accept it, but you've only made us angrier. I'm back :)

Hello. It is me. The Nerd. If you're Jodie reading this, then you've probably just shat your pants. The document from August 1st, and Jodie's subsequent response, have activated dormant hater genes within my very soul and I established communication with The Tickler and their contact in the rainy streets of Gotham City (because how else do you find somebody named The Fucking Tickler? (it was actually just discord dms)). My identity? Barely hidden. My rage? Palpable. I have waited since 2021 to get back at Jodie and so have several people I've been in touch with, all of them not even referenced in the original document *or* Jodie's response. As a hater, it is my sworn duty to learn everything I can about the person I'm hating, and to not give them a moment's rest.

Before I get into picking apart the response properly, I'd like to draw attention to something said back in Tickler's original document.

In my server, Jodie wanted a private channel and vc for herself and people she specifically chose to be in this secret chat. It was initially supposed to be for when she got overwhelmed in VC or something, but this situation spiraled so out of control that the channel got archived forever. I never thought you could recreate class warfare in a discord server, but I accidentally created a space for that. Oops.

This was not like class warfare. If I had to pick better terms to describe it, it was like a...

# Part 1: Cult of Personality (Or Lack Thereof)

*((Really, take away the cry-type venting and who is she? I can't even remember.))*

Have you ever done some diving into cults, or how they operate? Oftentimes they exhibit a hierarchical structure among its members, the leaders at the top exhibit almost all of the control, their closest supporters surrounding them, and a flock of useful idiots there to act as a shield, or propagandists. In this Discord server, Jodie had a private circle of people who she knew would follow her unquestioningly. What was once a private place for when she got overwhelmed came to be a meeting place where Jodie and several others would simply shit talk other people behind their backs because none of them had the courage to talk like adults. Ban first, ask questions later, you know, Discord moderator stuff.

The server members, the “useful idiots” in my analogy, would only ever be given partial information, in a vague way as to intentionally downplay her actions and the drama in general. You might be asking me, “Ms. Nerd, all of this action happened years ago, you certainly shouldn’t be holding Jodie to the same standard as all of those years ago!” Which, to that I say, have a look at this, it’s pretty cool:

After the initial callout, Jodie continued to cultivate a discord wherein she tries to take the heat off of herself by citing issues with how the document was written and structured rather than directly engaging with the content within to her fans. She puts the onus onto the document to prove her innocence, as she habitually desires to control the conversation with the benefit of the

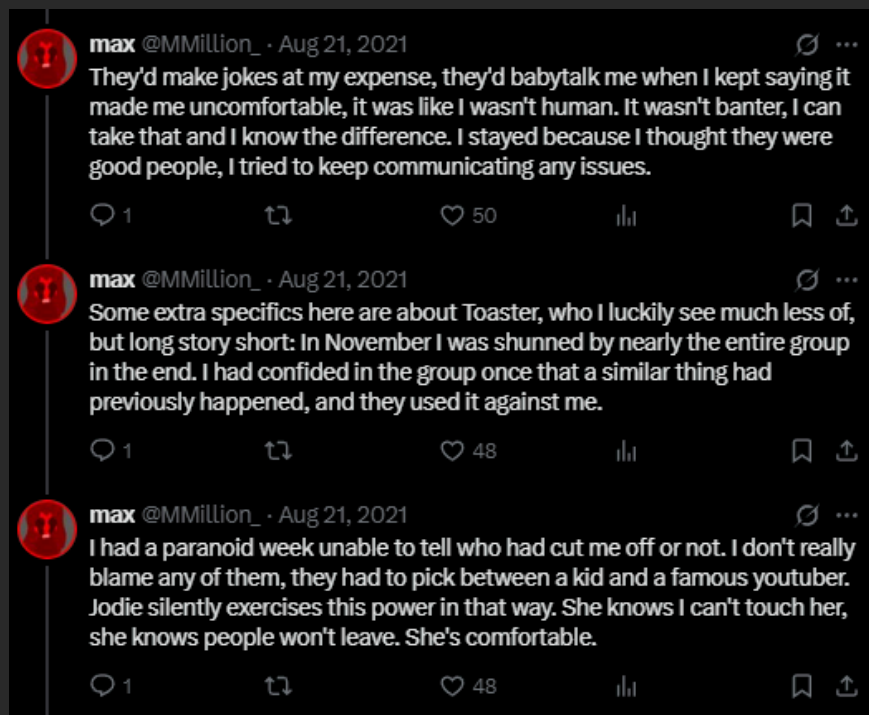
backspace key, rather than having the balls to talk to people directly face to face. When I was around, her method of excising people she deemed undesirable would be a shotgun ban to the face rather than direct communication. Do you know why? Because it would be easier to give her fans a thrice revised public service announcement than actually engaging in honest conversation. If you've taken the liberty of checking her Youtube, you've probably noticed her deleting all of the comments relating to the drama. Cultivating an image is her number one priority.

And what happens when people who know the truth aren't willing to go along with her false, fabricated image?

## Part 1.5: Excommunication

*"You leave me no choice but to declare you excommunicado. The doors to any service or provider in connection with the Continental are now closed to you. I am so sorry. Your life is now forfeit." - Winston Scott, John Wick Chapter 2*

Excommunication is a method used by cults to exert control and instill fear into its members. The fear of losing contact with the people in the cult is used to keep people loyal, to keep them obedient. Jodie would regularly excommunicate people from her circle and everybody within for the crime of sympathizing with people she deemed "enemies." It's not hard to find evidence of this online.

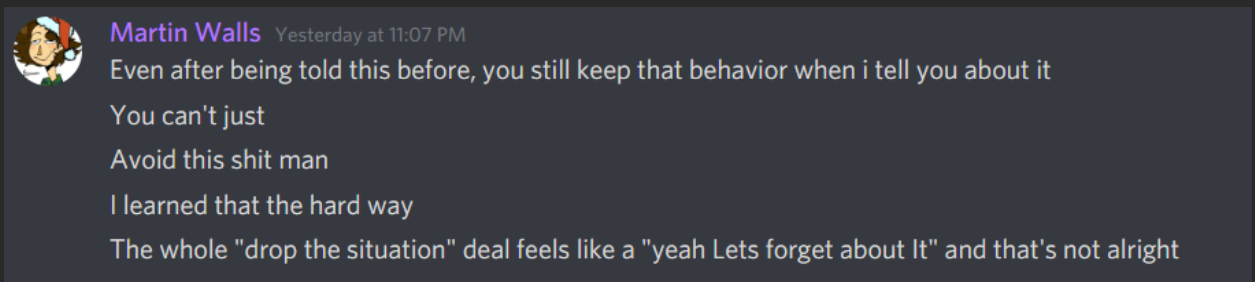
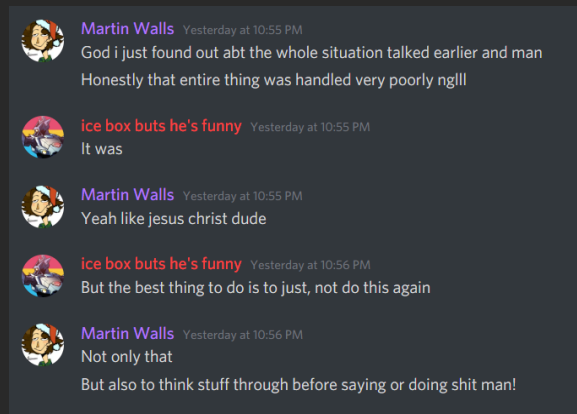
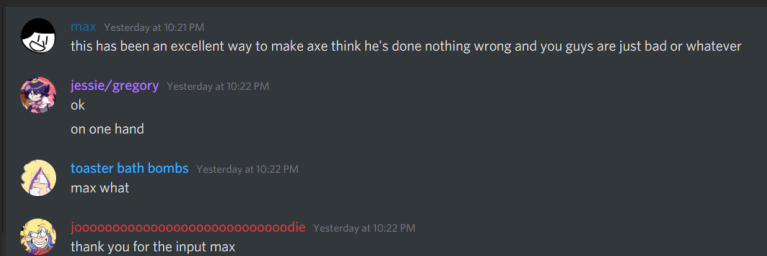


This was not random, this was not spur of the moment, it was controlled, and it was immediate. Several people, myself included, would be ousted from an entire friend group in the blink of an eye. People I personally had been having fun with would cut me off the exact same day without even attempting to reach out. This type of excommunication was traumatizing for both me and several others who were unlucky enough to fall victim to it, lasting for years until they were able to settle into new groups and communities. Several of us only had each other to rely upon.

## Note from MMillion

I care even less about hiding my username on a document like this than these other people. I just don't mind the downsides, and it's so much work otherwise. I hope you can forgive everyone here for what you might feel are the "goofier" qualities of all this exposé writing, I think they've earned it at this point.

The first person to get excommunicated was 13 years old. Specifically, this kid was gradually bullied by Jodie until finally getting verbally dogpiled by her and a number of close friends in the group, leaving on November 21st, 2020, and becoming dead to her. It was completely petty and really rocked the boat. The strongest dissenting voice was the wonderful Martin Walls, the only proper adult in the room:



Including Martin and the kid, 6 people left. It was taking Martin's side that made me even more of a target (I had already been an outlet for Jodie for at least a month prior), the heat gradually turned up on me and I was bullied out for my "snark" on November 24th. Famously, this was Jodie having a heated gamer moment in Among Us and directing it at me. I took the opportunity to leave, and so I was excommunicated and blocked by just about the entire circle instantly.

I had understood the system well enough at that point. I didn't want to be part of the monthly casting out of the latest unfaithful teenager. Of course, that made me the perfect example to make, and so I was cut off. If you're one of those conditional friends who blocked me everywhere and didn't reach out to me, my door is always open to make up and forgiveness is pretty easy to get. I know just because we were in a cult doesn't make it impossible because I wasn't alone to begin with.

The machine kept going. In my absence I figured the whole thing must have been normalized. Bit by bit I was effectively building a support group of young teens bullied out of Jodie's personal chats. This sounds difficult to take too seriously, but Jodie surrounded herself with a good amount of people who lived online like her, so being excommunicated and smeared privately did a lot of harm. I saw her giving a live interview one night and was so frustrated by the lack of justice that I wrote my comparatively simple Twitter thread in August of 2021, partial screenshots previously included in here. That was my project to try and let people know, break the cult up if I could, and by all accounts it failed miserably because this 121 page document still needed to come out four years later. I don't really think you can break a cult from the outside. I don't know what to do but wait for people to come around on their own, even at their own risk.

The writer of the rest of this followup, calling herself "The Nerd", was trying to reach the same goal around that time. Her plan was to break things up from the inside, she did a good job getting people asking questions and changing just a few minds, but the work still wasn't finished. Then this person, calling herself "The Tickler" for some reason, makes all of this happen years later. I wanted to help, here I am.

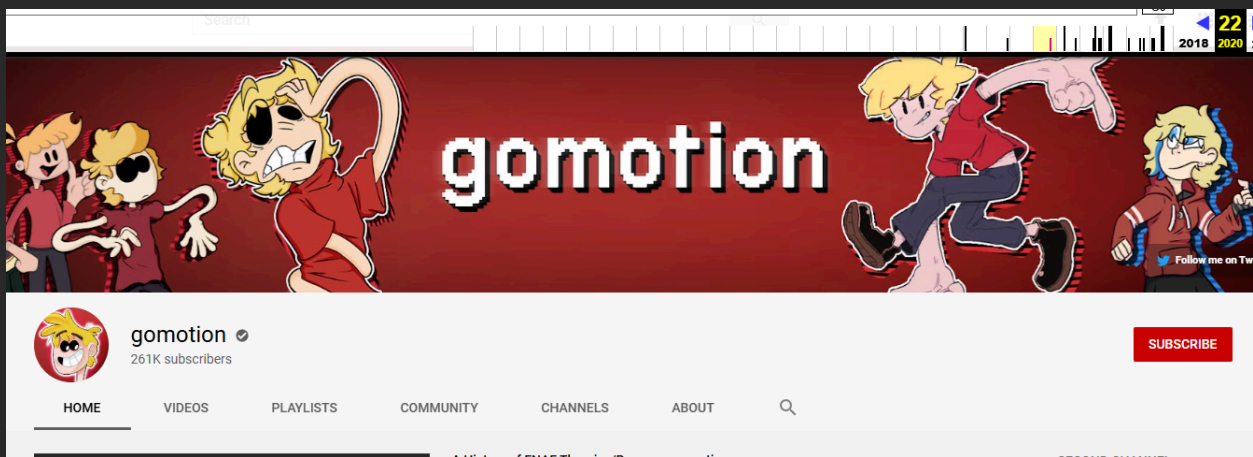
What I can do is keep spreading the word so nobody else falls into this. I'm asking you to see how this controlled shunning behavior has continued all along, how the most recently known person to be shunned is this new whistleblower sharing her story of sexual assault, and understand that if Jodie were to say this is all old news, no longer reflective of her as a person, she is lying. It will happen again.

I'm asking you to look at those leaked screenshots of her chats recently and, with the context of this and the previous document, see that her support system now is a repeat of her support system from five years ago, how she would crush them under her heel if they stopped orbiting her and her only, and how she needs them as her tools, and understand that this is exactly how it has been all along, with a rotating set of well-meaning, isolated people as Jodie burns through them. Follow-up questions are welcome.

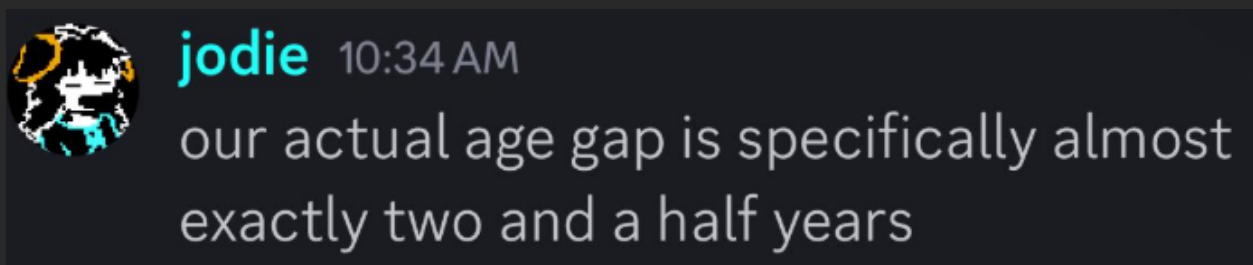
None of the several people that were excommunicated from Jodie's inner circle received proper apologies prior to Jodie's response. I've asked. Had Jodie properly realized the harm this Discord had done back in 2021 like she claims, several of the people excommunicated during that era would have received apologies. We did not. The "I'm so sowwys" given in the response document never would have reached us had the Tickler not outed her for being an asshole. There is no other way to read these apologies than as being disingenuous and a method of saving face.

## Part 2: Power Imbalance, Jodie's Response

I believe Jodie's attempt to get people to focus on the technicalities of her own personal definition of grooming (purely in relation to age) is her way of avoiding the way she would abuse the power she held over her fans and friends. It does not matter the age differential, it does not matter if they were "both unwell," Jodie held tangible social power over The Tickler, and was immensely irresponsible with how they used it. Jodie already had 260k subscribers back in 2020 when the screenshots in the original thread begin, as proven by the Wayback Machine.



The Tickler, comparatively, did not have this following. Jodie's influence was derived from this differential in power, over not only The Tickler but everyone in her close circle. When asked whether or not they'd like to remain friends with the nobody, or the Youtuber, the answer could not have been more obvious. When there's a substantial power imbalance present, a small age gap becomes only a secondary factor. Grooming is not only about age. It is when somebody exerts influence and control over somebody "lesser" in an attempt to extract something from them, sexually or otherwise, and in this case, Jodie is a groomer by definition.

When re-reviewing the original letter published by The Tickler through this context, it becomes clear that Jodie was, consciously or not, using her influencer status to ensure that The

Tickler would remain loyal to her, because the alternative would be excommunication, or Jodie using her large following to go after The Tickler. Jodie used her fans as outlets because she knew they wouldn't dare go against her.

Jodie using her fans as a way to make up for her insecurities and what she thinks she lacks... sound familiar?

However, one day Jodie approached me with something that sounded exciting: She said she had a crush on someone, who was a mutual friend of ours who met her by being a fan of her channel. Things seemed very hopeful!  
For 3 days.

Jodie dumped this friend 3 days after admitting a crush to them, and it was horrible. My friend's self-worth was damaged for an extremely long time after this event, and Jodie just felt "they needed to get over it."

Jodie's manipulation and underhanded use of the power she held is the undercurrent that runs through the entire original document, and Jodie knows this. This is why I was so quick to squash beef with The Tickler (why do I have to keep using this name). I had previously viewed them as an enabler of Jodie, and if you were to interpret the screenshots in the original letter unfaithfully (who would ever do such a thing?), it wouldn't be hard to come to the same conclusion. They were not an enabler, however, they were just afraid of what would happen were they to go against Jodie's perception of how things simply were, because going against her judgements could lead to losing all the people they held dear.

To call The Tickler an enabler of Jodie's actions would be to imply she had any other choice, but when Jodie held her social life captive, there was nothing she could be expected to do except play along. In Jodie's response she tries to blame the Tickler for mimicking her behavior back towards her, using that as a way to "gotcha" them into being just as bad as her, or something stupid like that. I hope I've done an adequate enough job at explaining why exactly that line of reasoning is just kind of inherently borked, and if you don't understand it. Jodie argues that the "sister" thing was reciprocated by the Tickler (who I will now be simply referring to as T for the sake of my sanity).

Here's my follow up to this claim:

**Early on in the friendship, I began to refer to T as my 'sister'. This never, ever, alluded to anything more than a sincere platonic affection towards my friend. This was reciprocated quickly by T, who began to refer to me similarly.**

T was a *15 year old*, bro??? When you put a young person into an incredibly dangerous position they're going to want to look for a sisterly role model or any kind of familial figure to help themselves get through it, it's just that you made yourself that role model so you could use it to exercise more control over T.

*The following passage is NSFW.*

As mentioned in the original document, on two occasions, I masturbated to some of the art T made of me as a girl, early in our friendship. It is incredibly important to state that this had **nothing** to do with the artist - I simply felt euphoric seeing myself as a female. This behavior then ceased immediately.

A few months after T had turned 16, while I was 18, I masturbated thinking of myself as them. Similarly, I felt euphoric imagining myself as female. There were **no** ulterior motives to this.

*Page 5 of Jodie's response*

Jodie knows this! Notice the wording of "a few months after T had turned 16," notice how she deliberately tries to avoid saying that number, 15, at all costs because 16 holds a more "mature" mental connotation for people. This deliberate wordage shows that even now she's trying to manipulate the conversation in a way that shows a greater degree of sliminess than there would be if this was simply the actions of somebody who was mentally unwell.

**I recognize now that T and I were both feeding into each other's fear of abandonment.** I softened my words as I was afraid of hurting them if I ever left, and decided that I could still make things work in a healthy way. I was not in my right mind. I wish I'd been advised to leave.

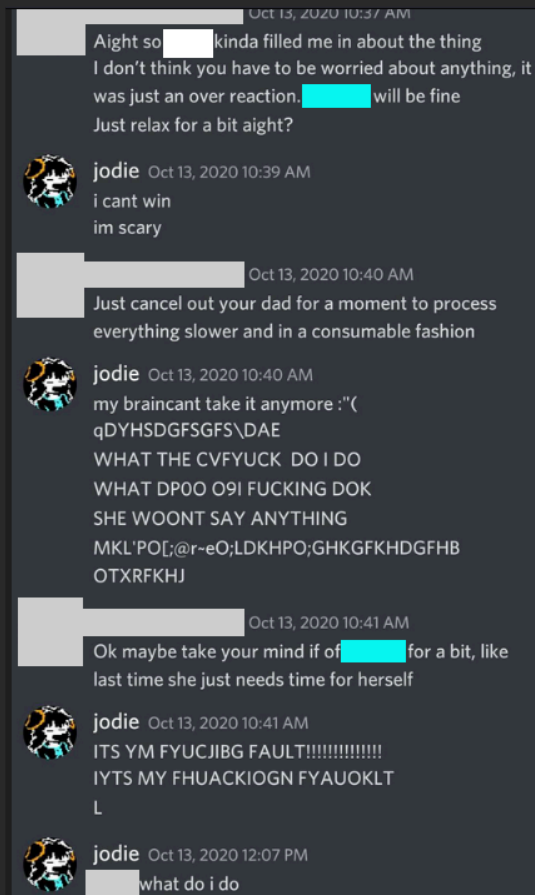
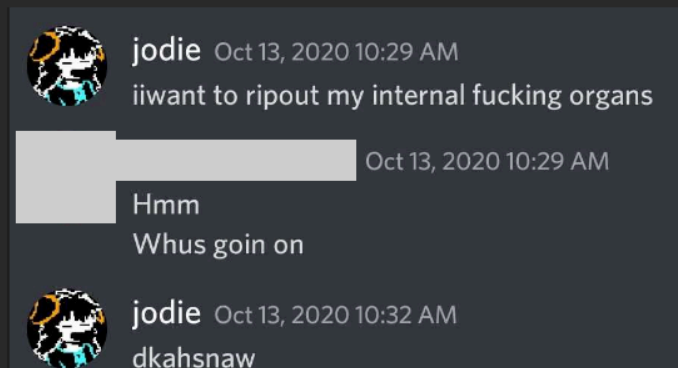
As established earlier, T was in a position of greater vulnerability due to the difference in their position, and power. T was only feeding into Jodie's fears out of anxiety over the power that Jodie held over them. Jodie's manipulation was much more calculated than this, and this can be shown clearly in how she treated her friends other than T.

## Part 2.5: Everyone's a Therapist on a Two Week Notice

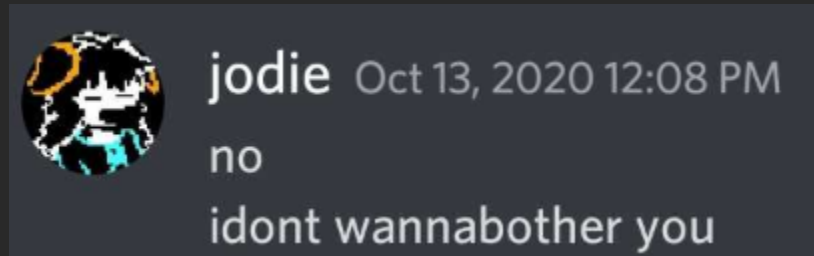
*You'll never know it was there until it's time to leave.*

Jodie would use all of her friends as outlets, as therapists. At the same time, these people were disposable to her. On the same day you'd be assigned as Jodie's therapist, she was equally likely to shit talk you behind your back. Jodie did not come to these people for help. She came to these people to feed on their validation. The three day relationship mentioned in the original letter shows this, but since then even more people have come to us to provide screenshots and evidence to show that Jodie would feed off of her friends for this twisted validation, empowering her to keep acting the way she did while not having to change anything about herself at all, because her friends simply didn't want her to cry, or worse.

This is not a diatribe against venting in discord to your friends. It is a warning to stay away from people who see your goodwill as a resource to be extracted.



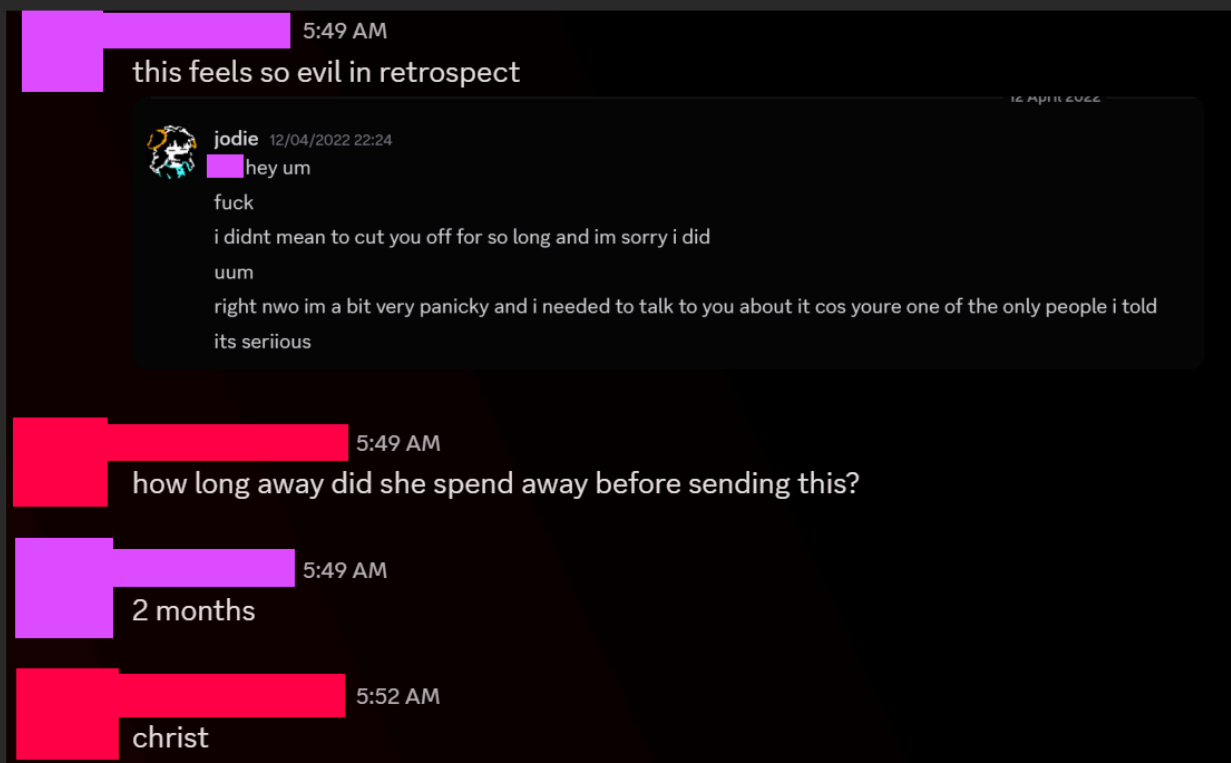
In these screenshots, T had been offline for an insignificant amount of time, which prompted Jodie to immediately turn her head towards another person, who she proceeds to just lay so much god damn shit on. Not soon after all of this she tells them that she didn't want to bother them, despite already having bothered them for two hours.



*So why did you*

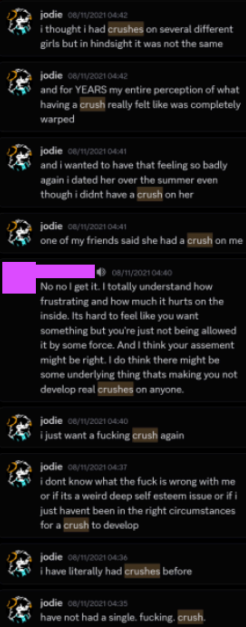
Jodie would trauma dump on people in an effort to gain their validation, then gather sympathy from them before moving on to the next person in an effort to make herself appear more sympathetic and like she wasn't using every minor around her as a mini-psychiatrist. The anonymous user in this screenshot was excommunicated one year after this for having a waning loyalty in Jodie, and for the heinous crime of liking cruder humor. Another therapist used up then thrown out when they stopped agreeing with her every word on her whim. If T wasn't available, she'd simply move on to the next.

One of the things glossed over in the original document immediately stuck out to me as something worth investigating further was the three day relationship Jodie had with one of her fans (which has already been referenced multiple times in earlier parts of this document). This immediately struck me as indicative of this kind of quick toxic validation seeking behavior, so I began to dig deeper, and what do you know?

Also like digging through 2021 dms made me remember how many times she just showed up in my dms cause she was drunk and freaking out jesus how did I put up with that

It was at this point that something that I hoped would never happen happened. My beef with Jodie was squarely in 2021, about the toxic discord group she was a part of and the way it treated its victims. It is a great tragedy that I'm going to have to write from a personal perspective about something entirely new to me, but I learned that Jodie's relationship with this person also reeked of ulterior motives. I had come to learn that this person had a crush on me at the time they got together, and Jodie consciously knew of this.

i was also informed you had a crush on me at the time (past is in the past who cares) and my immediate thought was that jodie was trying to poach you in fear that us hypothetically getting together back then wouldve deprived her of an outlet which is scummy and manipulative

I'm genuinely, honestly baffled. I'm at a loss for what to type. Jodie knew that this person already had feelings for me, but set it in her mind that she needs to be partners with this person. She words her messages in a way as to get people to encourage her to try to initiate a relationship regardless. Quitting while ahead was never an option to her, so she decided to ruin the self worth of one of her fans. Much like Jodie's jealousy over T's partner, I was viewed as a threat to one of her vent sponges, threatening to take away this person's affection. She used up one of her friends in hopes it'd make her feel better about herself, then threw them out when she decided it wasn't working. She was 17. Jodie was 19. And so the pattern continues.

Unfortunately, this one is more serious.

Jodie played her hand with this in a way as to stop us from being able to get empiric evidence as to what transpired that night. Tyto (who is fine with their identity being shown in this document) was one of Jodie's minor therapists, only being 14 at around the time of this happening. Tyto, coincidentally, was also in the private part of the discord where all of the fucked up shit established prior took place. Jodie knew that talking about them over text would leave behind logs that Tyto would be able to see, so she took to the jodie hole's voice chat. What we do know is that there were people in that voice channel who remember the event.

It's been long enough now that the people's memories of what happened in this chat are hazy, so take this with a grain of salt if you wish, but I believe it to be true. Tyto was one of Jodie's "friends" at the time, but like all of Jodie's friendships, it was conditional. She had no problem talking behind Tyto's back after a serious moment in their life.

*I genuinely don't remember what Jodie said but I remember she was incredibly fucking mean and inconsiderate to her situation*

*T's statement about the situation*

So, all in all, good one Jodie. Way to obscure the evidence. In the absence of that however, we can make a pretty certain conclusion. Tyto was one of Jodie's personal therapists and vent sponges, and was later thrown out. The pattern repeats. The pattern consumes all, and once it's done doing that, it finds new people.

If you're reading this, if you're one of Jodie's current friends, and you see her current behavior in any of this, run as far away as you can. Jodie, however, will tell you that this behavior was because of her unchecked OCD and mental illness.

Why don't we look into that?

## Part 3, Finale: Take Responsibility, i.e., That's Not How OCD Works

Jodie seems intent on coating her response in discussion of mental health issues. Jodie claims to be seeing a therapist at the end, which gives us the impression that what she is saying is something that has been backed up or told to her by said therapist. This poses a problem for me. What is a poor little hater like me expected to do when Jodie has the supposed backing of a “variety” of mental health professionals behind her? She finds her own, of course. :)

The following is a statement from a social worker and a mental health professional whose studies included underage victims of sexual abuse:

*“As a mental health professional I can only comment on the mental health stuff, which is to say that mental illness does not abdicate responsibility from Jodie. Upwards of 55%, (Neal W Dunsieith Jr, 2004, S L McElroy 1999) of sexual violence perpetrators suffer from psychiatric disorders, but that does not make them any less a perpetrator. Knowing a child from 15 years of age and engaging in emotional exploitation of this child for several years. Adults are met with the responsibility so as to understand that those under the age of 18 are in the eyes of the law, unable to consent nor understand the implications and impact of these types of relationships, and that when seeking aid must do so with other adults. Jodie, from 18 onwards, repeatedly ignores this responsibility. Jodie then moves this emotionally exploitative relationship into a sexually exploitative one after having enticed and groomed this child in a vulnerable position for several years. The impact this will have on the survivor will statistically lead to psychiatric disorders (Sian Oram 2019) which will make the victim even more likely to be abused in this fashion. Jodie's actions have had an intense impact on both the victims and the social circle they encompass. I am also a mandatory reporter and I am facing an ethical dilemma on whether to report this to authorities or not.”*

There you have it, straight from the horse's mouth. The entire argument that Jodie's response is predicated on, the idea of her being mentally unwell, and of T's complicity therein, is foundationally incorrect and does not work to absolve her in any way of her actions. I have been working with this mental health professional throughout the writing of this document to ensure that nothing I'm saying isn't factual or misrepresentative of anything in relation to mental health. Jodie's deflection of her relationship with T onto mental illness is not the problem here, the problem is that she should not have relied on T in such a fashion to begin with.

Said social worker also had thoughts on Jodie's deflection onto OCD specifically. I'd prefer not to editorialize their words, so I'll post them as they were here, with some edits from me for grammar.

gender dysphoria. **I had severe issues with oversharing, especially with somebody I had just met.** At this time, my OCD was also, what I now recognize, at its most aggressive. I felt like I needed constant reassurance. This was something I had been doing with several friends leading up to my friendship with T, but with how close and vulnerable we were with each other, **I ended up consistently asking T for reassurance for my OCD obsessions. This is the worst thing somebody with OCD can do, and I fell into that trap.**

*Page 5 of Jodie's response*

*"Let's break down how OCD affects an individual- the sufferer will be met with unwanted thoughts and obsessions, which can range from harming others or the self, disease, disaster, doubting, having a hard time dealing with uncertainty, and various other examples.*

*The 'disorder' lies in both the obsession and the 'correction', which present as compulsions such as hand-washing until your skin becomes raw, checking doors over and over again to make sure they're locked, checking the stove over and over again to make sure it's off, counting in certain patterns, silently repeating a prayer, word or phrase, or trying to replace a bad thought with a good thought.*

*With that said, the disorder lies in these obsessive unwanted thoughts and the overcorrection, ritualistic and self soothing behaviors made to cope with these thoughts.*

*Forming an inappropriate relationship with a minor is often the subject of these obsessions, it's been seen in many cases- however, this leads to overcorrection in manners such as avoiding minors obsessively, attempting to scare off the minor and potentially harming them out of fear, or self soothing self harm or risky behavior.*

*The claims from Jodie that their OCD trapped them into a relationship with a minor is nothing but deflection. Jodie either did not care for the impact of their behavior or actively sought out people who were vulnerable and able to be easily exploited. Someone who could affirm their poor behavior and not be able to properly understand the nature of the relationship that Jodie was forming with T.”*

With that, I'm pretty sure it's time for me to let up on the gas and give my closing arguments, which I assure you are very mature. My identity? Easily discoverable. My rage? Intense. Your response? *Dogshit*. I hope I've done a well enough job at explaining exactly why. Jodie's response is nothing but deflection and victim blaming by a person who desires nothing more than to control the conversation into thinking she's someone with no control whatsoever. Do with this information what you will.
