REPORT - NARRATIVE

On 01/10/13 at 0620 hours I responded to 3970 Scott Drive Forest Park, GA 30297 in reference to a suspicious vehicle call. Upon arrival I observed the above listed vehicle parked behind the house. The complainant (Baisden, Chianti) came out of the house and stated that she did not recognize the vehicle and could not tell if there was anyone inside it. I then approached the vehicle. As I approached I observed a black male asleep in the driver seat and a black female asleep laying across the back seat. The female appeared to be laying with a child's safety seat under her head. I knocked on the window and the male woke up and immediately started the vehicle. I opened the driver door and ordered the driver to turn the car off. The male then put the car in reverse and started to drive away from the house. From the position I was in the open driver door hit me and started to push me under the vehicle. I then let go of the driver and the vehicle and rolled away from the vehicle to avoid injuries. While this was going on I could hear a baby begin to cry. The male left the incident location southbound on Scott Drive. The male was a black male wearing a light colored tee shirt and blue jeans. The male had a low hair cut and visible tattoos on his arms. The female was a black female with long hair wearing a light colored hooded sweat shirt. While driving through the front yard the male hit a tree in front of the incident location causing damage to the right side of the vehicle. The county photographer and the Crime Scene Unit were called and responded to process the scene. The Criminal Investigation Division was called and the case was turned over to them.

At approximately 0919 hours Forest Park Police observed a silver Infiniti matching the description and damage of the vehicle the unknown male was driving. The vehicle was unoccupied and parked at the corner of Simpson Place Drive and Rocky View Drive Forest Park, GA 30297. The tag was checked and it returned stolen out of Atlanta Police (reference case # 123430773). The vehicle was then confirmed stolen through the Central Watch Office. Officer Palmer took the vehicle off the computer as stolen. The county photographer and the Crime Scene Unit both responded to process the vehicle. A blue sheet was filled out for the vehicle. New Image Towing picked it up.

Butler stated that he was shot 01-06-12 (see case no, 12001190) and one of the persons involved in the shooting was seen by him driving in the area in a brown Suburban with A and W all over it. Butler stated that he is in far for his life and he think that the person driving the Suburban may try to come after him again. Butler described a dark black male a bit over six feet tall.

I conducted a canvas of the area and discovered a brown Suburban with Ga tag #BRZ4756 with A and W written all over it park in front of 4178 Murray Lake Cir. Due to the fact that the vehicle driver was known to carry a weapon due to the shooting that he was involved in, the driver, offender #1 (Rozier, Jarkese) and the passenger, offender #2 (Brooks, Ray) were both removed from the vehicle at gun point for officer safety. Rozier was observed putting his hands down several times when he was ordered to keep his hands up on the ceiling of the vehicle before he was removed from the vehicle. As Rozier was being removed from the vehicle, the handle of a pistol can be seen sticking out of the console. Rozier and Brooks were placed in handcuffs and placed in the back seat of my patrol vehicle where there Miranda Rights were read. Rozier refused to be put into the police vehicle by stiffening up his body so that it would be harder to put him inside of the vehicle. Once Rozier was placed into the vehicle he began to kick the left rear passenger window causing the window to be damaged. Brooks stated that he doesn't really know Rozier and that he just buys marijuana from Rozier. Less than an ounce of marijuana and two checkbooks, with the name Vincent J. Weille on them, were found inside the pocket Brooks who stated that he just purchased the marijuana from Rozier and Rozier threatened to harm him if he doesn't place the checks in his pocket due to the police coming. During an inventory for impound, it was discovered that a .22 cal pistol with the make of Unique Arms and s/n 624370 and a Tech 9 with the make of Masterpiece Arms s/n B2855 were both found inside of the vehicle along with over 4 oz of marijuana.

Witness #2 (Kimble, Deshon) stated that Brooks was at his place at 4178 Murray Lake Cir when the A and W truck pulled up and Brooks went inside of it then police arrived moments later. A written statement was obtained from Kimble.

Witness #3 (Graves, Shawn) and witness #4 (Spence, Kareem) both stated that Brooks walked up to 4178 Murray Lake Cir then the A and W truck pulled up in front of the house, driven by Rozier, where Brooks got in and moments later police arrived. Written statements were obtained from Spence and Graves.

Rozier and brooks was then transported to the Clayton County Jail using the most direct route. Once at the jail I secured my weapon, magazines, taser, oc spray and asp baton in the trunk of my vehicle. Rozier and brooks was then turned over to Clayton

On 102110 at approximately 1911 hrs. I responded to a report of an armed robbery at 5420 SR-139, Apt. #T-1, College Park, Ga 30349. Upon arrival, I met with Complainant / Victim #1 (Clemmons, Patrick A.) And Victim #2 (Malone, Marco A.). They advised that they were visiting a female friend at the incident location. Victim Clemmons and Victim Malone advised that they had been sitting on the porch for about 30 minutes, when Suspect #1 approached them and started a conversation with them.

Victim Clemmons and Victim Malone did not specify what they talked about, however they advised that Suspect #1 seemed cool and they didn't think anything of him, as they played cards on the back porch table. Victim Clemmons advised that he observed Suspect #1 travel across the parking lot and talk with Witness #1 (Jones, Shantesica) at Apt. #R-7 for a few minutes. Victim Clemmons advised that approximately another 30 minutes passed by as they continued to play cards. Victim Clemmons stated that while playing cards, Suspect #1, while accompanied by Suspects #2 / #3 approached from the side of the "T" building.

Victim Clemmons advised that he didn't pay him any attention since they had talked before. Victim Clemmons advised that moments later he felt something on his right side temple. He stated that he turned his head and observed the barrel of a black in color semiautomatic handgun in his face. Victim Clemmons advised that the frame of the gun was small, so it was probably a .380 or 9mm. He advised that the gun looked like a High Point brand that he had seen at the pawn shop before and that Suspect #1 possessed the firearm in his right hand.

Victim Clemmons advised that Suspect #1 was accompanied by Suspect #2 / #3 who simply stood with him, but did not say anything. Victim Clemmons advised that Suspect #1 stated "Give it up man, I ain't playing!!". Victim Clemmons advised that Suspect #1 subsequently took the following items from him: 1. (1) Apple Ipad, 32 G, unk serial number, Silver / Black in color, valued at \$800 dollars 2. (1) Gucci Brand Men's Wallet, brown in color, valued at \$200 dollars, 3. \$300 dollars cash / miscellaneous credit cards including Georgia Driver's License. 4. (1) AT&T phone, unk brand, model, serial, dark in color, valued at \$300 dollars. I then obtained a written statement from Victim Clemmons.

I conducted a field interview of Victim Malone. He advised essentially the same story as Victim Clemmons, however he advised that Suspect #2 and #3 were short and that Suspect #3 was carrying a small child. Victim Malone advised that Suspect #2 / #3 did not say anything or make any gestures to them. Victim Malone advised that Suspect #1 looked at him and advised him to hand over his wallet, when he was finished with Victim Clemmons. Victim Malone stated that Suspect #1 took the following items. 5. (1) mens wallet, containing approximately \$63 dollars in cash, his Georgia Driver's License, company gas card and money gram card. Victim Malone advised that Suspects #2 / #3 definitely were with Suspect #1, because they left with him.

On 22 October 2010 I responded to the incident location in reference to a follow up investigation. (See original case # 10055590)

Upon arrival I was met by the victim "Malone, Mario" who advised that he had spotted the offender "Brooks, Ray Shard" who was with the suspects that robbed him on 10-21-10. The offender was positively identified by the victim. I next made contact with the offender "Brooks, Ray Shard". The offender was detained. The offender had in his possession a Gucci female bag which contained a 5" flip down Fahrenheit TV and a Valor in dash CD player. The items were placed into Clayton County Police evidence see original case # 10055758. The offender advised that he had just purchased the items from an unknown black male "suspect" for \$5. The offender was read his miranda rights at this time. The offender agreed to speak to me without a lawyer present. The offender was asked what he knew about the armed robbery that happened on 10-21-10. The offender advised that he didn't know anything about the armed robbery and that he was at "Boo" house who lived in the T building. The offender stated that he had not spoken with the victim prior to the robbery. The victim advised that he was in his house approx two hours before police arrived. After further investigation the offender changed his story and advised that he did speak with the victim prior to the robbery. The offender advised that he was outside walking with his son and walked over to the victim and asked him for a beer. The offender advised that the victim gave him a beer and he drank it on the way back to his apartment when several police cars arrived and asked him if he had seen a robbery that had taken place. The offender advised that he told the police that he had not seen a robbery take place.

The offender then stated that he did speak to an unknown black male "suspect" who asked if he had a gun, but the offender advised that he told the black male "no" and went back to his residence. I next advised the offender that his story didn't sound right.

The offender then admitted to making a false statement about the armed robbery. The offender then stated that the reason he had made the false statements about the robbery was because he had just got out of jail for armed robbery and didn't want to get into anymore trouble. The offender next advised that he knew who the two suspect's were that robbed the victim. The offender advised that suspect # 1 was the one who asked if he had a gun earlier and was the suspect that robbed the victim. The offender next advised that suspect # 2 was out in front of the building with suspect # 1 so he believed that suspect # 2 robbed the victim as well because both suspects hang out together. I received the ELSAG alert at 2212 on GA tag PND5633 displayed on a 2000 Oldsmobile Alero, stating it was a possible stolen vehicle. I checked the vehicle through GCIC/NCIC which advised and confirmed the vehicle was reported stolen by Clayton County PD case#13009155 on 02-13-2013.

I immediately searched the surrounding area and could not locate the vehicle, at 2222 hours I located the vehicle parked at 4887 Old Dixie Rd (Western Inn Suites). Once I located the vehicle I observed a male subject inside sitting in the passenger seat. I asked the passenger to step out of the vehicle. The passenger, Dewayne High was detained at that time.

I placed Dewayne in the back seat of MPO Simmons patrol vehicle (Unit 13). I read Dewyanes his MIRANDA rights and he agreed to talk with us. I asked Dewayne who was driving the vehicle and he said "My friend Little Mac just picked me up, we came here to drop some food off then he was going to take me home". I asked him what room he went in and he pointed out room#105, I asked him if he knew Little Macs real name and he said "nah, but I know he in that room though". See MPO Simmons supplemental for further information.

Lt Gentry arrived on scene and we both went to room#105 and started knocking on the door at 2228 hours. We announced ourselves 'Forest Park Police, come to the door', at that time Lt Gentry observed the blinds move in the window and a male subject looked at him. We continued to knock and announce our selves for an hour and a half.

Rashieta Walker arrived on scene at 0001 hours and said "My baby is in room#105". I asked her who was all in the room and she said "Issac, I left my eight month old baby with Issac. He should be the only one in the room".

I continued to knock extremely hard on the 4x4 glass window as well as the steel door announcing 'Forest Park Police, the mother of the baby is here come out with the baby'. Still no one came to the door and someone turned the lights off inside the room. I continued to knock and announce for several more hours asking telling them to bring the baby out. I could here a child inside the room crying as I was knocking. I told Issac to bring the child out so it could be with it's mother.

Lt Gentry advised me he was going to get a warrant for the room. (See Lt Gentry supplemental for further). Lt Gentry advised Clayton County Swat Team was on the way to the scene and that he got a warrant for room#105.

MPO Simmons advised me that he obtained information on a possible name for the subject inside of 'Rashard Brooks'. MPO Simmons advised it was a male subject about 505/506 185lbs and about a 1'' hair cut.

I stood by with Rashieta as she attempted to call Issac to get her baby back. Issac would not pick up his cell phone or the room phone. Rashieta continued to call Issac and texting him for several hours. Rashieta said that Issac was supposed to watch her eight month old child Rian for about an hour or so. Rashieta filled out a statement form for me.

At 0315 hours Clayton County Swat arrived on scene. They pulled there vehicle up in front of room#105 and began to announce. At 0345 Issac walked out of room#105 and he was placed in custody, Rayshard Brooks was also placed in custody. Rashieta's son Rian was plaed back in her custody unharmed.

I read Rayshard Brooks his MIRANDA rights and he agreed to talk to us. I asked him why he did not come to the door and he said "I have been helping Isaac watch the baby all day, I was asleep I didn't here anything". I asked him if he knew about the stolen car and he said "I don't know shit".

I read Issac his MIRANDA rights and he agreed to talk with us. I asked Issac why he didn't come to the door and he

Further investigation determined that there was a male named Issac that was supposed to be inside the room. We also found out that there was an 8 month old baby inside the room. I got on the loud speaker inside of my patrol unit and made several announcements for Issac to come to the door, but no one came to the door. The mother of the baby arrived on scene and she attempted to contact Issac by cell phone, but no contact was made. When she was asked if Issac was the baby's father, she advised no he was a friend. She didn't know who the other male was. The baby's mother stood by in the lobby of Western Inn Suites.

Once Lt. Gentry obtained the search warrant for the room, Captain Harris had dispatch call Clayton County PD for a SWAT call out. Captain Harris arrived on scene and set up a command post at Public Storage which was next to Western Inn Suites. When SWAT arrived on scene they had a team occupy room #106 and the Armored Personnel Carrier(APC) was parked in front of room #105. They gave several verbal commands from the loud speaker of the APC for Issac to come out. A short time later I saw a black male exit the room and he was taken into custody. A SWAT team member brought the baby out of the room and put it in the back of the APC. Another male in that was in the room was taken into custody and brought out of the room.

I went and got the baby's mother from the lobby and a SWAT team member gave her baby to her. For more information see the original report completed by Officer Clayton.

On 3/2/13 at 2223 hrs, MPO Clayton came over the radio indicating that the ELSAG on his patrol car alerted a stolen vehicle being a 2002 Oldsmobile Alero Georgia Tag # PND5633. Myself and other units began checking the Old Dixie Rd/Forest Parkway area for the vehicle. MPO Simmons located the vehicle parked in a parking space at 4887 Old Dixie Rd (Western Inn Suites) with a passenger in the vehicle.

I was told by Simmons that the passenger said the driver of the car known as "Little Mack" got out of the car and went into room 105 with a bag of food. I went to room 105 with Clayton and Officer Bullington. I began knocking on the window of the room and Clayton was knocking on the door. I yelled out Forest Park Police, and the curtain inside the room moved to the side and B/M later identified as Isaac Thiongo was the person who slid the curtain to the side. I saw another black male sitting on the corner of the bed. I told Isaac to open the door, and he closed the curtain and never came to the door. We continued to knock and announce Forest Park Police come and talk to us.

It was a short time later I heard a racking of a shot gun come from the room, I pulled my weapon and Clayton looked at me and said "did you hear that" I told him yes as I took cover behind a pillar just slightly north of the window. I told units in the parking lot to take cover because I heard the racking of a shot gun. I was able to find out more about the stolen vehicle as it was coming in from dispatch on GCIC/NCIC. The vehicle was stolen out of Clayton County PD from a car jacking.

I briefed Capt Harris of the situation, and I went to the office where I obtained the tenant of the room to be Isaac Thiongo. I was then told over the radio by one of the Officers that they heard what may be a woman crying in the room. Capt. Harris requested dispatch to contact Clayton County SWAT commander to have them contact us. I had Clayton, Bullington, Sgt Jackson, K9 Officer Slay, securing the outside perimeter of room 105. Simmons had the passenger Dewayne High detained while the investigation was being conducted. SWAT Sgt. Marttel arrived on scene and Capt Harris and I briefed him on the situation. Sgt Marttel said he spoke to his supervisor and that he would do what ever Forest Park needed done.

I then saw a female pull up in a vehicle and she got out of the car frantic saying her baby is in the room. She indicated that Isaac Thiongo was watching the baby while she went to get some food. I asked her what her name was and she said Rasheita Walker. I asked what the babies name is and she said his name is Rian Anthony Walker and she said he is only 8 months old. Rasheita said she wanted her baby. I had Rasheita call Isaac but he was refusing to answer the phone.

I heard Clayton banging on the window telling Isaac and the guy in the room that the mother is here for the baby and that they needed to open the door and bring the baby out of the room because now they were interfering with custody. We still did not get an answer from the people in the room. At that time I left the scene and went to the Forest Park PD where I began typing up a search warrant for room 105 at 4887 Old Dixie Rd (Western Inn Suites). After I completed the search warrant I called Clayton County Magistrate court Judge Hayward and she told me to

meet her at the Clayton County court house.

I went to the Clayton County court house and provided Judge Hayward the search warrant. I swore under oath that all facts in the typed search warrant was true. I was granted the search warrant docket # 2013SW04857. I called Captain Harris on the phone and told him the search warrant was granted. Captain Harris then had dispatch call Clayton County dispatch to have Clayton County SWAT Team activated. I went to Forest Park PD and made a copy of the search warrant so it could be given to the SWAT commander Sgt Marttel.

I went back to Western Inn Suites and gave Sgt Marttel a copy of the search warrant, he said he was going to suit up and his team would be at scene shortly. A short time later Clayton County SWAT Team arrived in a APC vehicle. They briefed us to let us know that the APC vehicle would pull up in front of the room and a negotiator would be on the PA system to attempt to talk the subjects out of the room so the baby could be taken out safely. The negotiator gave a few commands to come out with hands up and that we knew the baby was in the room. It was a short time of SWAT being on scene that the door to room 105 opened up and Isaac was the first person to come out of the room with his hands up in the air. Isaac was ordered to the ground by the negotiator and one of the SWAT members placed flex cuffs on his wrists behind his back.

I saw that the second subject known as Ray Shard Brooks was handcuffed with flex cuffs behind his back by a SWAT Team member also. The baby was taken out of the room safely and reunited with it's mother Rasheita without any incident. The room was checked for the keys to the stolen vehicle and no keys were located. The room was secured and Ray Shard ad Isaac was taken into custody by Clayton for state charges of Interference with custody, false imprisonment, obstruction, cruelty to children. Ray Shard was also charged with Theft by Receiving a stolen vehicle.

I let the scene and went to the Forest Park PD to assist with paper work, during the early hours we had five different people in one room for different incidents. The four guys was sitting together in a small circle area when I said "how many tattoos do you have Little Mack". At that time Ray Shard made the comment that his name is Ray Shard. I then said "did I say I was talking to you". Why would you think I was talking to you, and nobody but you answered when I said that". He then looked down to the ground and didn't say anything else. I notarized the Warrantless Arrest Affidavits and I placed a copy of the search warrant in the detectives box so it could e sscanned and attached to the report.

On March 2nd, 2013 at 2223 hours I assisted MPO Clayton with an occupied stolen vehicle at 4887 Old Dixie Rd (Western Inn Suites). When I arrived I saw a male passenger in the passengers front side of the car. MPO Clayton ordered him out of the car and he was hand cuffed. The male passenger was then given to me to keep custody off. I patted him down for weapons, and put him in the back of my patrol car. He was read Miranda by MPO Clayton, and he agreed to talk to us. He told MPO Clayton that he only knew the driver as "Lil Mack" and did not know his real name. The passenger told me that his name was Dwayne High.

I explained to him that the car was reported stolen, and was car jacked from the original owner. He appeared very shocked when I told him, and he said "man if I would have known that I would have never got in that car. I don't roll like that man". He then went on to tell me that about 20 minutes before the police showed up, he was standing at the corner of Jonesboro Rd and Conley Rd waiting for a ride to Moreland Ave to see a girl. Dwayne said he saw "Lil Mack" in the car. "Lil Mack" offered him a ride to Moreland, but said he needed to stop by his hotel room at Western Inn Suites first. Dwayne said that "Lil Mack" needed to drop of "some shit" meaning drugs. He also mentioned that "Lil Mack" had two doggy bags of food in the car with him. When "Lil Mack" went into the room he took the food with him, so he was assuming that there was another person inside the room.

Dwayne said that "Lil Mack" usually carries a gun because he is a drug dealer. He usually sells crack cocaine and marijuana according to Dwayne. Dwayne said that he had no idea the car was stolen and would do anything he could to help the investigation, and was very cooperative. I asked him if there was anyway he could find out "Lil Mack`s" real name and date of birth. He said that he could make some phone calls and see what information he could find out. He agreed to keep the phone on speaker mode so that I could hear everything that was being said.

Dwayne called a female that he knows as "KeKe". On the phone she claimed to be "Lil Mack`s" cousin. "KeKe" said that his real name was Rashard Brooks, but did not know how to spell it. She also said that he was born in 1993, was about 5`05``, 165lbs, clean shaven with a short hair cut. "KeKe" went on to say that Rashard had been released from Clayton County Jail about 2 months prior for a gun charge. She also mentioned that "Lil Mack" did time in Rice Street for murder. Later during the phone call "KeKe" said that she would try to contact Rashard`s sister(unknown name). "KeKe" called back 3 times saying that the sister was not answering the phone.

During the last phone call "KeKe" and Dwayne were talking about the stolen car. "KeKe" said "I have seen "Lil Mack" driving the stolen car for about 2 or 3 weeks. Dwayne told "KeKe" that he remembered "Lil Mack" saying something a few weeks ago about getting the car from some apartments near Thurmond and Conley Rd. "Lil Mack" told Dwayne previously that he gave some white guy some dope in exchange for borrowing the car. "Lil Mack" said the deal went bad so he kept the car.

I asked Dwayne to fill out a statement, but he said he does not like writing stuff down, and politely refused. I relayed all of this information to MPO Clayton and to the incident command post. Once Dwayne was no longer needed, I gave him a courtesy ride to Jonesboro Rd and Conley Rd.

On March 4th, 2013 at approximately 0730 hours, I received an evidence processing request from MPO Clayton in reference to case number 13-001405. MPO Clayton requested that a 2002 Oldsmobile Alero (VIN: 1G3N152F22C279321) be processed for evidence of value. I noted that the request form had the location of the vehicle to be processed, which was the Forest Park Police Department's sally port.

On March 4th, 2013 at approximately 0900 hours, I received a signed consent to search form from Valerie Bell (owner of the vehicle). After receiving the consent form I began processing the vehicle. I started processing by obtaining photographs of the outside and inside of the vehicle. While obtaining photographs of the inside of the car I noted several items. These items included, a black leather jacket, black "A" hat, black "Croc" slippers, packet of Goody's headache powder, and two drinking glasses.

I continued processing the vehicle searching for latent impressions using black fingerprint powder. I focused latent impression processing to the area's most likely to have been touched by the suspect(s) in this case. These area's included, the outside of all main cabin doors, gas compartment, rear view mirror, drivers side vanity mirror, Goody's headache powder package, White Owl cigar package found in middle dash console, White Owl package found in trunk and inside drivers side window. I located a latent impression in the form of a finger on the Goody's headache powder package. I obtained a photograph of the impression with the presence of a scale. I collected the latent impression using clear fingerprint lifting tape and placing it onto a white backing card. I also located a latent impression in the form of a finger on the inside window of the front drivers side compartment. I collected the latent impression using clear fingerprint lifting tape and placing it onto a white backing card. I did not locate any other latent impressions that were of value for identification.

I contacted the owner of the vehicle (Valerie Bell) and asked her about the items that were in the vehicle. She advised me that the black leather jacket, black "A" hat, two drinking glasses, Goody's headache powder package and the two White Owl Packages, did not belong to her and did not belong in the car. I collected those items and placed them into brown paper evidence bags.

I conducted a thorough search of the vehicle looking for any other evidence of value. In the cup holder of the middle console, I located a small clear plastic apple seed baggy. Underneath the driver's seat I located a small clear plastic baggy which contained a green leafy substance. Also, under the driver's side seat near the rear of the seat I located a third clear plastic baggy that contained a white powder like substance. I collected the baggies, processed them for latent impressions using black fingerprint powder. I did not develop any latent impressions of value for identification. I placed the three baggies into brown paper evidence bags.

Once I completed processing the vehicle I turned it back over to Forest Park Wrecker and called the victim to let them know the vehicle was ready to be picked up.

On March 25th, 2014 at approximately 1000 hours I submitted latent impressions collected from case number 13-001405 to IAFIS. I was notified of a hit through IAFIS which was a hit on a known fingerprint impression of a Rashad Brooks (FBI ID: 938121FD6). I noted the IAFIS hit was related to the collected developed impression labeled as L2 (Latent 2). I retrieved the collected latent impression labeled as L2, which had been stored in the Forest Park Police Departments CSI case file.

I examined the latent impression labeled as L2 and noted that it presented in an arch formation. On the rear of the backing card containing the collected latent impression I noted the following information written in black ink:

Type of Offense: Theft by Receiving
Location: Goody's Headache Powder Package
Prints lifted by: J. Ashworth

I collected the developed latent impression using clear fingerprint lifting tape. I placed my initials partially over the tape extending onto the card to ensure the integrity of the collected impression. On the tape just above the latent impression, I drew a curved line, which I used to indicate the top of the latent impression. Just to the right of the curved line I placed a label "L2". Additionally, I placed an arrow just above the curved line to indicate the orientation of the impression.

I continued by examining the known impression from the IAFIS hit which was labeled as being donated by a Rashad Brooks (FBI ID: 938121FD6). I noted the known impression presented in an arch pattern. I noted the known impression from the IAFIS hit contained clear detail.

I compared the developed latent impression collected from the evidence retrieved from the scene to the known impression labeled as belonging to Rashad Brooks. I determined that both impressions presented in the same pattern (arch). I continued by comparing both impressions focusing on the minutia presented within them. With the use of a magnifying loop and two ridge counters I located 14 individual points of minutia that were shared by both impressions. I did not locate any points of minutia in either impression that differed from the other impression. I concluded the developed latent impression collected from the evidence was donated by the same person as the impression from the IAFIS hit labeled as Rashad Brooks (FBI ID: 938121FD6).

I had Inv. K. Reynolds compare the two impressions. She agreed with my findings above the collected latent impression collected from the evidence was donated by the same person who donated the impression from the IAFIS hit.

I stored the collected latent impressions in the Forest Park Police Department for comparison against known suspects in this case.

I parked my patrol vehicle away from the location and walked to the house. As I approached, I could here a man and woman yelling inside the residence. The glass storm door was locked but the front door was open. I could not see anyone when I looked in the door. I knocked several times but no one came to the door. I went to the side carport door and knocked but again got no answer. I continued hearing the man and woman yelling. I specifically heard the man say "give me my money." and the woman saying "let me go." It also sounded like she was crying.

After several minutes, a black man came to the door and asked why we were at his house. He was talking through the glass door but would not open it. He was asked several times to open the door and allow us into the residence. While Lt Elliot was talking with the man I heard the side carport door open. I stepped around and made contact with Tomika Miller. She said her husband grabbed her by her arms and twisted her left wrist. She said he then drug her into the couples bedroom and would not let her leave. She said he was yelling at her, poking her in the forehead with his finger demanding to know where she had been. Tomika said her husband's name was Ray Brooks. I asked Tomika if she needed medical attention but she said no. I asked if she would provide a written statement and wanted to press charges. She said yes. Tomika said she sent her seven year old son Mahkai Miller to the neighbor to call for help. The neighbor that called asked to remain anonymous.

I stepped back to the front yard. Ray had come out of the house and was standing on the front porch. He was still yelling at Lt Elliot saying he and Tomika were just talking. I told Lt. Elliot that I had charges against Ray. As we attempted to take Ray into custody he became actively resistant and would not put his hands behind his back. Lt. Elliot had placed one cuff on Ray's right hand. As Ray tried to pull away, Lt. Elliot and I grabbed Ray by his arms and neck and placed him on the ground to try and gain control of Ray. I grabbed Ray's left wrist and tried to pull his arm behind his back and roll him on his stomach. Ray continued to resist and pulled his arm away. Both Lt. Elliot and I gave Ray clear verbal commands to stop resisting and roll over on his stomach. Ray would not comply with out instructions. As we were trying to restrain Ray, Lt. Elliot placed his knee against Ray's upper chest and held Ray's head down with his left hand. Lt Elliot was holding onto Ray's right hand with his right hand. I was still holding Ray's left hand to the ground with both of my hands.

Lt. Elliot told Ray that he would be tased if he continued to resist. Ray ignored the warning and continued to try and pull away from us. Lt. Elliot warned Ray several times with no response from Ray. Lt. Elliot took his taser from the holster, removed the cartridge and drive stunned Ray in the abdomen. Ray still continued to fight us. Officer Patterson and Officer Harrison arrived on scene to assist us. Officer Harrison obtained a set of leg restraints. Harrison assisted me in strapping Ray's legs together to stop him from trying to kick us. We were finally able to place Ray on his stomach and get him handcuffed. Lt. Elliot advised dispatch to send EMS personnel to evaluate Ray for injuries. Ray complained that his right hand hurt. EMS checked Ray's vital signs and tried to check his hand but Ray would not let them touch it. Ray was crying and shaking. He kept yelling for Tomika.

I transported Ray to FPPD for booking. I completed an arrest booking sheet and warrantless arrest affidavit. I transported him to the Clayton County Jail. I noted on his booking sheet that Ray had been tased and notified intake officer Ronnie Wyatt. I released Ray to the booking officer.

On March 31, 2014, at approximately 1557hrs I responded 850 Pine Valley Dr with MPO Hightower and Officer Blackwood in reference to an active domestic disturbance. When I arrived on scene MPO Hightower and Officer Blackwood were on scene and at the front door. I exited my patrol car and was met by MPO Hightower. MPO Hightower said that he heard arguing inside the residence but he could not get anyone to the door and the front glass storm door was locked. MPO Hightower went to the side door and knocked and I went to the front door again. I knocked on the front glass storm door and knocked. As I was approaching the door I could hear arguing inside the residence and a female voice saying "let me leave." I could see a black male standing inside the residence at in the entryway to the hall. I knocked to get his attention but was initially ignored. I knocked again and yelled out to the male to answer the door. The male, Ray Brooks, eventually came to the glass storm door but he refused to open the door and asked why we were there. I explained to him that due to the arguing the police were called. He said that he and his wife argue all the time and that he did not call the police. I asked Mr. Brooks to see his wife but he refused and stated that she did not want to see me. All the while I could hear the female telling Mr. Brooks "to let her go" and "let her out."

I was able to convince Mr. Brooks to let me see his wife and he called her over to the door. Mr. Brooks wife was hesitant because she did not want to be near Mr. Brooks. When she did go near the door and try to open it, Mr. Brooks grabbed her and would not let her open the door. The female then went to the side door, opened it and made contact with MPO Hightower. Mr. Brooks finally opened the glass storm door and stepped outside to talk. He explained that his wife was gone for several hours and that he was upset his did not know where she was. He to say that he did not call the police and wanted to know why we were there.

As I was talking to Mr. Brooks, MPO Hightower came to the front and indicated that Mr. Brooks was going to be placed under arrest. I informed Mr. Brooks that he was to place his hands behind his back and then I reached for his right wrist. Mr. Brooks immediately began to resist by pulling his arm free from my grasp and yelling that he had done nothing wrong.

Mr. Brooks turned and faced me while I was instructing him to place his hands behind his back. At this point I was afraid that Mr. Brooks may become physical and fight. Due to Mr. Brooks demeanor I kicked his legs out front under him and pushed him to the ground on his back to control his aggressive behavior and gain compliance. MPO Hightower and I both tried to control Mr. Brooks on the ground. Mr. Brooks continued to resist arrest by flexing his arms and keeping them locked to his side. I was able to get his right wrist handcuffed and with the assistance of MPO Hightower we attempted to roll Mr. Brooks on to his stomach. Mr. Brooks continued to struggle by pulling from our grasp, kicking his legs out wide and trying to sit up.

MPO Hightower and I were able to keep Mr. Brooks pinned to the ground and attempted several time to roll him to his stomach. All attempts failed at rolling him on to his stomach so in another attempt to gain compliance I drew my Taser M-26 electronic control device, sn# P3-001325, removed the Taser cartridge and performed a drive stun to Mr. Brooks stomach. The drive stun was ineffective. The Taser functioned properly but failed to gain the

On March 31, 2014 at approximately 1557 hours I (Officer Blackwood) was training with Corporal Hightower and we were dispatched to a domestic disturbance call at 850 Pine Valley Drive. I got out of my patrol vehicle and approached the residence.

Once I approached the residence, I heard a male yelling "give me my money". I also heard a female crying and yelling "let me go, let me go". A black male, identified as Rayshard Brooks, came to the door and was yelling and saying "why is the police in my house". He said he did not call the police. He also stated that he was just talking to his wife, identified as Tomika Miller.

I observed that Lt. Elliott wanted to talk to Rayshard and was telling him to come outside so they could talk. Rayshard did not want to open the door and tried to shut it in Lt. Elliott's face. Rayshard then decided to come outside and told Lt. Elliott that him and his wife always argue all the time. I observed that when Lt. Elliott tried to handcuff Rayshard he resisted. He began to cry and yell "baby, baby". Lt. Elliott told Rayshard to turn around but Rayshard did not want to turn around, and Rayshard applied more force to avoid getting handcuffed.

Rayshard began to move his arms and hands trying to pull away from Lt. Elliot. At that point Lt. Elliott along with Corporal Hightower grabbed Rayshard by his arms and put him on the ground. While on the ground Lt. Elliott kept telling Rayshard to get on his stomach, but he kept moving and resisting. I observed when Lt. Elliott pulled his Taser out and tased Rayshard once. Corporal Hightower had his arms and knees over Rayshard to hold him down.

I observed Lt. Elliott place his knee over Rayshard's upper body to gain control but Rayshard was still resisting, moving around and trying to pull away from Lt. Elliott and Corporal Hightower to avoid the arrest. Rayshard kept resisting and yelling "baby, baby why you doing this to me".

Officer Harrison and Officer Patterson arrived at approximately 1616 hours. Officer Harrison went in his patrol vehicle and grabbed the leg straps and placed it around Rayshard legs to keep him under control. Officer Patterson was talking to Rayshard and assisting Lt. Elliott and Corporal Hightower in placing Rayshard on his stomach.

I was speaking to Tomika to calm her down because she was crying, she advised me that Rayshard is violent and that this was not the first time they have had a physical altercation. I provided Tomika with a statement form and once completed she signed it. I read the statement and signed it.

Upon my arrival I met with Phyllis Hodge who advised she went to register 3 to pay for her items. She said she removed her credit card from her wallet to make the purchase, put her card inside of her purse and walked out of the store leaving her wallet on the counter. Phyllis said when she arrived home she realized she left her wallet at the store. When she arrived back at the store she asked cashier, Fallon Posey about her wallet. Fallon told her a black male that was in line behind her said the wallet belonged to his wife so she gave the male the wallet.

I asked Phyllis if she had any other items inside her wallet and she said yes. The following items that were inside of the wallet consisted of: (1) Case Debit Card, (1) Best Bank Debit Card, (1) Kroger Visa Credit Card, (1) Merrick Bank Visa Card, (1) Capital One Credit Card, (1) Barclay Credit Card and (1) laminated high school diploma. Phyllis provided a written statement and I gave her a case card.

I spoke with Fallon regarding the theft of Phyllis' wallet. Fallon said when Phyllis came through her line to check out she did not realize Phyllis had left her wallet after making her purchase. Fallon said a black male with 2 children were in line behind Phyllis and when the black male was checking out she noticed a black wallet laying on the counter. Fallon said she asked the male if the wallet belong to him and he said the wallet belong to his wife who went back to get other items to purchase. At that point Fallon gave the male the wallet.

I met with store manager, Terry Thompson to view the security video. The video showed Phyllis in line at register 3 at 1837 hours. She pulled her wallet out of her purse to pay for her items. Once she removed her debit card from her wallet she laid her wallet on the counter. When her transaction was completed she left the store leaving her wallet on the counter. There was a black male with 2 children behind Phyllis wearing black pants, black shirt and red shoes. The male had a red mohawk style hair cut and appeared to be 20 to 25 years of age. The male completed his transaction with some type of debit card. While the male was still in line Fallon got the wallet from the counter and showed it to the male. Fallon then gave the wallet to the male. The male left the store with the children and a female.

The outside security camera showed the male leaving the parking lot driving east in a dark colored 4 door passenger vehicle possibly a Toyota Camry. I obtained a copy of the security video and placed it into evidence. Phyllis contacted me a short time later and told me one of her cards was charged 1000.00 using pay pal and another card was used at PP Morris Tile in Morrow GA.

Whether is was a withdrawal or transaction, and exact location. I made sure Phyllis had my contact information.

I called Floor and Decor in Morrow, Georgia and spoke with Kendall. She advised she has never heard of PP Morris Tile. Kendall also advised that "Floor and Decor" shows up on their billing. She said to call her if / when I had a transaction number she can look up.

I called best Bank and spoke with Regina Fireson. I explained the case to Regina and she advised the company name is PP Moore Styles and it said Morrow, Georgia after it. I checked that name on Google and was unable to find a company that matched. Regina said she was going to look into a few things and call me back.

Phyllis called me and said she had talked to Kendall from Chase Bank. Kendall had advised PP Moore Styles was listed as a general contractor. She also said the debit card was used as credit at 6:52 pm for \$100. At 10:52 pm the card was attempted for a \$500 purchase and was denied. At 10:53 hours the card was attempted for \$200 and was denied. I told Phyllis I will call her tomorrow after I hear back from best Bank.

I requested and received a copy of the DVD from Inv. Singh.

On Tuesday (10/20/15) I had a voice mail message from Regina. I called her back and she advised it looks like the transactions were possibly ATM because she didn't see a purchase. I asked her if it was possible that someone had a Square Card Reader for a cell phone and Regina advised that was likely. She said the code read "code 21 - smart phone." I asked Regina how I would go about getting the phone information and she said she was contacting another investigator and will get back with me.

I responded to the location and saw that a black female was standing outside crying. The female identified herself as Tomika Miller. Tomika said her husband, Rayshard Brooks punched her in the mouth. Tomika told me that Rayshard was inside the house. Tomika said "he hit me I want him to go to get out of my house and go to jail. Tomika showed me the inside of her lip that had a cut inside of it.

I went to the front door of the house and met with Rayshard. Rayshard was upset and yelling. Rayshard had scratches on the side of his face. I asked Rayshard to calm down and go inside his house.

I spoke with Tomika who told me Rayshard called her to say he was on his way home from work and that he was riding with his co-worker. Tomika asked Rayshard who he was riding with, and he replied I do not have to tell you. Tomika said when Rayshard pulled up, she ran up to the car with her fist balled up and yelled "Why did you hang up on me".

I asked Tomika if she hit Rayshard. She told me she did not. Tomika then said Rayshard may have thought she was going to hit him by the way she ran up to him.

Tomika told me as she was yelling at Rayshard he punched her in the mouth.

I asked Tomika how many times did Rayshard hit her. Tomika, replied she thinks once but it may have been twice. Tomika, then said she was quite sure it was once. I asked Tomika where Rashard hit her. Tomika told me Rashard punched her in the mouth and the side of the face.

I did not observe any injuries to the side of Tomika's face.

Every time I spoke with Tomika she provided me with a different way in which she was hit.

I took pictures of Tomika's injury and had it attached to the report. Tomika also completed a written statement.

I spoke with Rayshard who told me he called Tomika, and told her he was riding with his co-worker home from work. Rayshard, said when he got home Tomika, ran to the car yelling at him. Rayshard, said he thought Tomika was going to hit him and put his hands up to guard his face. Rayshard, said Tomika's injury may have come from that.

I asked Rayshard, how he got the scratches on his face. He told me that he received them at work and they did not come from Tomika.

Rayshard refused to complete a written statement or allow me to take pictures.

Tomika's son, Brian Santana, said that Rayshard, punched Tomika, in the face as she yelled at Rayshard. Speaking with Brian, a few minutes later, Brian said that Rayshard did not hit Tomika in the face.

Tomika's and Rayshard's roommate, Rahsheen Reid, told me that he witnessed the incident from inside looking out the front window. Rahsheen, said he saw Tomika, run up to Rayshard. Rahsheen, said he saw Tomika's hands come up and then saw Rahsheen, put his hands up. Rahsheen, said, Rayshard, did not punch Tomika, in the face.

Other witnesses inside the house refuse to give a statement about the incident.

Based on the witnesses statements and inconsistencies in Tomika's story I was not able to get probable cause to charge anyone with a crime.

On Wednesday 902/19/14) I reviewed a domestic violence case that occurred on Monday (02/17/14) at 850 Pine Valley Dr. Tomika Miller advised her husband, Rayshard Brooks punched her in the mouth. According to Officer Session, Tomika changed how she was hit numerous times and was unsure how many times she was hit. Rayshard advised Tomika ran up to him and he thought she was going to hit him so he put his hands up in front of his face. Officer Session wrote that Tomika`s son, Brian Santana said Rayshard hit Tomika and then a few minutes later said he did not hit Tomika. \*\* Brian`s information is not in the report so it is unclear if he is a young child or not. Brian had some scratches on his face and said he received them from work. he would not let Officer Session take a photograph of him. I tried calling Rayshard and Tomika [redacted] and I have not heard back from either of them.

I checked them both in RMS and P2P and neither of them have a domestic violence history. I checked them on the Clayton County database and Rayshard is listed as a suspect in domestic violence on 01/10/14 and 06/15/10. He is listed as an offender on 01/18/11 and was convicted of the charge. Tomika is listed as the victim in all three of the cases and another case on 02/20/04. I checked Tomika and Rayshard on GCIC/ NCIC and Tomika did not have a criminal history. Rayshard did and the only domestic violence history was the case out of Clayton County (GCIC / NCIC shows the date as 03/04/11). Rayshard`s criminal history was placed in the shred receptacle. A domestic violence packet was mailed to Tomika. Case status is inactive / insufficient leads pending any contact with Tomika and / or Rayshard.
